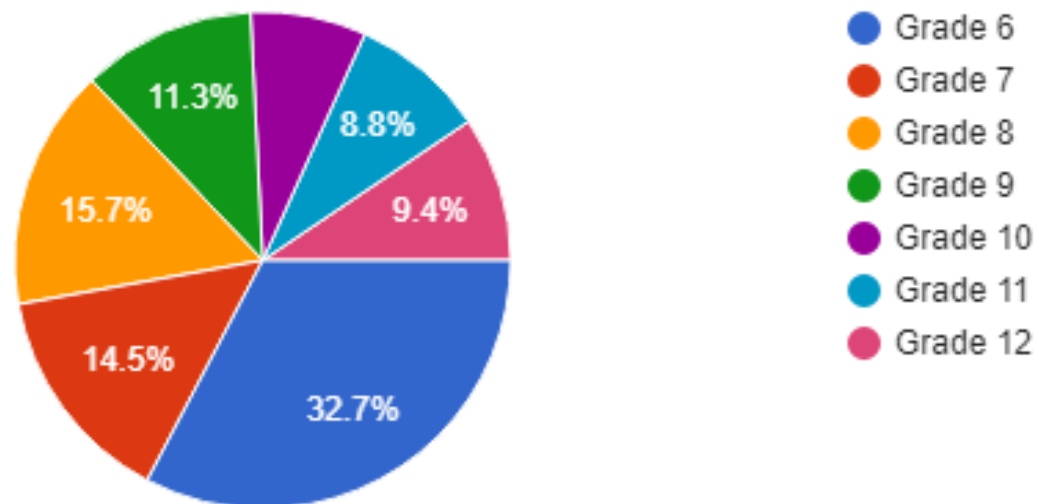

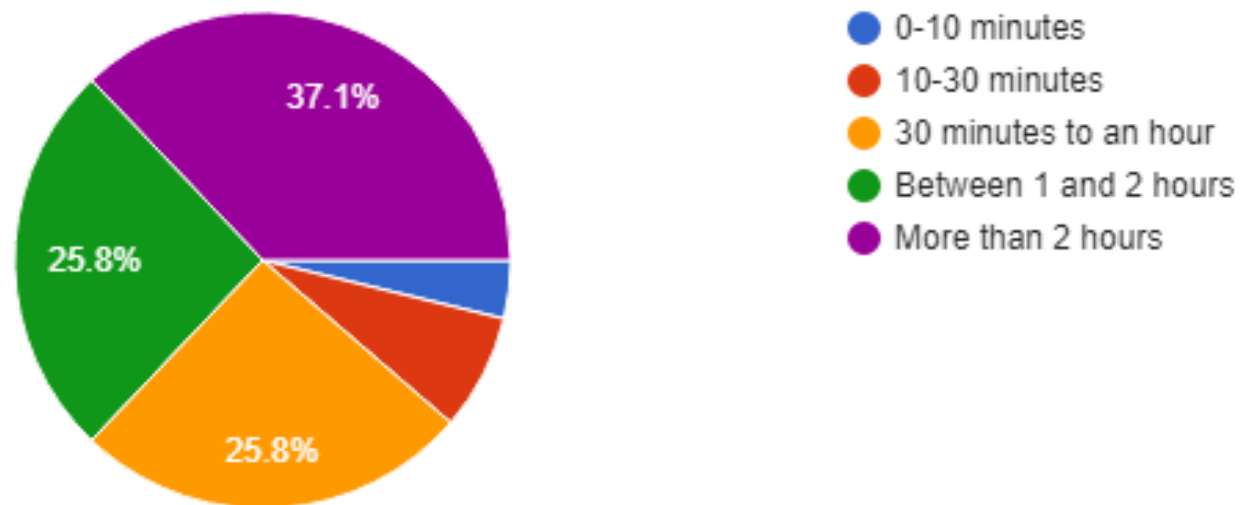
What grade are you in?

