Camping Area Rules and Conditions:

Set Up and Leaving Times

Friday Set up time from 4:00 till 9:00, Saturday set up times from 7:00 till 11:00. On Sunday the campsite will be closing at 14:00 everyone must have all their stuff removed by this time.

Pitch Size

Each tent / Camper is allocated a 6m x 6m pitch you must only use you allocated space.

Access to Camping Area

Anyone without a wristband for camping will not be authorized to enter the camping area at anytime.

Stereos and Musical Instruments

No stereos or musical instruments are to be played on the campsite at any time between 9pm - 9am.

Under 18's

Under parental supervision only and by prior arrangement with the G*YP*P*O Board of Trustees.

Fires

Open fires are not permitted under any circumstances.

BBQs

BBQs are not permitted on the camping area at any time.

Rubbish

All rubbish must be bagged and placed in the bins which can be found at the entrance to the camping area. Your pitch and its surround must be kept clean and free of rubbish at all times.

Noise

Please conduct yourself with due regard to others at all times. Please keep noise to a minimum between the hours of 10pm—9am, and when returning to the camping area at night please remember that other campers especially families with children may be asleep

No generators at anytime electric hook up will be provided for campers / caravans at a extra cost of £10 for the full weekend.

General Conduct

If at any time, in our opinion, the conduct of any person(s) is such that it is considered to be detrimental to either our interests or those of other campers, then they will be asked to leave the camping site and or event.
