Dear Bernalillo County Commission:

This letter of interest and resume are my formal application to fill the District 26 Senate vacancy due to the resignation of Jacob Candelaria. I live at 3404 Grande Vista Place northwest which is approximately 1½ miles from my childhood home. I was born and raised in Albuquerque and am an **11th generation New Mexican on both my mom and dad's side of my family**. I am a 54-year-old Chicano, a lifetime Democrat, nine-year husband, and father too three, Gabriela Alarid (20), Mateo Maestas (8) and Isadora Maestas (7). My voter registration is Antonio "Moe" Maestas.

I am a graduate of Valley High School, the University of Washington, and the University of New Mexico, School of Law. I served as an Assistant District Attorney, **prosecuting domestic violence cases** for over 5 years. I have since managed my own law office, currently practicing personal injury law. Prior to college I worked as a **community organizer at El Centro de la Raza** in Seattle, Washington and worked as a **union factory worker** at night to put myself through college.

**For the past 16 years I have served honorably in the House** and have played a key role in some very impactful pieces of legislation. I have served as the **Chairman of House Commerce Committee** for the past four (4) years, was Majority Whip for two (2) years, and served as a regular member for the other ten (10) years, two (2) of which as a member of the minority. I have served on the following standing committees; Judiciary, Consumer & Public Affairs, Appropriations & Finance, Government, Elections & Indian Affairs, Transportation & Public Works, Taxation & Revenue, Rules & Order of Business, and the Commerce Committee.

During the interim I have served on the Court, Corrections & Justice Committee, the Revenue Stabilization & Tax Policy Committee, **founded and co-chaired the Criminal Justice Reform Subcommittee** and am Chair of the Economic Development & Policy Committee.

For the past decade I have been the **prime sponsor of the Constitutional Amendment on Early Childhood Education**. HJR-1 is on the ballot and would increase the annual distribution from our \$25 Billion Permanent School Fund from 5% to 6.25% (approximately \$250 million) which would grow, exceeding inflation - in perpetuity. Upon its passage it will constitute the **largest transfer of wealth from wall street to communities of color in the history in our nation**.

Other impactful progressive bills I have passed into law (in no particular order) are:

**1 - Breaking Bad Bill**, saved the film industry in New Mexico and increased the tax credit for films with multiple episodes;

**2 - Liquor License Reform**, defeated the powerful liquor lobby for the first time in 40 years by introducing Restaurant-B licenses to help our fledgling restaurant industry;

**3 – Legalized Medical Cannabis**, provided much needed medicine for veterans suffering with PTSD;

**4 - 2019 Crime Package**, consolidated previously vetoed crime bills to help prosecutors focus scarce resources on violent crimes;

**5 - Preventative Detention, CA**, allowing for preventative detention of violent criminals waiting trial after money bail was prohibited by the Supreme Court in *State v. Brown*, 2014-NMSC-038;

**6 - Public Defender Commission, CA**, separated the agency representing indigent defendants from the Executive consistent with America Bar Association Code of Ethics;

**7 - Expungement Act**, overcame four (4) vetoes by two (2) different Governors as NM because the last state in the union to offer a mechanism for certain individuals to expunge criminal records to be able to gain better employment;

**8 - Financial Literacy in High Schools**, every high school in New Mexico now offers a full semester class in personal finance;

**9 - Restricting Solitary Confinement**, prohibits those suffering from mental illness, pregnant inmates, and children to be placed in solitary confinement in prisons & jails.

**10 - Sex Offender Registration**, Modernized our registration requirements for registered sex offenders. which became model legislation for the entire country;

**11 – Legalized the Hemp Plant**, passed in 2017 in anticipation of passage of the federal Hemp Farming Act of 2018, usurping 80 years of prohibition;

**12 - NIL for College Athletes**, allows college athletes to market their name, image & likeness and not lose their college scholarship and forced the NCAA to change its policies one day before its enactment.

More importantly I have successfully fought for more westside representation through the creation of **three new House districts** and one additional APS school board district. Along with community organizers we have **brought thousands of westside students to the State Capital** celebrating *Westside Day at the Roundhouse* each year prior to Covid-19 educating our next generation of leaders on how to participate in government.