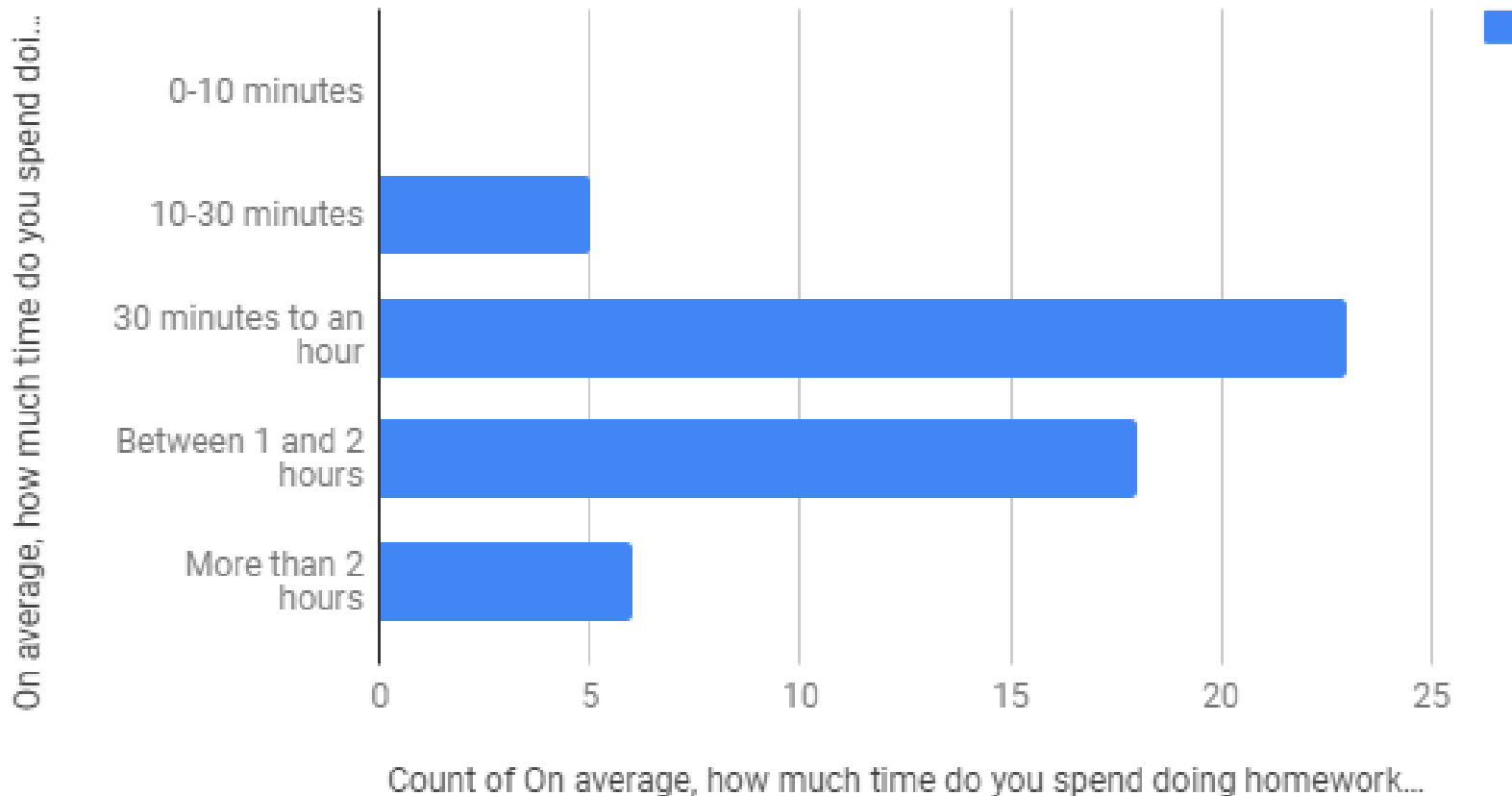


On average, how much time do you spend doing homework each night?

