Cardigans and Sweater

For Measurements and Materials see back page.

NOTES

Instructions are given for 18 in or 46 cm, larger sizes in square brackets. Where only one figure is given this applies to all sizes. We suggest that you underline all the figures for the size you require before knitting.

TENSION

22 sts and 35 rows to 4 in or 10 cm measured over patt on size 4 mm needles or the size of needles to give correct tension. It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment, therefore knit a tension square. If there are less sts or rows to 4 in or 10 cm than stated, change to finer needles. If there are more sts or rows to 4 in or 10 cm than stated, change to larger needles.

ROUND NECK CARDIGAN

BACK

With the thinner needles cast on 57 [63 : 69 : 73 : 79] sts.

1st Row: (Right side). K1, * P1, K1, rep from * to end.

2nd Row: P1, * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

1st and 2nd rows form rib.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows 6 [7 : 7 : 7 : 8] times more.

Change to the thicker needles and work in patt as follows:

For 1st, 3rd and 4th sizes only

1st Row: P1, * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

2nd to 8th Row: Rep 1st row 7 times more.

9th Row: K0 [2 : 0], * K1, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K3, K2tog, yfwd, rep from * to last 1 [3 : 1] sts, K1 [3 : 1].

10th and 12th rows: Purl.

11th Row: K2 [4 : 2], * yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K3, rep from * to last 7 [9 : 7] sts, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K2 [4 : 2].

13th Row: K3 [5 : 3], * yfwd, S1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K5, rep from * to last 6 [8 : 6] sts, yfwd, S1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K3 [5 : 3].

14th Row: Purl.

These 14 rows form patt. **

For 2nd and 5th sizes only

1st Row: P1, * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

2nd to 8th Row: Rep 1st row 7 times more.

9th Row: K5, K2tog, yfwd, * K1, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K3, K2tog, yfwd, rep from * to last 8 sts, K1, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K5.

10th and 12th Rows: Purl.

11th Row: K1, * yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K3, rep from * to last 6 sts, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K1.

13th Row: K2, * yfwd, S1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K5, rep from * to last 5 sts, yfwd, S1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K2.

14th Row: Purl.

These 14 rows form patt. **

For all sizes

Work 68 [76 : 90 : 104 : 124] rows more in patt.

Shape Shoulders

Keeping patt correct cast off 17 [19 : 21 : 22 : 24] sts at beg of next 2 rows. — 23 [25 : 27 : 29 : 31] sts.

Slip sts onto a stitch holder.

LEFT FRONT

With the thinner needles cast on 35 [39 : 41 : 43 : 47] sts.

For Girl Only

Work 13 [15 : 15 : 17] rows in rib as given for Back.

For Boy Only

Work 4 rows in rib as given for Back.

Next Row: (Making Buttonhole). Rib to last 5 sts, yrn, P2tog, rib to end.

Work 8 [10 : 10 : 12] rows more in rib.

For Boy or Girl

Next Row: Rib 9 and slip these 9 sts onto a stitch holder for front band, rib to end and **for 1st, 3rd and 4th sizes only** inc 1 st at end of row. — 27 [30 : 33 : 35 : 38] sts.

Change to the thicker needles and work in patt as follows:

For 1st and 4th sizes only

1st Row: P1, * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

2nd to 8th Row: Rep 1st row 7 times more.

9th Row: * K1, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K3, K2tog, yfwd, rep from * to last 3 sts, K3.

10th and 12th Rows: Purl.

11th Row: K2, * yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K3, rep from * to last st, K1.

13th Row: K3, * yfwd, S1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K5, rep from * to end.

14th Row: Purl.

These 14 rows form patt. ***

For 3rd size only

1st Row: P1, * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

2nd to 8th Row: Rep 1st row 7 times more.

9th Row: K2, * K1, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K3, K2tog, yfwd, rep from * to last 7 sts, K1, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K4.

10th and 12th Rows: Purl.

11th Row: K4, * yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K3, rep from * to last 5 sts, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K3.

13th Row: K5, * yfwd, S1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K5, rep from * to last 4 sts, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K2.

14th Row: Purl.

These 14 rows form patt. ***

For 2nd and 5th sizes only

1st Row: * P1, K1, rep from * to end.

2nd Row: * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

3rd to 8th Row: Rep 1st and 2nd rows 3 times more.

9th Row: K5, K2tog, yfwd, * K1, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K3, K2tog, yfwd, rep from * to last 7 sts, K1, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K4.

10th and 12th Rows: Purl.

11th Row: K1, * yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K3, rep from * to last 5 sts, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K3.

13th Row: K2, * yfwd, S1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K5, rep from * to last 4 sts, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K2.

14th Row: Purl.

