

Where Is The New Minecraft Launcher Exe Located

Windows apps shortcuts do not include.exe

Option 1:

Select Start > Settings > Personalization > start > enable "Show App List in Start Menu"

Once enabled, your start menu will have an app list on the left side (Picture).

Scroll down to Minecraft Launcher and drag the icon to the desktop.

Option 2:

An alternate method to create a short for new Minecraft Launcher

Use the Windows key + to change the language.

Type shell:AppsFolder, and hit enter

Find the new Minecraft Launcher

Right click and create shortcut
