Report Narrative **On 8-10-2015 at 0700 hours I was contacted by Sergeant Randy Berke, and advised that**



I needed to be enroute to the Detective Bureau reference a shooting that occurred at the Auburn Street Manor Apartments.

Upon arrival I meet with Detective A. Ashe, J. Joyes, D. Foulker, T. Zuczynski, and Sergeant Berke. Sergeant Berke advised us that on 8-09-2014 at 1140 hours there were two Metro Enforcement Security Guards that were shot at last night. Sergeant Berke advised that Metro Enforcement Officer Aaron Richter was stuck twice, once in the left leg and once in the left arm. Metro Enforcement Officer Joseph Naser was not injured in the incident. Sergeant Berke advised us that Metro Enforcement Officers approached Knox because they had known for him to be banned from the property. Knox got back into his vehicle that he arrived in and left the parking lot at a high rate of speed. Metro Enforcement Officer Richter and Naser proceeded to walk west bound through the parking lot when they started to take on gunfire. Sergeant Berke advised that there were no witnesses to be interviewed at the present time.

Sergeant Berke advised us that he wanted us to return to 4120 Auburn Street and conduct another check of the area for possible evidence now that it was daylight. I went to 4120 Auburn Street and proceeded to search the rear parking lot where this incident occurred with negative results. I then proceeded to help other Detectives search the area around the residence at 2319 Arthur Ave with negative results.

I was then advsied by Sergeant Berke that he wanted me to meet him at [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. Sergeant Berke advsied me that Officer Watson was there and she was speaking to Britnay Person. Officer Watson was currently involved in a investigation where Person was battered by Justin Knox, and she has a child by Knox. I asked Person when was the last time she had seen Knox. Person advised me that Knox does not come to her apartment. Person says that Officer Yalden came to her apartment last night looking for Knox. Person says that she told Yalden that Knox was not here, and that he might be at his other girlfriend's house. I asked Person if she had talked to Knox at any time last night. Person advised Sergeant Berke, Officer Watson and I that she called Knox last night and wanted to find out what he did, because he is that father of her 12 month old child. Person said that when she called him, she asked him if he had shot at anyone. Person says Knox told her that he was at North Main Manor and he seen the Metro Enforcement Officers there. Person says that Knox told her that he got up out of there. Person says that Knox left the property because he knew that he was banned from the property and had a warrant. Person says during the time she was talking to Knox he never stated that he shot at someone. Person says Knox told her that he messed up, he stated that he can't go back to Gail. Person says Knox then stated that he would take a Police Officer's gun away from them, and use it on them. Person said that Knox told her that he would be in contact with her when he touches down. I asked Person what did touch down mean. Person says that whenever he gets to where he is going.

Person advised me that Knox is crazy she says that Knox would get so mad and just start banging his head against the wall repeatedly. Person advised that she only dated Knox to get rid of another guy that she was dating. Person said that during the short time that



she was dating Knox she got pregnant. Person says that she wants Knox arrested for the beating her up. I issued Person my business card, and advised her to call me if she hears from Knox.

I returned to the Detective Bureau and assisted other Detectives on their follow up investigations in this case.

