DEKAL Industrial Park

Economic Develop



The Pharr EDC recently celebrated the groundbreaking of DEKAL Industrial Park which will add 1 million square feet of refrigerated, frozen, and dry warehouse space to south Pharr through a collaborative venture formed by the partnership between Delta Fresh and Kaliroy Fresh. The two companies, which are based in Arizona, have come together to build the multi-milliondollar project to better serve the needs of the industry in Pharr.





"The Pharr EDC believes in collaborative partnerships, and we are proud to see Delta Fresh and Kaliroy Fresh joining efforts to expand their warehouses in south Pharr," said Victor Perez, President /CEO of the Pharr EDC. "We are proud to have incentivized this project which will result in additional warehouse space, more imports/exports, investment opportunities, and economic development for the area," added Perez.

DEKAL has acquired almost 77 acres in the City of Pharr and will be developing an industrial park consisting of 16 mixed storage warehouses, totaling 1million square feet (500,00 SQ FT on both sides). This will be one of the largest industrial parks in the City of Pharr.

"We saw the opportunity to meet the demand for warehouse space and to bring new investors to Pharr," said William Millan, project manager for Dekal Industrial Park. "The Pharr Bridge



is the gateway for everything coming from Mexico/South America to enter the United States," he said. "Pharr has replaced Nogales as the top land port of entry for fresh produce and it will only continue to grow," said Millan.

These state-of-the-art warehouses will facilitate business for a variety of companies seeking to expand into the region, while enhancing opportunities for growth for distributors and marketers of fresh produce. It is also estimated that this project will create approximately 100 direct and indirect jobs.




ECONOMIC OVERVIEW: CITY OF PHARR


2nd Quarter • April, May, and June 2022

The City of Pharr has continued its economic trend towards growth and development in the months of April, May, and June of 2022. Throughout the last quarter Pharr has welcomed new homes and businesses to the community, increased job opportunities, and grown its sales tax collections including earning the #1 ranking in May 2022.

The City of Pharr reported a strong Civilian Labor Force of 32,960 at the end of the second quarter compared to the same time last year (28, 817) and unemployment rates of 7.4 % (April 2022), 7.3% (May 2022), and 8.7% (June 2022) a major improvement from the same period the prior year. The City of Pharr remains committed to improving citizens' quality of life and is focused on continuing the positive financial and economic growth it has experienced over the second quarter.
