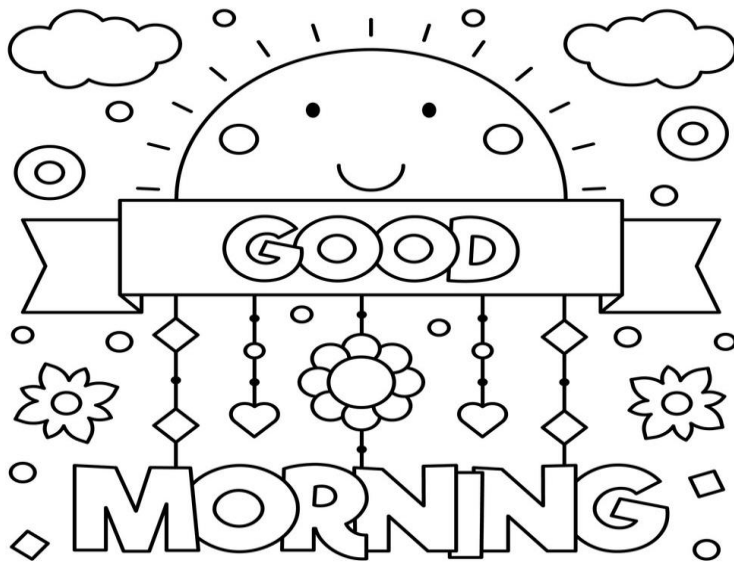


Meet Jesus in the Morning

I go to bed and sleep in peace, because, Lord, only you keep me safe. -Psalm 4:8

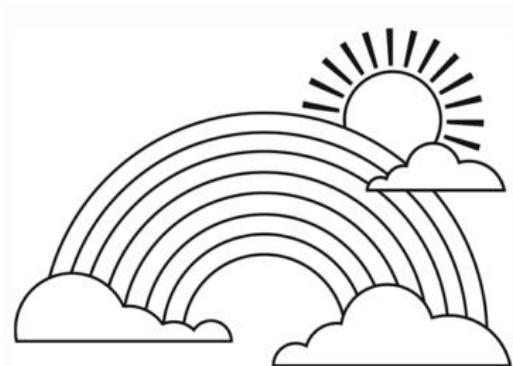
I can lie down and go to sleep, and I will wake up again, because the Lord gives me strength. -Psalm 3:5