These 14 rows form patt. ***

For all sizes

Work 56 [56 : 70 : 84 : 98] rows more in patt.

Shape Neck

Next Row: Patt to last 4 [5 : 6 : 7 : 8] sts and slip these 4 [5 : 6 : 7 : 8] sts onto a stitch holder for neckband, turn. — 23 [25 : 27 : 28 : 30] sts.

**** Keeping patt correct dec 1 st at neck edge on next 4 rows, then foll 2 alt rows. — 17 [19 : 21 : 22 : 24] sts.

Work 3 [11 : 11 : 11 : 17] rows straight in patt. (Work 1 row more here when working Right Front).

Cast off in patt.

RIGHT FRONT

With the thinner needles cast on 35 [39 : 41 : 43 : 47] sts.

For Girl only

Work 4 rows in rib as given for Back.

Next Row: (Making Buttonhole). Rib 4, yrn, P2tog, rib to end.

Work 8 [10 : 10 : 10 : 12] rows more in rib.

For Boy only

Work 13 [15 : 15 : 15 : 17] rows in rib as given for Back.

For Boy or Girl

Next Row: **For 1st, 3rd and 4th sizes only** inc in first st, then **for all sizes** rib to last 9 sts and slip these last 9 sts onto a stitch holder for front band, turn. — 27 [30 : 33 : 35 : 38] sts.

Change to the thicker needles and work in patt as follows:

For 1st and 4th sizes only

1st Row: P1, * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

2nd to 8th Row: Rep 1st row 7 times more.

9th Row: K2, * K1, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K3, K2tog, yfwd, rep from * to last st, K1.

10th and 12th Rows: Purl.

11th Row: K4, * yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K3, rep from * to last 7 sts, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K2.

13th Row: K5, * yfwd, S1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K5, rep from * to last 6 sts, yfwd, S1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K3.

14th Row: Purl.

These 14 rows form patt. *****

For 3rd size only

1st Row: P1, * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

2nd to 8th Row: Rep 1st row 7 times more.

9th Row: K4, K2tog, yfwd, * K1, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K3, K2tog, yfwd, rep from * to last 3 sts, K3.

10th and 12th Rows: Purl.

11th Row: K3, K2tog, yfwd, K3, * yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K3, rep from * to last st, K1.

13th Row: K2, K2tog, yfwd, K5, * yfwd, S1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K5, rep from * to end.

14th Row: Purl.

These 14 rows form patt. *****

For 2nd and 5th sizes only

1st Row: * K1, P1, rep from * to end.

2nd Row: * P1, K1, rep from * to end.

3rd to 8th Row: Rep 1st and 2nd rows 3 times more.
9th Row: K4, K2tog, yfwd, * K1, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K3, K2tog, yfwd, rep from * to last 8 sts, K1, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K5.
10th and 12th Rows: Purl.
11th Row: K3, K2tog, yfwd, K3, * yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K3, rep from * to last 6 sts, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K1.
13th Row: K2, K2tog, yfwd, K5, * yfwd, S1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K5, rep from * to last 5 sts, yfwd, S1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K2.
14th Row: Purl.
These 14 rows form patt. *****

For all sizes
Work 56 [56 : 70 : 84 : 98] rows more in patt.

Shape Neck
Next Row: K4 [5 : 6 : 7 : 8] and slip these 4 [5 : 6 : 7 : 8] sts onto a stitch holder for neckband, patt to end. — 23 [25 : 27 : 28 : 30] sts.
Complete to correspond with Left Front from ***** noting variation.

SLEEVES (Both Alike)

With the thinner needles cast on 31 [33 : 35 : 37 : 39] sts and work 13 [15 : 15 : 15 : 15] rows in rib as given for Back.

Next Row: Rib 1 [2 : 3 : 4 : 1], inc in next st, * rib 2 [3 : 3 : 3 : 4], inc in next st, rep from * to last 2 [2 : 3 : 4 : 2] sts, rib 2 [2 : 3 : 4 : 2]. — 41 [41 : 43 : 45 : 47] sts.

Change to the thicker needles and set position of patt as follows:

1st Row: P1, * K1, P1, rep from * to end.
2nd to 4th Row: Rep 1st row 3 times more.
5th Row: Inc in first st, K1, * P1, K1, rep from * to last st, inc in last st. — 43 [43 : 45 : 47 : 49] sts.
6th Row: K1, * P1, K1, rep from * to end.
7th and 8th Rows: Rep 6th row twice more.

For 1st and 2nd sizes only

9th Row: K1, * K1, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K3, K2tog, yfwd, rep from * to last 2 sts, K2.

10th and 12th Rows: Purl.

