Where only one figure is given this applies to all sizes.

Sleeve Seam	14 5½	15 6	23 9	cm. ins.

The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

Abbreviations

K.=Knit; P.=Purl; st(s).=stitch(es); dec.=decrease; inc.=increase; tog.=together; st.st.=stocking stitch; rept.=repeat; sl.=slip; p.s.s.o.=pass slip stitch over; T.2F.=twist two front, knit into front of 2nd stich on left hand needle, then K. the first st. slip off both sts. tog; C.6F.=cross six front - slip the next 2 sts. onto a cable needle and leave at front of work, slip next 2 sts. onto another cable needle and leave at back of work, K.2, then P.2 from 2nd cable needle, then K.2 from first cable needle; Patt.=pattern; O.=No sts. or rows to be worked in that particular size. alt.=alternate; cm.=centimetres; ins.=inches.

Success will be assured if you . . .

Use only the Wendy or Peter Pan yarn specified. (We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used).

Follow our instructions exactly, make certain you have the right tension. Measure (without stretching) to see you're knitting the right number of stitches as stated. Too many? - use larger needles. Too few? - use finer needles. Once the tension is right, the size will be right.

Tension:

11 sts. and 14 rows to 5 cm. (2 ins.) over st.st. on 4½ mm. (No. 7) Needles.

Both Designs

Back

Using 3¼ mm. (No. 9) Needles, cast on 55 (61) [67] sts.

1st Row – K.1, * P.1, K.1, rept. from * to end.

2nd Row – P.1, * K.1, P.1, rept. from * to end. Rept. the last 2 rows 6 times more.

Change to 4½ mm. (No. 7) Needles and st.st. (1 row knit, 1 row purl) until work measures 14 (16.5) [17.5] cm. 5½ (6½) [7] ins. from commencement finishing on a wrong side row.

Shape armholes

Cast off 3 (4) [4] sts. at beg. of next 2 rows.

1st Row – K.1, sl.1, K.2 tog. p.s.s.o. K. to last 4 sts. K.3 tog. K.1.

2nd Row – Purl.

3rd Row – K.1, sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o. K. to last 3 sts. K.2 tog. K.1.

4th Row – Purl.

Rept. the last 4 rows 1 (0) [0] times more.

Then the 3rd and 4th rows only until 19 (21) [23] sts. remain finishing on a purl row. Sl.sts. onto a st. holder. Break off yarn.

Front

Using 3¼ mm. (No. 9) Needles, cast on 55 (61) [67] sts.

Work 13 rows in rib as given for back.

Next Row – Rib 18 (21) [24] sts. (inc. in next st. rib 2) 6 times, inc. in next st. rib 18 (21) [24]. 62 (68) [74] sts.

Change to 4½ mm. (No. 7) Needles and patt. panel.

1st Row – K.18 (21) [24] sts. (P.2, T.2F) 6 times, P.2, K.18 (21) [24].

2nd and Alt. Rows: P.18 (21) [24] sts. (K.2, P.2) 6 times, K.2, P.18 (21) [24].

3rd Row – As 1st Row.

5th Row – K.18 (21) [24] P.2, C.6F. (P.2, T.2F) twice, P.2, C.6F. (P.2, K.18 (21) [24].

7th Row – As 1st Row.

9th Row – As 1st Row.

11th Row – K.18 (21) [24] sts. (P.2, T.2F) twice, P.2, C.6F. (P.2, T.2F) twice, P.2, K.18 (21) [24].

12th Row – P.18 (21) [24] sts. (K.2, P.2) 6 times, K.2, P.18 (21) [24].

These 12 rows form the patt. panel.

Continue in patt. until work measures 14 (16.5) [17.5] cm. 5½ (6½) [7] ins. from commencement finishing on a wrong side row.

Shape armholes

Cast off 3 (4) [4] sts. at beg. of next 2 rows.

1st Row – K.1, sl.1, K.2 tog. p.s.s.o. patt. to last 4 sts. K.3 tog. K.1.

2nd Row – Patt. to end.

3rd Row – K.1, sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o. patt. to last 3 sts. K.2 tog. K.1.

