Protecting Oregon's Food Supply and Essential Agricultural Workers Proposal DRAFT

GOALS:

- Deploy rapid support and resources to Oregon's agricultural growers to meet harvest demands and to ensure the protection of migrant and seasonal farmworkers during the COVID-19 emergency.
- Reduce the potential for illness and death associated with COVID-19 among farmworkers, their families, and employers, and other residents in rural and urban communities.
- Enhance the public health of the state and educate Oregon's agricultural industry to mitigate the spread of COVID-19.

Agricultural Workforce Housing

<u>Hotel Vouchers</u>: Increasing statewide temporary housing capacity for employers that need to rapidly provide employer shelter for workers

Funding request: \$5M

<u>Non-Congregate Housing</u>: Standing up centralized temporary housing for workers to meet peak harvest demands while social distancing in prioritized locations.

Funding request: \$5M

TOTAL: \$10M

COVID-19 Sanitation

Providing a state procurement process for the rapid deployment of handwashing stations, sanitation equipment, cleaning supplies for agricultural employers, farmworkers, and community-based organizations.

- Field Sanitation- Handwashing Stations and Portable Restrooms: \$5M
- Social Distancing Transportation: \$1M
- Isolation & Quarantine: TBD

TOTAL: \$6M

Mitigating COVID-19 Outbreaks

Ensuring that workers who are sick are able to recuperate and seek health care by funding COVID-19 Wage loss relief. Providing farmworkers with PPE to slow the spread of COVID -19. Outreach and education that is linguistically and culturally responsive in partnership with community-based organizations.

• PPE: \$500K

COVID-19 Wage Loss Relief: \$10MCommunity-based outreach: \$3M
