



## Summer Internships

*Teach for Slovakia* is a non-profit organisation fighting for every child to get an excellent education and the opportunities that go with it. We are looking for energetic, creative and positive young people to join our team this summer.

### About us

We recruit, train and place the best Slovak talents in the toughest schools in our country. Our Fellows are taken through a concentrated process to become transformational teachers and leaders during an intensive 6 week Basecamp in the High Tatras. During this time, they undergo rigorous leadership and teacher training, which also involves them teaching in a Summer School for 3 weeks. Fellows are then placed in a disadvantaged primary school as teachers for two years. We further support them along the way so that they have the skills, knowledge and mindset to put their students on a different life path than the one they are currently on. The 2015 cohort will be our second group of Fellows.

### Who we are looking for

Three interns to join our team this summer from 22<sup>nd</sup> June to 14<sup>th</sup> of August who are:

- Energetic high school or university students or recent graduates;
- Passionate about the Teach for Slovakia mission;
- Proficient in English and Slovak;
- Highly competent in general computer skills and familiar with social media platforms;
- Quick learners, organised, prompt and fair team players;
- Preferably in possession of a valid drivers licence.

### Responsibilities

- Support our core team of trainers with translation and interpretation (English-Slovak, Slovak-English), creation or adaptation of training resources (including video editing and creation), and anything else our team might need help with.
- Act as part of our Operations Team, ensuring that our Opening Ceremony and all Basecamp and Summer School activities are administered effectively. Tasks will include setting up venues, catering, facilitating team building activities such as rock climbing, and other.
- Help document all events and post regular updates on social media.
- There is also a possibility of working directly with children by leading extra curricular and experiential learning activities during our Summer School. Activities may include but are not limited to dance, music, performance, improvisation, arts and crafts, and sports.

### What we are offering

- Free accommodation and food in Villa Siesta hotel in Novy Smokovec while at Basecamp;
- A stipend of 40 EUR paid weekly;
- Possibility to join in several of the world class leadership development workshops and activities designed for our Fellows;
- Working alongside inspirational international and Slovak leaders that will lead the trainings and discussions, such as Anton Zajac (ESET), Rasto Kulich (Google), Janette Motlova, Stanislav Boledovic, and alumni from Teach for All programs around the world;
- Professional development and freedom to learn from a diverse, energetic and passionate team on a mission to provide every child a chance to a better life through education.

### Location and dates

Bratislava between 22<sup>nd</sup> June and 8<sup>th</sup> July, and the High Tatras (Novy Smokovec) between 8<sup>th</sup> July and 15<sup>th</sup> August 2015. Interns do not have to join us for the whole period, but have to stay at least 3 weeks at a time.