On 8-11-2014 at 1200 hours Detective P. Sarantopoulos and I went to Rockford Memorial Hospital to check on the condition of Arron Richter. We located Arron in his room and observed that he had been shot in the left leg and the left arm. Arron greeted both Detective Sarantopoulos and I with a hand shake. I asked Arron if he could go over and tell me the events that occurred that night. Arron stated that he was working with his partner Joseph Naser, and they were walking in the back parking lot of Auburn Manor Apartments. Arron says that he could hear music coming from a vehicle, and he seen the vehicle and recognized that the vehicle to be driven by a black male name Justin Knox. Arron said that he is familiar with Knox's vehicle and has seen him driving the vehicle before. Arron then advised me that Knox is banned from all Auburn Manor Property. Arron says that he and Naser hid behind a garbage dumpster as Knox drove into the back parking lot. Arron says that he heard Knox ask someone if they had seen the Metro Security Guards. Arron said that the unknown black male said no and Knox continued to drive his vehicle east bound into the parking lot. Arron says that once Knox stopped his vehicle and got out of the car, he and Naser approached Knox. Arron says that he was about 15 feet from Knox when he advised Knox that he was under arrest for Criminal trespass. Arron says that Knox stated "fuck you" and Knox got back into his vehicle, and left the parking lot at a high rate of speed. Knox says that he and Naser proceeded to walk back towards the office and within 90 seconds he heard gun shots. Arron says he then realized that he was shot in the left arm and the left leg. Arron says that they were able to get to cover behind a vehicle in the parking lot. Arron says once the shots had stopped they were able to get to the front entrance of one of the buildings and waited for then Police and Fire Department. I asked Arron if he had seen who was shooting at him and he stated he did not.

I then advised Arron that I had a photo line-up of some subjects that I wanted him to view. Prior to meeting the Arron I retrieved a photo of Knox from the Winnebago County Justice Center. I also retrieved five additional photos of persons from the Winnebago County Justice Center jail photos Offendertrak program who appeared to be about the same age, and had similar appearance. All photos were placed on one sheet of paper in two rows and three columns. I used the following photos, and numbered them on the front as follows:

I first issued Arron a Rockford Police Department Line-Up/ Photo Spread Notice form. I had Arron read the form and asked him if he understood then form. Arron advised that he understood the form and signed the form at 1210 hours. Detective Sarantopoulos and I also signed the form. I handed Arron the photos and told Arron to take his time viewing all of the photos prior to making any decisions, which he agreed. After viewing all of the photos, Arron pointed at #1 and stated "that looks like Knox but I'm not 100% sure". Arron looked at the photo a little longer and stated "no that's not him, no I don't think that's him". I recovered the photo line-up and later tagged it into the Property & Evidence Department tag #006.

Arron advised me again that he knows Knox because he has seen Knox before off the property while he was assisting Spinello Locksmiths on a lock out of Knox's vehicle. Arron then advised me that he also arrest Knox for criminal trespass in Fairgrounds Housing Development. Arron then showed me a photo on his phone that he had taken of Knox when he arrested him for criminal trespass. I asked Arron if he could email me the photo of Knox. I issued Arron my business card and advised him that If he remembers anything else later to contact me. Arron sent the photo to my work email address. I located the photo and printed it out and tagged it into evidence tag #014.

On 8-11-2014 I contacted Nykesha Jones who was the owner of the vehicle that Knox was driving that night. I advised Jones that I needed to speak to her reference the vehicle that Knox was driving. Jones advised me that she could meet with me at the Detective Bureau at 1430 hours. Jones arrived at the 1445 hours along with her mother. Detective Shelton and I spoke to Jones and advised her of our investigation. Jones advised me that she knows Knox and has been dating him since January of 2014. Jones says that Knox has been staying with her and he drives a black Chevy Impala. Jones says that she bought the car for Knox and let him drive it.

I asked Jones when was the last time she seen Knox. Jones said that she last seen him on Friday night 8-9-2014 around 2:30 pm. Knox says that the next time she heard from Knox was when he came back late that night around 1 O'clock in the morning. Jones says that the Police showed up at her apartment a little later and were knocking on her door. Jones said that she did not open the door because Knox told her not to. Jones says that she was afraid of what Knox might do to her if she did open the door. Jones said the Police impounded her vehicle that she bought for Knox, and left the area. Jones says that she waited for a while then left and went to a friend's house because she was afraid of Knox. I asked Jones if she knows where Knox is currently at. Jones advised me that she does not know where he is and has not heard from him after leaving the apartment Friday night.

I asked Jones if she would sign a consent to search form for her vehicle that was in our impound garage. Jones signed the form at 1500 hours and Detective Shelton and I also signed the form.