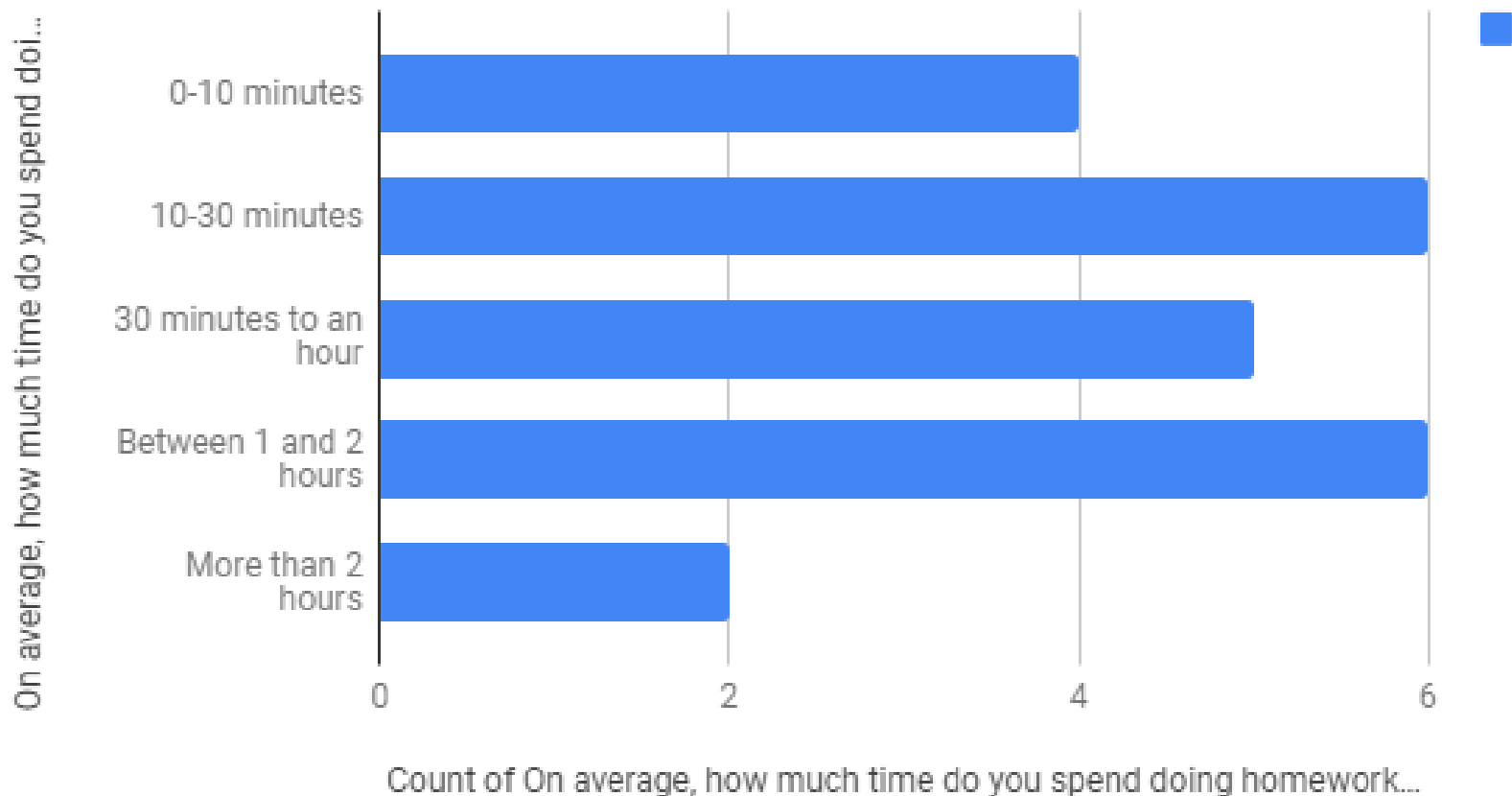

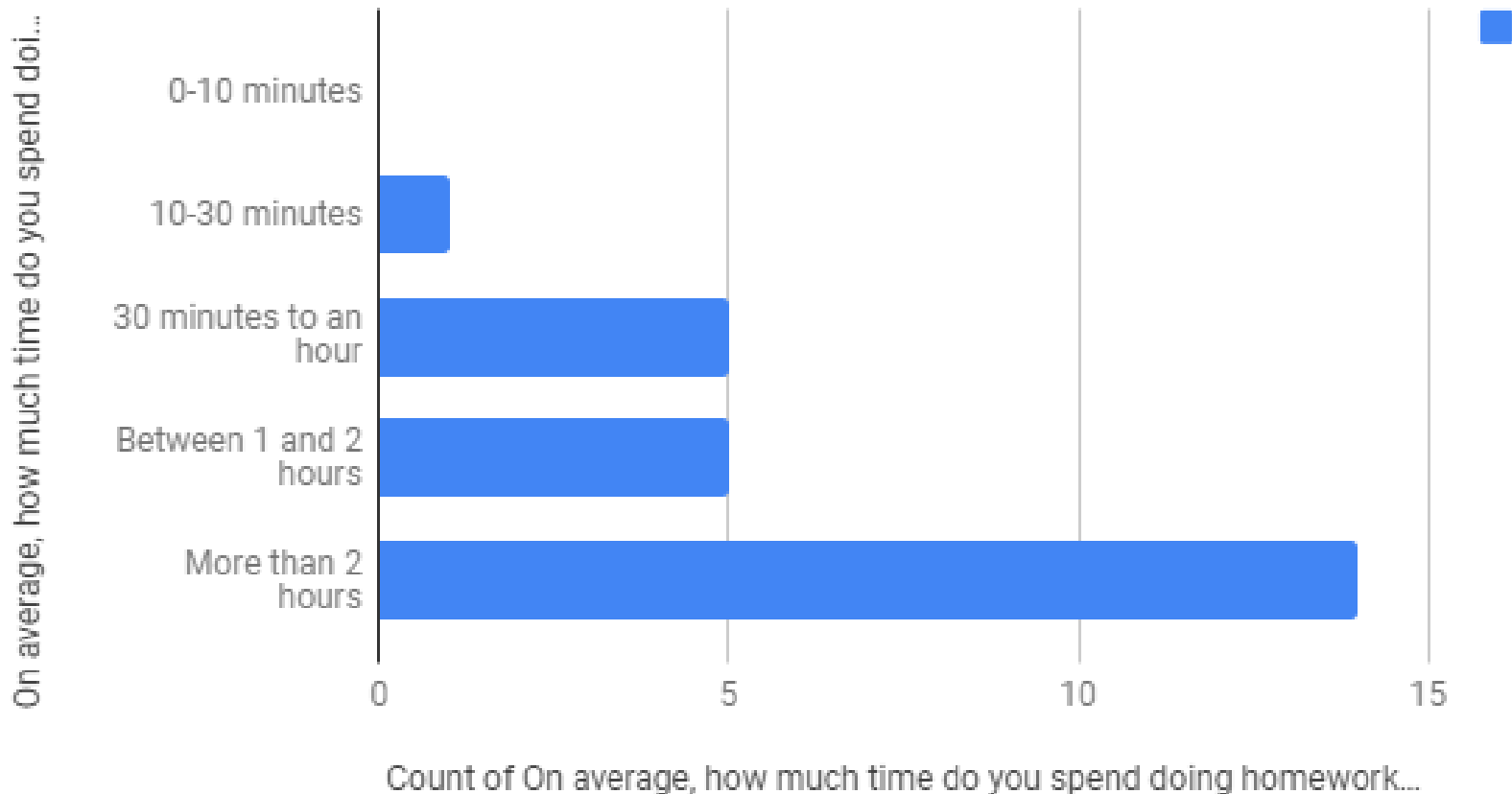
(Grade 6) Count of On average, how much time do you spend doing homework each night?



