

# Find Out How To Host A Minecraft Pc Server With Out Paying For One

Guide on How to Make a Minecraft Server!

You might imagine that this is simply one other a kind of silly guides that doesn't let you know find out how to make a personal Minecraft server -- it simply tells you find out how to host a global server. Step 1: Go to [minecraft.net](http://minecraft.net) and download the launcher for the most recent server software. Click on here to get a tutorial on easy methods to setup the Minecraft Server setting. Don't worry; it's easy!

Step 2: After you could have downloaded the software and ran it, and adjusted the ELUA to true, you need to go to [logmein.com](http://logmein.com) to download Hamachi, a hosting company. It is free. Download Unmanaged. Ensure to create an account if you don't have one.

Step 3: After you have downloaded and put in Hamachi and the Minecraft server platform, go forward and run Hamachi, and log in. After that, click "Create New Network," and fill in the following fields.

Step 4: After that, you need to see an IP that does not start with 192.168 or 127.0.0.0. Right click [Minecraft-crafting.Org](http://Minecraft-crafting.Org) and make sure you select "Copy IPv4 Handle," not IPv6.

Step 5: Go into the "server.txt" file that came together with your server file. Open it in a textual content editor application, akin to Notepad++ or Home windows Notepad. Change "server-ip:" to your copied IPv4 Address. You'll be able to paste by proper clicking or doing CTRL+V. Be certain that there aren't any Areas.

Step 6: Now, with the Minecraft Server file open and operating, you can now close Hamachi. Don't close the tray icon although. Open Minecraft and kind the IPv4 Tackle into the server data.
