6 Strange Reality About Kamyab Jawan Loan

Pakistan Special Assistant to the Prime Minister on Youth Affairs Usman Dar just recently inaugurated the hi-tech courses for youth as part of the widely-hailed Hunarmand Pakistan (Skills for All) initiative launched by the Government of Pakistan under its flagship Kamyab Jawan Program. The inauguration ceremony took place at the National University of Technology, more commonly described as NUTECH, in Islamabad.

kamyab jawan loan -- Youth Entrepreneurship Scheme', for young entrepreneurs and existing organizations in between the age group of 21 - 45 years, is developed to offer subsidized financing through 21 Commercial, Islamic and SME banks under the assistance and supervision of the State Bank of Pakistan. The loans will be paid out to SME recipients throughout Pakistan, covering; Punjab, Sindh, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Balochistan, Gilgit Baltistan and Azad Jammu & Kashmir. The Program intends to supply 25% of the loans to females entrepreneurs.

Pakistan's target was to participate at the Commonwealth Games and bring laurels for the nation whereas 3 sports talent hunt drives would be started to select best professional athletes of hockey, wrestling, and weight lifting that would be trained to get involved at international foras, he included. He said the Program has carried out football trials throughout the nation and selected 20 football stars, whereas the trials concluded last week in Karachi. He stated the dispensation of organization loans under the Kamyab Jawan Programme has been accelerated to help with optimal variety of youth in the country.

According to an authorities of the Ministry of Youth Affairs, this unique and enthusiastic program aimed at providing soft loans to the youth of the nation and creating job chances for them with having follow up technique. He stated that although similar youth support programme had also been introduced in the past, but they might not bear fruit due to absence of an effective and extensive strategy while under this program, a number of plans will be introduced for success of the programme.