I asked Jones if she owned any firearms and she said that she did. Jones advised me that she bought a gun from Bullet Stop and the gun is at her house. I asked Jones if she possessed a valid void card and she stated that she did. I asked Jones if we could go back to her apartment and see if the gun is still there, and Jones advised that we could.

At 1530 hours Detective Posley and I followed Jones back to her apartment at [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. Upon arrival Jones advised us that she has not been back to her apartment since she left that night after the Police had impounded her vehicle. Jones proceeded to unlock the door to her apartment and we followed her inside. Once inside I observed that the apartment had been ransacked, and there were clothes scattered around the apartment. Jones proceeded to look into the closet where she keep the gun, and advised Detective Posley and I that the gun was not there. Jones advised that Knox must have taken it because he was the only other person that had a key to her apartment. I asked Jones if she had any paperwork on the gun and she advised me that none of the paper work is here. I asked Jones if there was anything else missing from her apartment and she stated no there was not. I advised Jones to contact Bullet Stop and obtain all the information on the gun that she purchased. I asked Jones if Knox was with her when she purchased the gun, and she advised me that he was not. I asked Knox why she purchased the gun, and she advised me that she purchased it for home protection. I advised Knox to contact me once she obtained all the information about the gun she purchased.

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On 8-12-2014 I was contacted by Brittney Person and she advised me that she had received a phone call from Knox. Person said that she thinks that **Knox is in Snellville Georgia living with his mother.** Person says that she does not know where Knox mother is living at. Person advised me that Knox called her form a cell phone number of ([REDACTED])-[REDACTED]. I advised Person to attempt to locate a address for Knox and to let me know, and she advised that she would.

I went to Bullet Stop Gun Shop located at 2100 Harlem Road in Loves Park. I spoke with one of the employees there and was able to locate all the paperwork for Jones purchasing the gun. **I discovered that the gun was a SCCY model # CPX-2 9mm serial number# 130385. Jones had purchased the gun on 7-31-2014.** I recovered all the paperwork and tagged it into evidence.

Detective Brad Shelton had obtained a search warrant for the vehicle that Knox was driving. See Detective Shelton supplement report for further details reference the search warrant and what was recovered.

Detective Shelton later advised me that he had located a gun manual for a SCCY Industries handgun, a small sealed brown envelope with the label on it for a **model CPX 9mm, Serial #130385** on the outside, with a **spent casing on the inside.** The test fire casing is included with the purchase of a handgun. These items were recovered by Detective Shimaitis and Voyles. See their supplement report for further details.

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At 15300 hours I was contacted by Nykesha Jones and she advised me that she located the original receipt for the purchase of the handgun. I meet with Jones at her mother's residence [REDACTED] and recovered the Receipt. I asked Jones if she has heard from Knox anymore and she advised that she has not. I later tagged the receipt into evidence.

On 8-19-2014 I received a email from Metro Enforcement Supervisor Larry Hodges with a case number of 14-600803. This was the case number that Metro Enforcement Officer Arron Richter had arrested Knox on for a warrant. See Rockford Poice Department case #13-004696 for further details.

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On 8-22-2014 at 1000 hours I meet with Metro Enforcement Officer Joseph Naser at the Detective Bureau. I advised Naser that I wanted to go over the events that occurred that night when Arron Richter was shot. Naser proceeded to give me a oral account as to what happened that night. Naser oral account was placed into a written statement form which started at 1015 hours. Naser reviewed the statement after it was completed and signed his name to the statement at 1137 advising that his statement was a true fact.

During the oral statement I advised Naser that I wanted to show him a photo line-up of some subjects. I used the same photo line-up that I used with Arron Richter. I had I.D Detective Bruce Voyles rearranged the pictures in the photo line-up so that it would not be in the same order that Arron Richter viewed. The photo line- up consisted in this order.