11th Row: Inc in first st, K2, * yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K3, rep from * to last 8 sts, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K2, inc in last st. — 45 sts.

13th Row: K5, * yfwd, S1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K5, rep from * to end.

14th Row: Purl.

For 3rd size only

9th Row: K2tog, yfwd, * K1, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K3, K2tog, yfwd, rep from * to last 3 sts, K1, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso.

10th and 12th Rows: Purl.

11th Row: Inc in first st, K3, * yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K3, rep from * to last st, inc in last st. — 47 sts.

13th Row: K6, * yfwd, S1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K5, rep from * to last st, K1.

14th Row: Purl.

For 4th size only

9th Row: K1, K2tog, yfwd, * K1, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K3, K2tog, yfwd, rep from * to last 4 sts, K1, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K1.

10th and 12th Rows: Purl.

11th Row: Inc in first st, K4, * yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K3, rep from * to last 2 sts, K1, inc in last st. — 49 sts.

13th Row: K2tog, yfwd, K5, * yfwd, S1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K5, rep from * to last 2 sts, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso.

14th Row: Purl.

For 5th size only

9th Row: K2, K2tog, yfwd, * K1, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K3, K2tog, yfwd, rep from * to last 5 sts, K1, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K2.

10th and 12th Rows: Purl.

11th Row: Inc in first st, K2tog, yfwd, K3, * yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K1, K2tog, yfwd, K3, rep from * to last 3 sts, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, inc in last st. — 51 sts.

13th Row: K1, K2tog, yfwd, K5, * yfwd, S1, K2tog, pssso, yfwd, K5, rep from * to last 3 sts, yfwd, S1, K1, pssso, K1.

14th Row: Purl.

For all sizes

These 14 rows set position of patt.

Cont in patt as given for Back as set, inc 1 st at each end of 3rd row then every foll 6th row until 49 [49 : 51 : 59 : 75] sts are on needle, then every foll 4th row until 57 [61 : 67 : 73 : 79] sts are on needle, working inc sts into patt when possible.

Work 11 [9 : 9 : 15 : 15] rows straight in patt.

Cast off in patt.

BUTTON BAND (Right for Boy, Left for Girl)

Slip 9 sts from stitch holder onto a thinner needle so that you are ready to beg at inside edge.

Rejoin yarn and cont in rib until band fits up front edge to neck when slightly stretched, ending at inside edge.

Slip sts onto a stitch holder.

Mark positions for 6 [6 : 6 : 7 : 7] buttons, the first one to correspond with buttonhole already made and allowing for the last one to be made in 4th row of neckband with 4 [4 : 4 : 5 : 5] more evenly spaced between.

BUTTONHOLE BAND (Left for Boy, Right for Girl)

Slip 9 sts from stitch holder onto a thinner needle so that you are ready to beg at inside edge.

Rejoin yarn and cont in rib making further buttonholes, as before in welt,

until 5 [5 : 5 : 6 : 6] in all have been made.

Cont in rib until band fits up front edge to neck when slightly stretched, ending at inside edge.

Slip sts onto a stitch holder.

NECKBAND

With a backstitch join shoulder seams.

With right side facing slip 9 sts from right front band stitch holder and 4 [5 : 6 : 7 : 8] sts from right front neck stitch holder onto a thinner needle.

Rejoin yarn and pick up and K13 [20 : 20 : 20 : 26] sts evenly from right side of front neck; K23 [25 : 27 : 29 : 31] sts from back neck; pick up and K13 [20 : 20 : 20 : 26] sts evenly from left side of front neck; K4 [5 : 6 : 7 : 8] sts from stitch holder and rib 9 sts from left front band. — 75 [93 : 97 : 101 : 117] sts.

Beg with 2nd row work 7 rows in rib as given for Back, making last buttonhole in 4th row.

Cast off firmly in rib.

'V' NECK CARDIGAN

Work Back and Sleeves exactly as given for Round Neck Cardigan, but cast off sts at back neck.

LEFT FRONT

Work exactly as given for Round Neck Cardigan to *** for size required.

For all sizes

***** Work 28 [28 : 42 : 50 : 64] rows more in patt.

Shape Front Slope

Keeping patt correct dec 1 st at front edge on next row then every foll 4th row until 17 [19 : 21 : 22 : 24] sts rem.

Work 3 [7 : 3 : 5 : 7] rows straight in patt. (Work 1 row more here when working Right Front).

Cast off in patt.

RIGHT FRONT

Work exactly as given for Round Neck Cardigan to ***** for size required.

For all sizes

Complete to correspond with Left Front from ***** noting variation.

BUTTON BAND (Right for Boy, Left for Girl)

Slip 9 sts from stitch holder onto a thinner needle so that you are ready to beg at inside edge.

