# **PRK Eye Surgery**

#### Different types of eye surgery

There is laser eye surgery, RK eye surgery, AK eye surgery, CK eye surgery, PRK eye surgery, etc.

**PRK eye surgery is medical term is called as** Photorefractive Keratectomy. This surgery is the first method to treat low refractive errors. People with thin corona can be operated with this surgery. PRK AND Lasik; both are classified as laser eye surgery.

## **Advantages of PRK**

Surgeons usually choose PRK eye surgery for patients with larger pupils and thinner corneas. PRK procedure is done with an excimer laser. In order to shape the cornea, small bits of tissue is ablated through Cool ultraviolet light; this will focus light on the eye and on to the retina properly as well, thus resulting in clear vision.

PRK is the better way to address problems of nearsightedness and farsightedness. The objective of nearsighted defect is to flatten a cornea that is too steep while for the farsighted defect, the objective is to steepen a cornea that is too flat. PRK can also be used to correct astigmatism by using an irregular cornea and making its contour smoothie.

### **PRK Procedure**

Before the procedure start, you will have to say the doctor about any reason that will interfere or become a reason for outcome of the surgery. There are some conditions that will not allow a person as a candidate for PRK surgery and also there are some conditions that the procedure will postpone to further date. You can ask your doctor about the required details about it.

Normally, people will not feel any pain when they go for the PRK procedure. Anesthetic drops will be put on your eyes so that it will decrease your discomfort. You will have to lie down. The doctor puts the laser in proper place. Eyes are operated on one at a time and a retainer is placed on the eyes in order to keep them open. There are equipments used while the surgery is under process which will help the eyes to be in a steady procedure. Once the procedure is completed doctor will ask you to rest for a while and will continue to next procedure if both your eyes are needed to be operated. .

- 1. Rubbing of eyes should be avoided.
- 2. Need to use night glares for eyes to avoid infection.
- 3. Need to wear glasses at the time of watching television or working.
- 4. Doctors advise should be followed on regular basis.