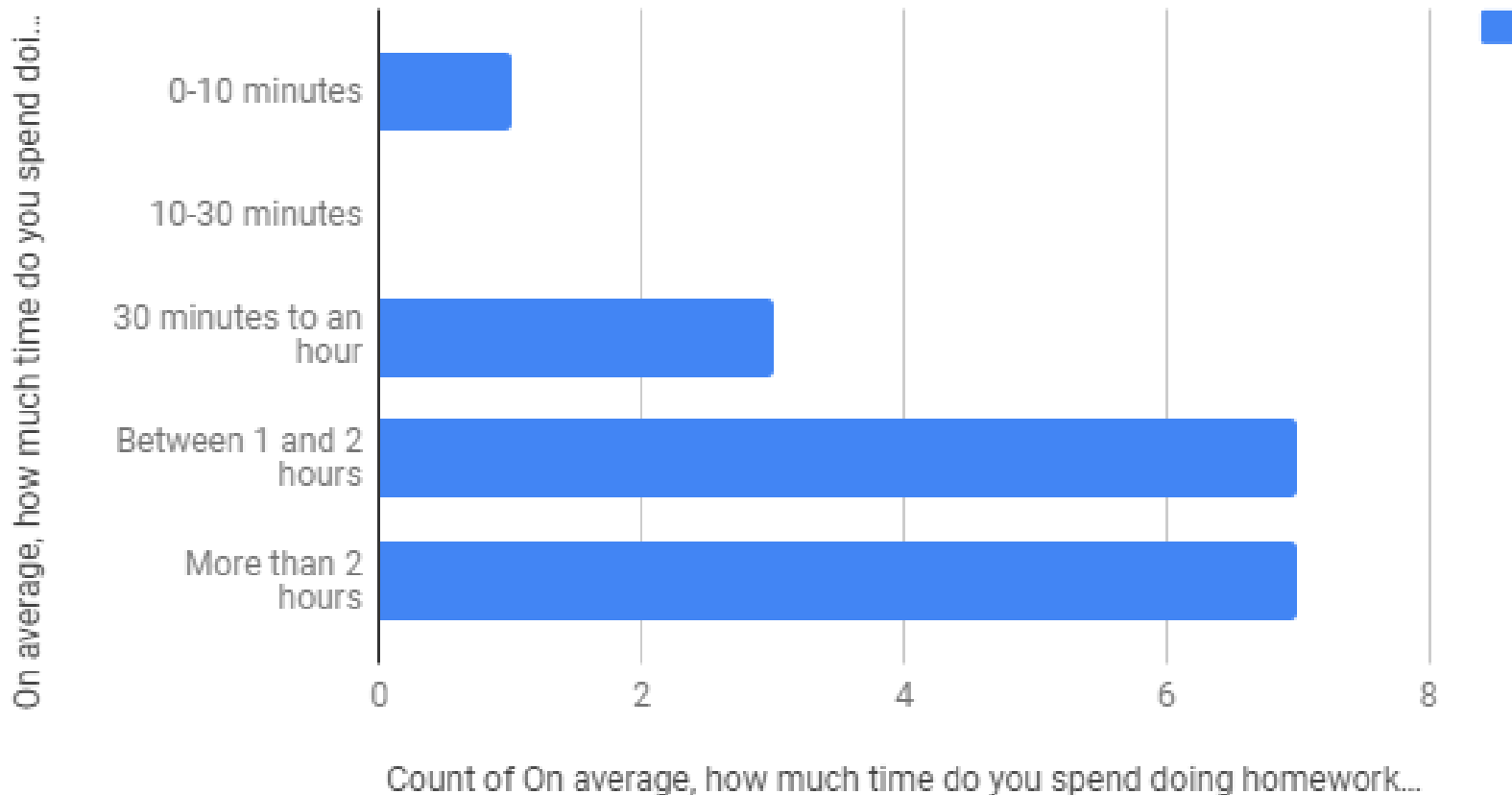
(Grade 7) Count of On average, how much time do you spend doing homework each night?



