Maryville University vs. Newman University

For the first time Seaman High School will host a college wrestling dual when Maryville University of St. Louis and Wichita's Newman University compete in NCAA Division II action.

Maryville, representing the Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC), comes in with a #22 national ranking and a 3-3 dual record. Individually; Tyler Kreith (#9 at 125), Tyler Stegall (#7 at 149), Tyler Herrington (#7 at 165) and Logan Radik (#11 at 285) are nationally ranked. Newman, of the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association conference (MIAA), enters today's match-up with a #18 national ranking and a 0-1 dual record. Tyler Lawley (#7 at 133) and Kameron Frame (#3 at 157) are listed in the latest NCAA D2 individual ranking.

Both programs are relative newcomers to the college wrestling scene. Newman's program was established in 2004, when it competed in the NAIA. The school joined the NCAA Division II in 2010. Maryville

began competing in the sport of wrestling in 2011. The school was formerly classified as a NCAA Division III institution. When it reclassified as a NCAA Division II school, the sport of wrestling was added. Ryan Smith has been at the helm of the Newman program since 2008. Coach Denney was the founding coach of the Maryville program after spending thirty-two years at a previous NCAA Division II institution, where he guided the program to seven National Championships.




Seaman High School has a strong connection to both programs. Steven Cooksley, 2010 SHS grad and two-time State Medalist, competed for the Jets. He competed in the varsity line-up all four years of his eligibility and was a 2012 NCAA Division II National Qualifier at 197 pounds. 2016 SHS grad Bailey Kelly, who was a four-time State Medalist and State Champion, currently competes for Maryville. He is a Redshirt-Junior. He was a National Qualifier at 184 pounds in 2019.

On behalf of Seaman High School and the Wrestling program, we want to welcome you to NCAA Division II wrestling action between Maryville University and Newman University.

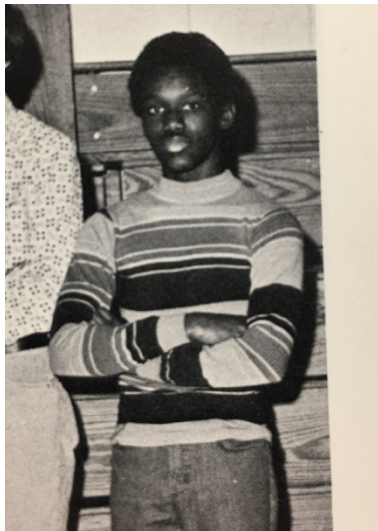
During the half-time break in the dual, we have a special Hall of Fame induction recognition.

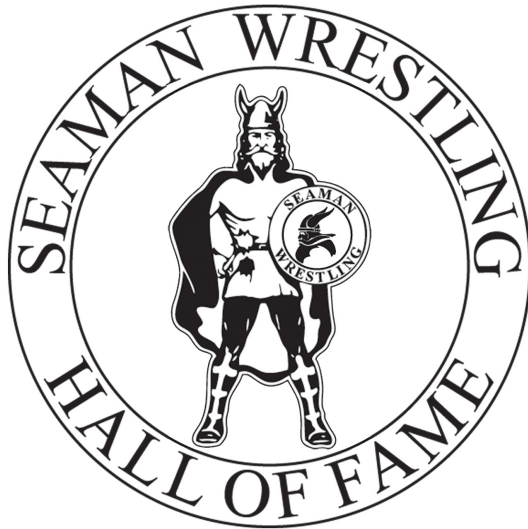

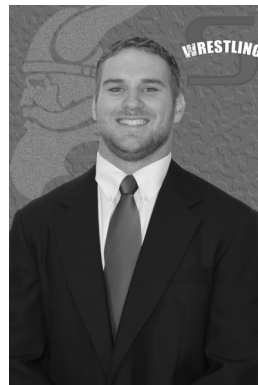

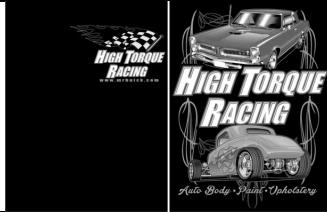
