

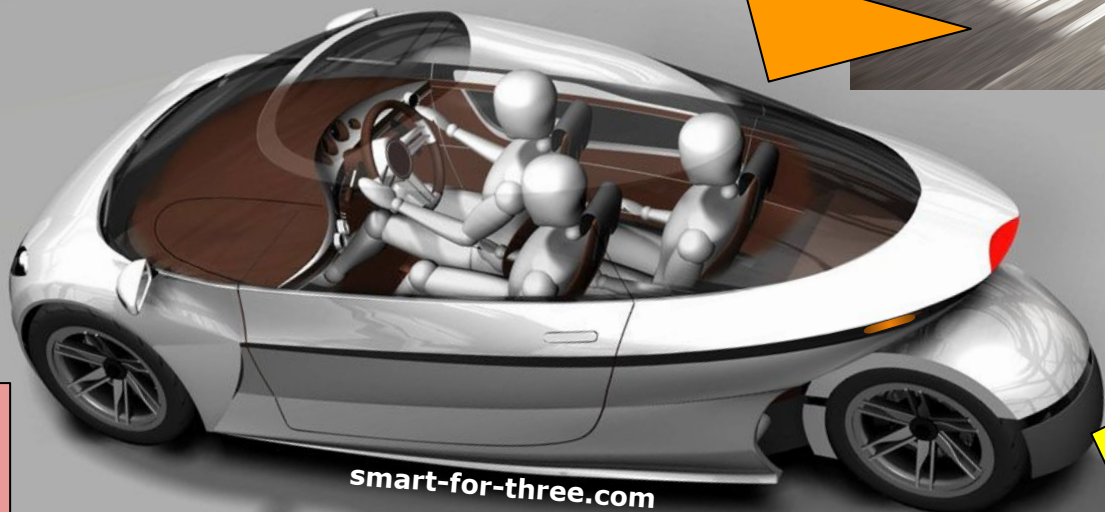
NCAP 50% offset

First passenger sits further back.

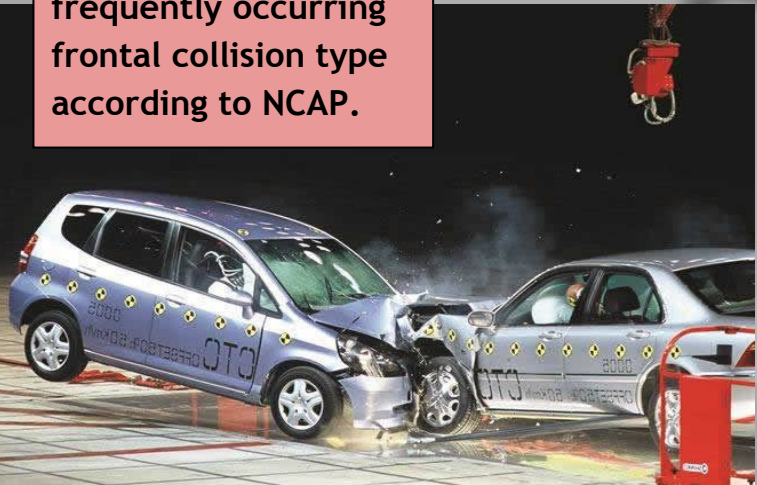
