Presently, Java supports Windows 7 and later, whereas Bedrock supports Windows 10 and later. I fear that Microsoft will decide that there is no reason to maintain two separate codebases when Windows 7 and 8 are eliminated.

This issue is not due to Microsoft's conflict of interest in (not) supporting Linux. None of the major game studios, including Paradox or Valve are planning to bring full-sized games onto Linux unless they have access to the majority of software for Windows. If the developer decided not to support the Windows version of an exclusive Linux game and it was a result, it was removed from the Linux community.