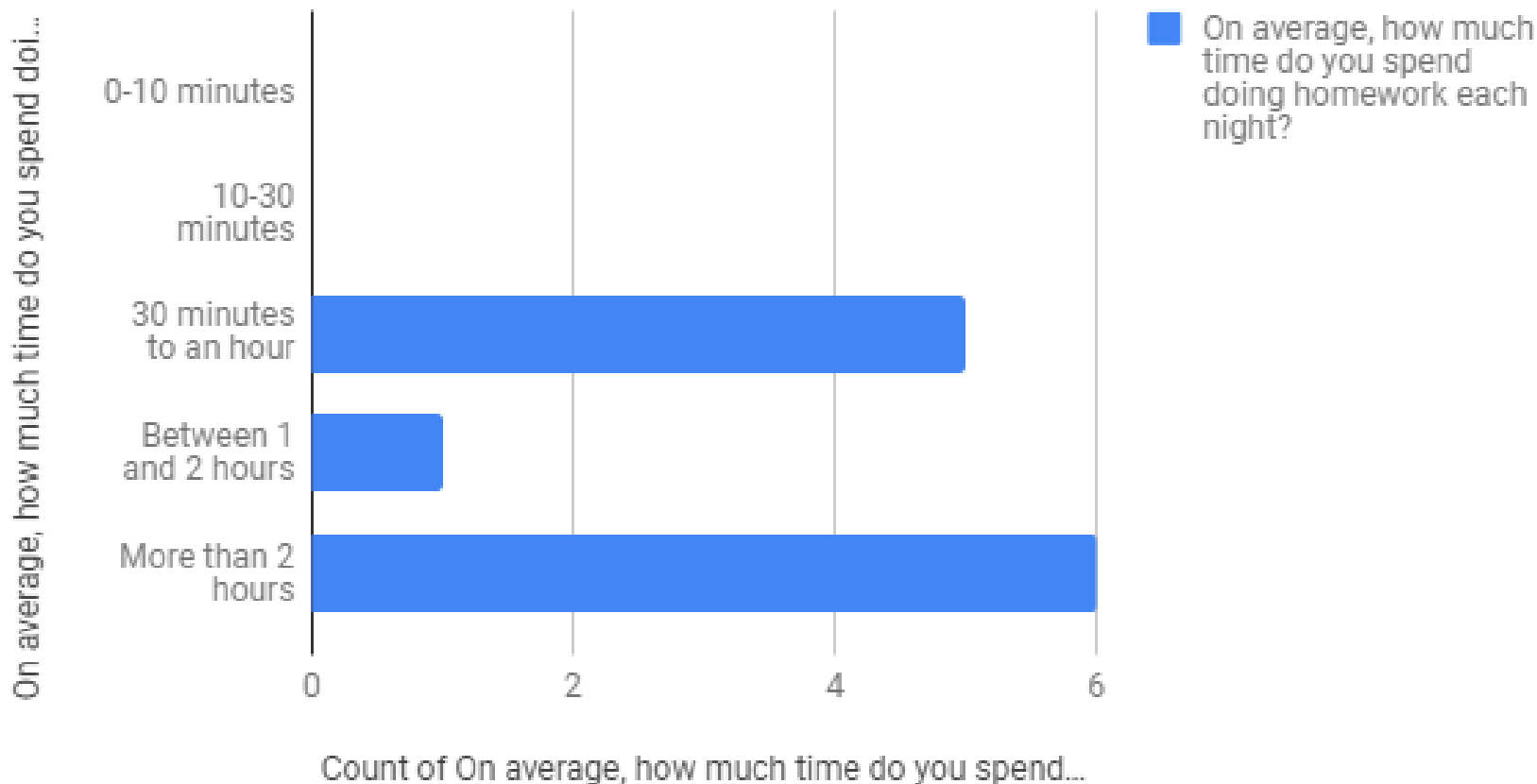
(Grade 8) Count of On average, how much time do you spend doing homework each night?



