Find the Tire Codes

The biggest error that consumers make is choosing the right tire. It is easy to see the code on the sidewall of your tire. The code is a combination number and letters. These codes are used to indicate the type, size and performance of your [tire](#).

It is important to measure the size of your object

When you do finally take the step to shop around the various tire shops, they will ask for the make, model and year of the car. You might have different sizes, too. You can choose to have bigger tires that can fill up the wheel or less costly tires.

Whatever you choose to do, ensure that the tires are able to meet the speed ratings. They should be able of handling your car at a specified maximum speed. Examine the sidewalls of your tires for these codes, or simply consult your owner's guide.

Decide What You Need for Replacement Tires
