After China locked down Wuhan in January 2020, a move many called “draconian,” countries around the world scrambled and experimented with their own travel restrictions.

This ferry has one tiny entrance for all passengers to board. When full, which it usually is, there are approximately 200 people on board. In the event of an accident, the chance of everyone getting out of the boat fast enough would be very small. Most places you would want to stop have parking attendants who will issue you a numbered tag and watch over your bike. Sometimes these parking operations are overseen by the establishment you are visiting, and sometimes they are free-lance operations set up in places where a lot of people go. Depending on circumstance, you might park the bike yourself, or just put it in neutral and let the staff position it.

If you're fond of dining in hotels and high-end restaurants and have a taste for nice wine, it's completely possible to spend \$200 or more on a meal for two in a high-end restaurant in Hanoi or Saigon. One of the easiest ways to save money in Vietnam is to eat local food. Vietnamese food is tasty, affordable and — provided you avoid the deep fried dishes — substantially healthier than most of the alternative options you'll find in cafés and Western restaurants. Discover delicious mouth-watering street food from family-run stalls and restaurants. For a more comfortable backpacker experience in Vietnam, it's best to budget around \$50 per day. This way, you'll have more money to spend on things like food, drinks, activities and hotel rooms.

Is It Safe For Tourists In Vietnam?

There are a very small number of exceptions for diplomats on official business and certain high-skilled workers. Such applications are required to be led by Vietnamese employers who must work directly through individual provincial government offices. The requirements and process may differ from province to province.

Programme Encourages Vietnamese People To Travel Domestically

As of May 2015, obtaining a 30 day extension took 10 days and cost US\$185 - although the stamp still states "10 (mi) USD". Similarly, overstaying your visa has become considerably more expensive (on the order of USD50/day). It is common to get the letter with several other applicants passport details (passport number, date and place of birth, full name, etc.). You might share your personal information with up to other applicants on the same letter. For persons who are concerned about their privacy or security, it is recommended to check first if the agencies have an option for a separate or private approval letter on their website. Another solution is to apply for a regular visa through an embassy to keep your personal details private.

Many foreign hospitals and clinics are accredited by the Joint Commission International. A list of accredited facilities is available at their website ([http://www.jointcommissioninternational.com](#)). Bring all the medicines (including over-the-counter medicines) you think you might need during your trip, including extra in case of travel delays. Ask your doctor to help you get prescriptions filled early if you need to. If you are sick, stay home or in your hotel room, unless you need medical care.
