In April 2014, I retired from the National Institutes of Health (NIH) where I served as Deputy Director for Human Resources for 10 years. Other experience:

Artist: started painting furniture in 2004 using color and geometric and floral designs. Items I paint are almost all reclaimed or abandoned junk, but have character, 'good bones', interesting shapes and lines or a high smile factor. I use acrylic paints which are inexpensive and forgiving, i.e. it's not a big deal to do a 'do over' if I don't like something. Finished items are colorful and whimsical. Earlier this year I got a booth at Woolworth Walk. I'm downstairs on the left toward the back.

• Community organizer/other:

- Kenilworth Residents' Association. Became KRA President in Jan. 2010. The 'Caledonia Saga' started June 2010 and did not complete until Jan. 2014. My takeaway this challenge was one of the most important and valuable experiences I have had. It was transformational both personally as well as for the neighborhood. Some KRA highlights during my tenure include: divided the neighborhood into 6 geographic sections, recruited reps for each section, amended & expanded the Bylaws to extend voting rights to section reps, filed & became a 501(c) 3 non-profit organization, gained much experience in hosting fundraisers (as in we learned the hard way ha!), adopted a new KRA website, consolidated 4 disparate email lists into one KRA list serv, and designed and distributed a New Neighbor brochure to the entire neighborhood. Our board grew from 4 members to 19. I stepped down as KRA President Feb. 2014 but am still active on the board.
- Kenilworth Art Association. I have been an active member of the KAA planning committee since the first tour in Dec. 2008. This year's tour (2014), I was the lead coordinator. We had the highest participation level to date (34 artists) and while results are not 100% complete yet, gross sales are up 44% so far. Artists donate 5% of their sales to Loving Food Resources, a food pantry in the neighborhood for people living with HIV/AIDS or who are in home hospice care. Artists have donated over \$5k to LFR since KAA incorporated this donation aspect in 2009.
- O Volunteer for Solarize Asheville. Participated as a neighborhood representative in a team effort to help spread the word city-wide re: group purchasing of solar PV. Initiative resulted in 368 people across Asheville who signed up as being interested in having rooftop solar panels installed.
