## For this project you'll need:

HOOK: 5 mm hook or size H hook for the US
YARN: Worsted weight yarn, 4 ply US, 10 ply AU

## If you want to make this for a:

Twin size bed: 7 in length and 10 wide would be a great size
Queen size bed: 12 in length and 12 wide
King size bed: 12 in length and 14 wide

## Abbreviations

ch = chain
sc = single crochet
$\mathrm{dc}=$ double crochet
sk (\#) st = skip number of stitches mentioned
beg $=$ beginning
TRC = Triple crochet
sl st = slip stitch
sts = stitches

YO = Yarn over
Repeat what's in between * for rest of round.

## To Start

ch 4 and sl st in beg ch to form a ring.
ch 2 ( counts as $1^{\text {st }}$ dc ) dc 11 in center of ring. Sl st in beg ch 2 to end round ( 12 sts) Work on your tail as you make your dc's so you can pull the tail to tighten up hole afterwards.

NOTE: We will be working with
clusters for round 2, do now
pull through last two stitches of
dc's to complete them, leave the
last loop on the hook and
continue.

## Round 2

ch 2, and make an incomplete dc in the same ch st, leaving last loop on hook, dc 2 incomplete dc's in the next stitch. You should have 4
 loops on your hook for this beginning cluster only, YO and pull through all 4 loops, *
ch 4 , dc 2 incomplete dc's in the next stitch, repeat 1 more time, dc 2 incomplete dc's in the next stitch leaving you 5 loops on the hook, YO and pull through all 5 loops

* after last cluster of row, only ch 3 instead of 4 , then sl st into beg ch 2.


## Round 3

* ch 6 and sl st in next ch 4 space
* repeat this 6 times giving you 6 spaces. To end round, sl st in bottom ch of beg ch 6 loosely, so not to make this beginning part pull down.


## Round 4

sl st into first ch 6 space and ch 3, dc 7 into this ch 6 space *
dc 8 into next ch 6 space * repeat for round. sl st in top of beg ch 3 .


Round 5

* ch 6 and sk 4 sts, sl st in the space between dc's 4 and 5 . ch 6 and sk 4 sts, sl st in big space in between the sets.

## Round 6

sl st into beg ch 6 space, ch 3 , TRC 3, ch 3 , TRC 4 all in same ch 6 space. This is your first corner of your granny. *

TRC 4 in next ch 6 space, and again TRC 4 in next ch 6 space then your next corner TRC 4, ch 3, TRC 4

* repeat for round, turning your circle into a square. SI st in beg ch 3 to end round.


## Round 7

ch 1 and sc into same st. sc in all sts and 5 sc's in each corner space.
