I, Christopher Griffin, as Student Body President of the University of South Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the USF Student Body Constitution, and all other applicable laws, do herby promulgate the following Executive Order to take immediate effect:

- > Student Government Statutes clearly outline a Code of Ethics for all Student Government officials to follow.
- > The Student Government Code of Ethics requires that SG Officials shall:
 - o Be independent and impartial.
 - Perform their duties in the interests of the Student Body.
 - o Uphold the truth in an accurate manner.
- The Student Government Code of Ethics also require that SG Officials not:
 - o Misuse their power for their personal gain or advantage.
 - o Misuse their power of the gain or advantage of any entity which they are invested.
 - Benefit in a way that creates a conflict with the interests of the Student Body.
- People who are members of Student Government on or after December 19th 2016 will be unable to simultaneously run to be the 2017 Student Body President or Student Body Vice President while upholding the standards listed in Student Government's Code of Ethics.
- Therefore, any person who is a member of Student Government on or after December 19th, 2016 will be disqualified as a candidate for the 2017 Student Body President or Student Body Vice President.

This shall take immediate effect upon signature of this document.