Rejoin yarn and cont in rib until band fits up front edge to centre back neck when slightly stretched.

Cast off in rib.

Mark positions for 4 [4 : 5 : 5 : 5] buttons, the first one to correspond with buttonhole already made and allowing for the last one to be made 4 rows below the first shaping at front edge, with 2 [2 : 3 : 3 : 3] more evenly spaced between.

BUTTONHOLE BAND (Left for Boy, Right for Girl)

Slip 9 sts from stitch holder onto a thinner needle so that you are ready to beg at inside edge.

Rejoin yarn and cont in rib making further buttonholes, as before in welt, to correspond with button markers, until 4 [4 : 5 : 5 : 5] in all have been made.

Cont in rib until band fits up front edge to centre back neck when slightly stretched.

Cast off in rib.

JUMPER

Work Back and Sleeves exactly as given for Round Neck Cardigan.

FRONT

Work exactly as given for Back of Round Neck Cardigan to ** for size required.

For all sizes

Work 56 [56 : 70 : 84 : 98] rows more in patt.

Shape Neck

Next Row: Patt 23 [25 : 27 : 28 : 30], turn.

Complete first side as follows:

Keeping patt correct dec 1 st at neck edge on next 4 rows, then foll 2 alt rows. — 17 [19 : 21 : 22 : 24] sts.

Work 1 [7 : 7 : 7 : 13] rows straight in patt.

Note that the first side of neck is shorter than the second, this is to allow for the depth of buttonhole band.

Cast off in patt.

Slip centre 11 [13 : 15 : 17 : 19] sts onto a stitch holder.

With right side facing rejoin yarn at neck edge of rem 23 [25 : 27 : 28 : 30] sts and patt to end.

Keeping patt correct dec 1 st at neck edge on next 4 rows then foll 2 alt rows. — 17 [19 : 21 : 22 : 24] sts.

Work 4 [12 : 12 : 12 : 18] rows straight in patt.

Cast off in patt.

NECKBAND

With a backstitch join right shoulder seam.

With the thinner needles and right side facing rejoin yarn and pick up and K9 [16 : 16 : 16 : 22] sts evenly from left side of front neck; K11 [13 : 15 : 17 : 19] sts from centre front; pick up and K14 [19 : 19 : 19 : 25] sts evenly from right side of front neck and K23 [25 : 27 : 29 : 31] sts from back neck. — 57 [73 : 77 : 81 : 97] sts.

Beg with 2nd row work 7 rows in rib as given for Back of Round Neck Cardigan.

Cast off fairly loosely in rib.

SHOULDER BUTTON BAND

With the thinner needles and right side facing, rejoin yarn at top of neckband at back and pick up and K7 sts from side of neckband and 16 [18 : 20 : 22 : 24] sts from shoulder. — 23 [25 : 27 : 29 : 31] sts.

Beg with 2nd row work 7 rows in rib as given for Back of Round Neck Cardigan.

Cast off fairly loosely in rib.

SHOULDER BUTTONHOLE BAND

With the thinner needles and right side facing, rejoin yarn at armhole edge of front shoulder and pick up and K7 sts from side of neckband and 7 sts from side edge of neckband. — 23 [25 : 27 : 29 : 31] sts.

Beg with 2nd row work 3 rows in rib as given for Back of Round Neck Cardigan.

Next Row: (Making Buttonhole). Rib 3 [5 : 3 : 5 : 3], yfwd, K2tog, * rib 6 [6 : 8 : 8 : 10], yfwd, K2tog, rep from * once more, rib to end.

Work 3 rows more in rib.

Cast off fairly loosely in rib.

TO MAKE UP

See ball band for pressing and washing instructions.

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Round Neck Cardigan

With a backstitch join sleeve seams.

Join side seams leaving openings for armholes to fit tops of sleeves. Pin sleeves into position placing centre of sleeve tops to shoulder seams and sleeve seams to side seams. Sew sleeves into position. Sew front bands neatly in position. Sew on buttons.

'V' Neck Cardigan

With a backstitch join shoulder seams.

Join sleeve seams.

Join side seams leaving openings for armholes to fit tops of sleeves. Pin sleeves into position placing centre of sleeve tops to shoulder seams and sleeve seams to side seams. Sew sleeves into position. See front bands neatly in position and join together at centre back neck. Sew on buttons.

Jumper

Place shoulder buttonhole band over shoulder button band and catch down at side edge.

Join sleeve seams.

Join side seams leaving openings for armholes to fit tops of sleeves. Pin sleeves into position placing centre of sleeve tops to shoulders and sleeve seams to side seams. Sew sleeves into position. Sew on buttons.

TO SET KNITTING

Pin out to size and shape, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry.