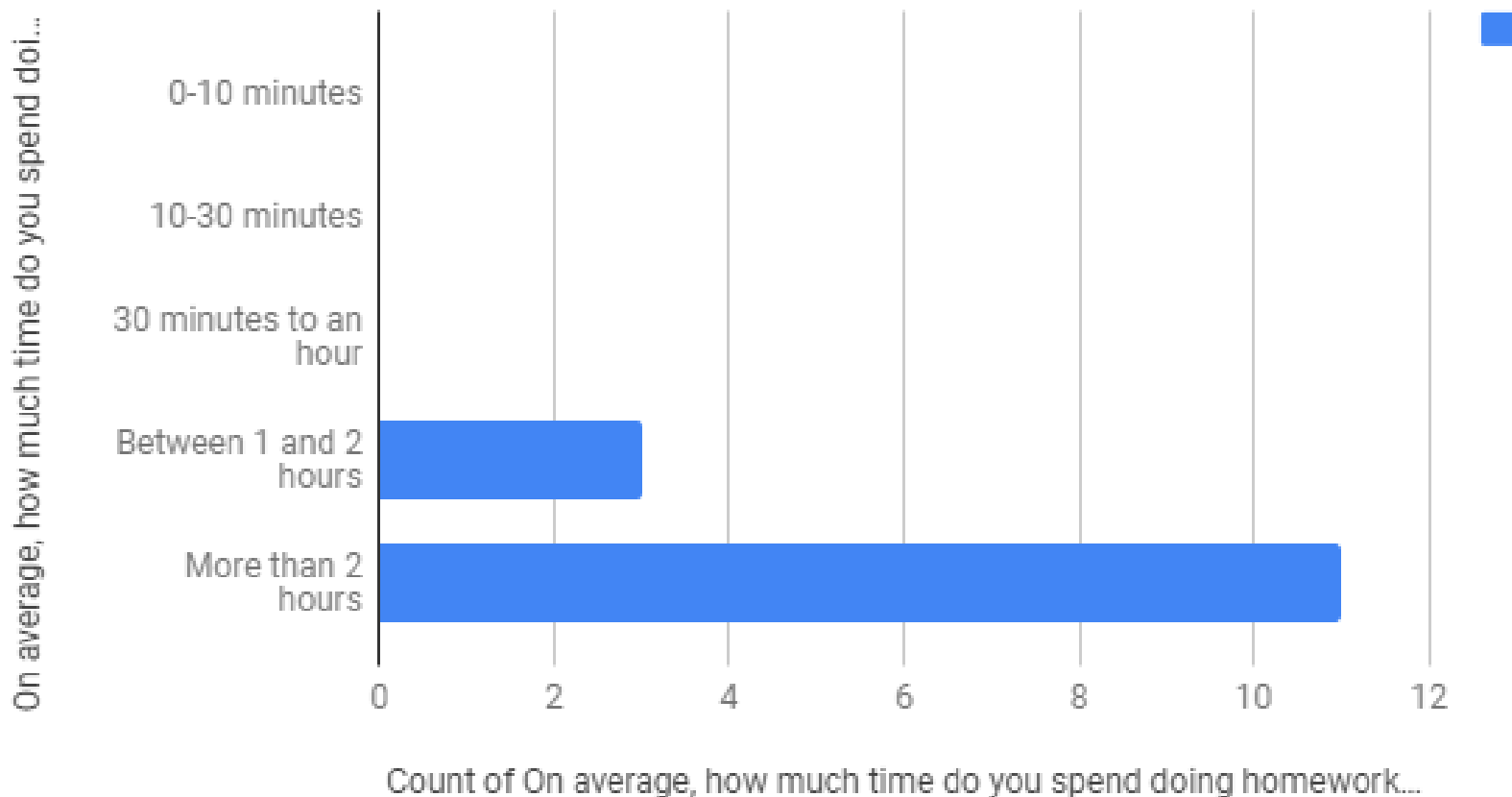
(Grade 9) Count of On average, how much time do you spend doing homework each night?



