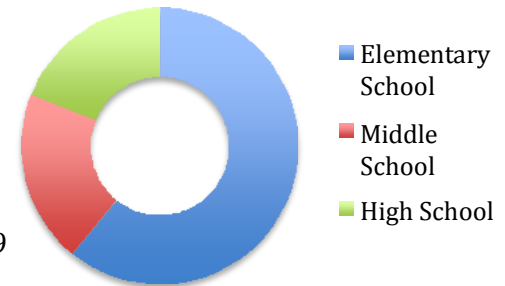

Grading and Testing Information

ASU does not rank its students. Maximum class size is 24 students. The cumulative GPA of ASU students reflects courses taken at ASU only. Grades from previous schools are not included. ASU calculates its GPA on a 4.0* non weighted scale as follows:

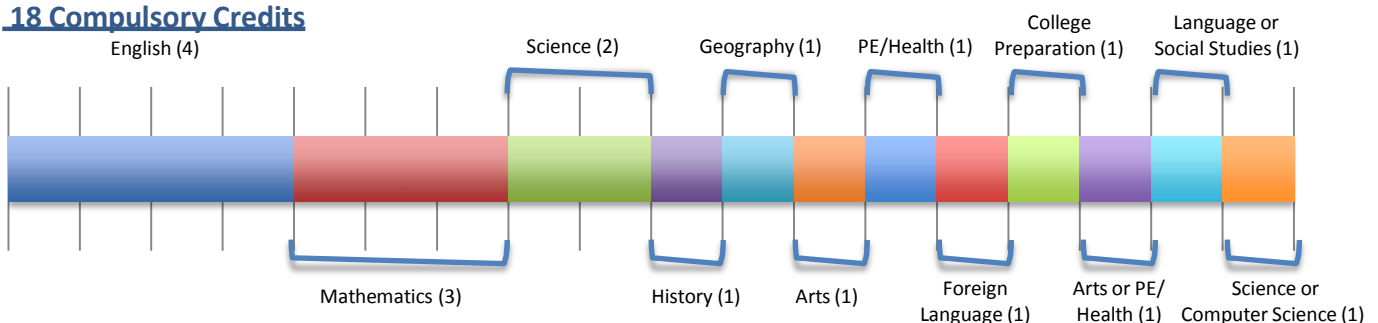
Co-Curricular Activities