4th Row – Patt. to end.

Rept. the last 4 rows 1 (0) [0] times more.

Then the 3rd and 4th rows only until 36 (38) [44] sts. remain finishing on a right side row.

Shape neck

Next Row – Patt. 25 (26) [30] sts. slip the last 14 (14) [16] sts. just worked onto a st. holder, patt. 11 (12) [14].

Continue to dec. at armhole edge as before **at the same time** dec. 1st. at neck edge on every row until 5 (4) [4] sts. remain, then at armhole edge only until 2 sts. remain. K.2 tog. Fasten off.

Rejoin yarn to remaining sts. work to correspond with other side reversing all shapings.

Sleeves (both alike)

Using 3¼ mm. (No. 9) Needles, cast on 29 (31) [33] sts.

Work 4 (4) [5] cm. 1½ (1½) [2] ins. in rib as given for back finishing on a 1st row.

Next Row (Inc. Row) – Inc. in first st. rib 10 (11) [12] sts. (inc. in next st. rib 2) twice, inc. in next st. rib 10 (11) [12] sts. inc. in last st. 34 (36) [38] sts.

Change to 4½ mm. (No. 7) Needles and patt. panel.

1st Row – K.12 (13) [14] sts. (P.2, T.2F) twice, P.2, K.12 (13) [14].

2nd Row – P.12 (13) [14] sts. (K.2, P.2) twice, K.2, P.12 (13) [14].

3rd Row – As 1st Row.

4th Row – As 2nd Row.

5th Row – Inc. in first st. K.11 (12) [13], P.2, C.6F, P.2, K.11 (12) [13] inc. in last st.

6th, 8th and 10th Rows – P.13 (14) [15] sts. (K.2, P.2) twice, K.2, P.13 (14) [15].

7th Row – K.13 (14) [15] sts. (P.2, T.2F) twice, P.2, K.13 (14) [15].

9th Row – K.13 (14) [15] sts. (P.2, T.2F) twice, P.2, K.13 (14) [15].

11th Row – Inc. in first st. K.12 (13) [14] sts. (P.2, T.2F) twice, P.2, K.12 (13) [14] inc. in last st.

12th Row – P.14 (15) [16] sts. (K.2, P.2) twice, K.2, P.14 (15) [16].

Continue in patt. as set, inc. 1 st. at each end of the needle on every 5th and 11th row until 40 (44) [48] sts. are on the needle. Continue

in patt. without further inc. until sleeve measures 14 (15) [23] cm. 5½ (6) [9] ins. from commencement finishing on a wrong side row.

Shape Top

Cast off 3 (4) [4] sts. at beg. of next 2 rows.
(51) cm. (20) inch Size Only
Patt. 2 rows.

All sizes

Next Row – K.1, sl.1, K.1, p.s.s.o. patt. to last 3 sts. K.2 tog. K.1.

Next Row – Patt. to end.

Rept. the last 2 rows until 8 sts. remain finishing on wrong side row. Sl.sts. onto a safety pin. Break off yarn.

Pressing

With wrong side facing pin out all pieces to measurements given. Press as instructions.

Making up

Both Designs

Pin sleeves into position, leaving left back raglan open. Sew in by backstitching.

Polo collar

With right side facing, using 3¼ mm. (No. 9) Needles, K.8 sts. from sleeve top, pick up and K.10 (11) [12] sts. down left front neck, K.14 (14) [16] sts. from front neck, pick up and K.10 (11) [12] sts. up right front neck, K.8 sts. from sleeve top and K.19 (21) [23] sts. from back neck. 69 (73) [79] sts. Commencing on a 2nd row, work 7.5 (7.5) [9] cm. 3 (3) [3½] ins. in rib as given for back. Cast off loosely in rib.

Round neck design

Work as instructions given for Polo Collar for 2 cm. (¾ inch). Cast off loosely in rib.



Both designs

Join left back raglan by backstitching, join collar by top sewing, reverse seam for polo collar.

Join side and sleeve seams by backstitching omitting rib, join rib by top sewing.

Press seams.