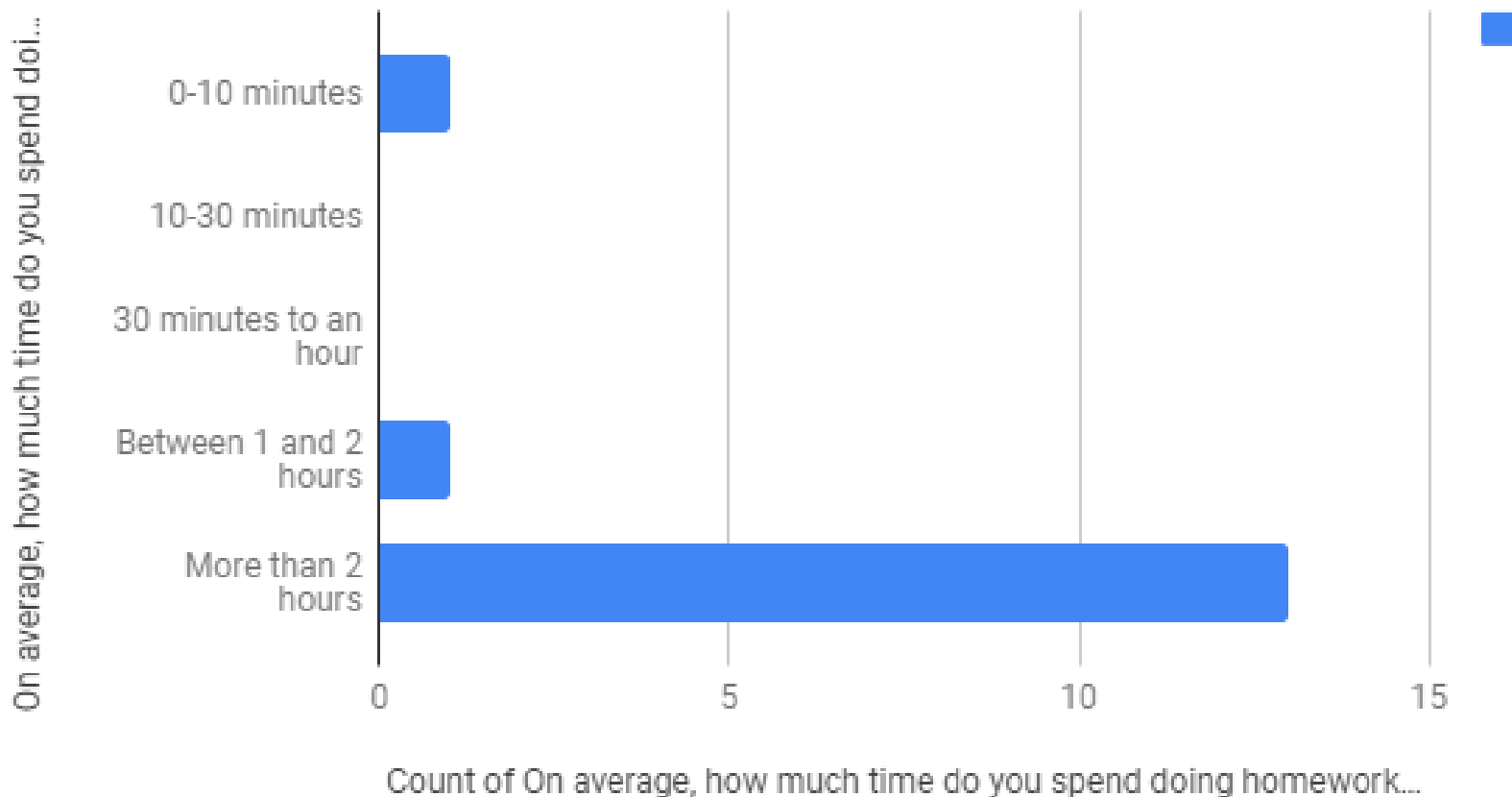
(Grade 10) Count of On average, how much time do you spend doing homework each night?



(Grade 11) Count of On average, how much time do you spend doing homework each night?

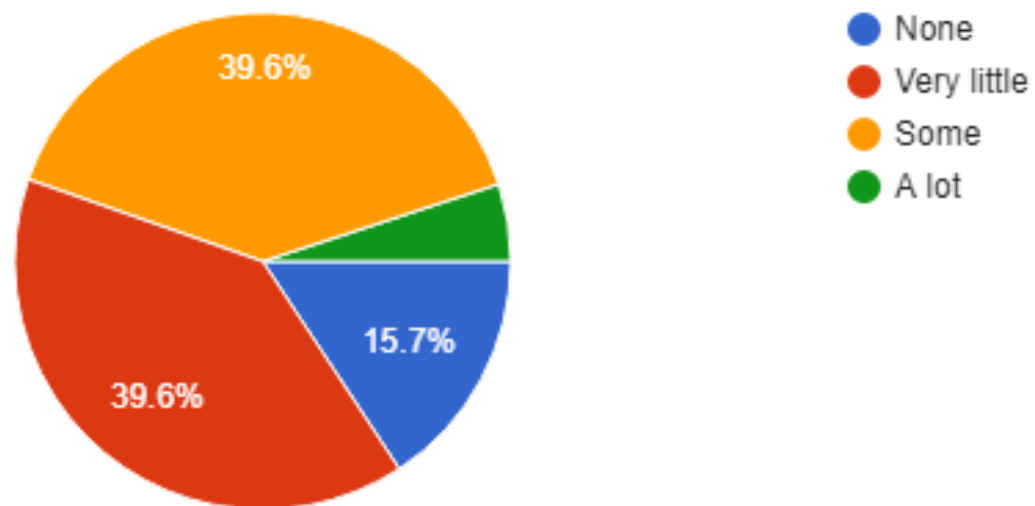


(Grade 12) Count of On average, how much time do you spend doing homework each night?



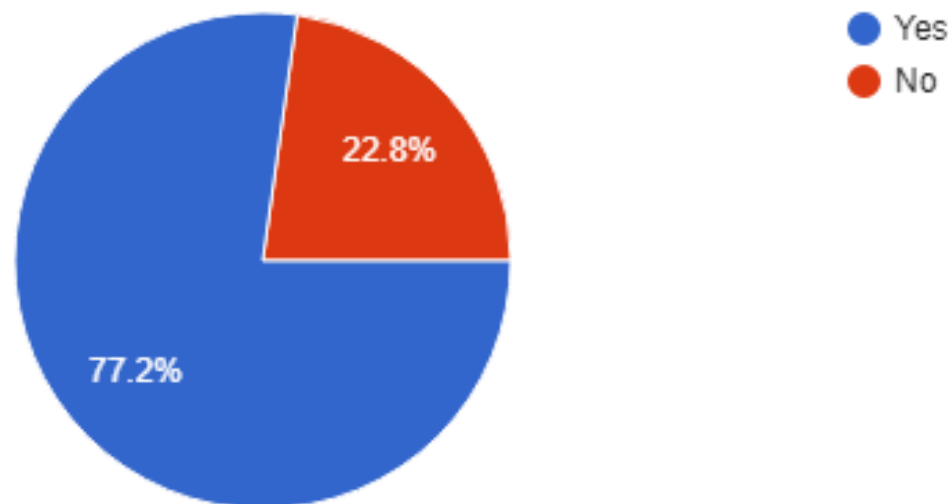
How much help do you need with your homework at home?

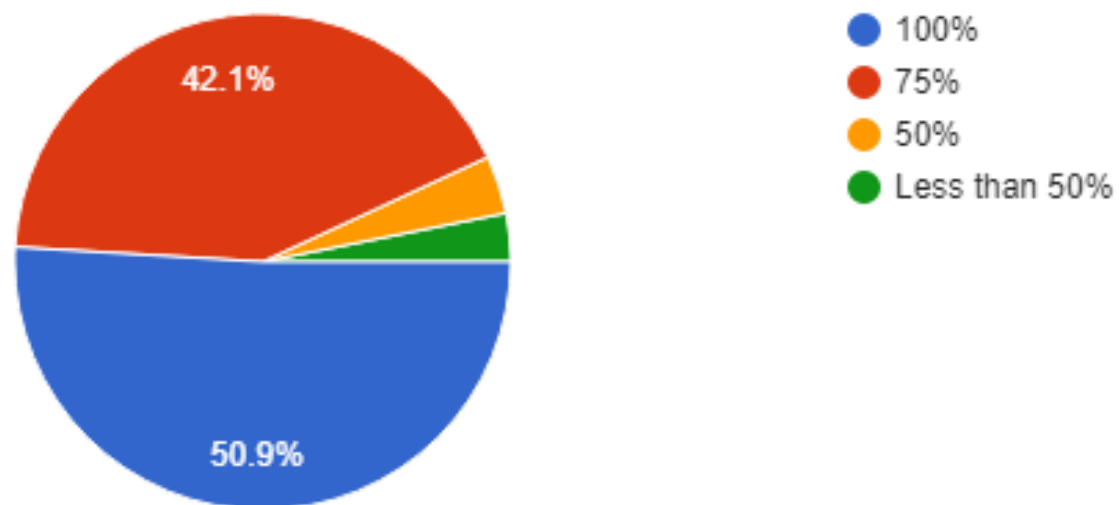
Do you have a quiet place to complete your homework at home?

7 Top Tips for setting and managing homework

1. Establish a firm routine
2. Gather parents' support
3. Avoid overnight homework
4. Don't dawdle with marking
5. Collect homework in the morning (or at earliest opportunity)
6. Reward effort
7. Consequences for lack of effort

Purposes for Homework

1. **Practice** (e.g., after the teacher has directly taught a math algorithm in class, the homework is to complete several problems requiring use of that algorithm).
2. **Preparation** (e.g., pre-reading or looking over a new unit of study in a text for the next class meeting).
3. **Study** (e.g., reviewing content to prepare for a test).
4. **Extend or elaborate** (e.g., completing a project or paper on a topic such as investigating the causes of the Vietnam War)