I first had Naser read the Rockford Police Department Line-Up/ Photo Spread Notice form, which I handed him. Naser read the form, said he understood the form, and signed the form at 1118 hours. Detective Shelton and I both signed the form.

I told Naser to take his time viewing all of the photos prior to making any decisions, which he agreed. I placed the photo line-up flat on the table in front of Naser. After viewing all of the photos, Naser immediately pointed to Photo #5 Justin Knox and stated that's Knox. Naser stated that this is the guy that he and Officer Arron Richter approached in the parking lot, and advised that he was under arrest for trespassing. I had Naser place a circle around the photo that he recognized, and had him place his signature in the circled photo of Knox. I then had Naser initial all the photos on the back advising that he viewed all the photos. I later tagged the photo line-up into Property & Evidence, tag 015.

On 9-2-2014 I was contacted by Detective Brian Shimaitis and he advised me that he had



processed a 9mm SCCY CPX-2 handgun that was recovered during a traffic stop by an Officer on 8-31-2014. For more details reference the traffic stop see case #14-102240. Detective Shimaitis advised me that he was going to send the gun to the State Crime Lab, and have them compare it with the casings that were recovered at the scene on Auburn Manor.

On 9-8-2014 at 1000 hours I meet with Officer Arron Richter at the Detective Bureau in the Public Safety Building. Richter at that time gave me a oral account as to what had happened that night he wa shot. Richter oral account was placed into a written statement form starting at 1010 hours. Once the statement was completed I advsied Richter to look over the statement and to see if any changes needed to be made or any corrections. Richter looked over the statement and signed the statement as being a true fact at 1153 hours.

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On 9-30-2014 I had received a copy of the Illinois State Police crime lab report. The report identified the handgun from case #14-102240 as the same gun that fired the rounds, and the casings were recovered from the Auburn Manor shooting. The gun was also found to be the same gun that fired the test fired round that was located inside of Knox's vehicle.

On 10-7-2014 I reviewed the case #14-102240 where the 9mm handgun was located during a traffic stop. I discovered that Raymon Smith was charged for possessing the firearm, and currently lodged in the Winnebago County Jail. Detective Brad Shelton and I went to the Jail and spoke with Smith reference where he had purchased the firearm.

Upon meeting Smith in one of the Winnebago County Jail interview rooms, I introduced myself along with Detective Brad Shelton. I advised Smith of my investigation and asked him if he would like to speak to us about this incident. Smith stated that he would. I then provided Smith with his Miranda rights. This was done by utilizing two preprinted Rockford Police Department rights forms. I placed one form in front of Smith, and I maintained one form in front of me. I first had Smith read the beginning sentence of the form aloud which he did without difficulty. I then asked Smith if he understood what he just read. Smith advised me that he understood. I then proceeded to read the rights form to him as he followed. After each sentence was read to Smith he placed his handwritten initials at the end of the section on the form in front of him to indicate that it was covered. On the form that I was utilizing I placed check marks at the beginning of each reviewed section. He next read the final sentence aloud. After the form was properly reviewed with Smith he placed his signature on both of the rights forms at 0930 hours. Detective Smith and I both signed the forms at 0930 hours.

Smith proceeded to advise me that the gun was not his. Smith stated that he was at a party on the west side near Mulberry and Willard. Smith says that the pe3ople that he went to the party with left and he was stranded there at the party. Smith says that he seen Jason a friend of his that he use to work with at P.C.I. Smith says that Jasone gave him a ride to his car on the east side of town. Smith says that he was sitting in the front

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passanger seat and there were three other black males sitting in the back seat. Smith says that he puled the seat up to give the guys in the back some leg room. Smith says that he was not suree who the guys sitting in the back seat were. On 08/11/14, at about 1045 hours, I along with Sergeants Randall Detectives Sarantopolous, Beets, J. Gulley, Asche and Shelton attended a briefing headed by Sergeant Berke in reference to a shooting incident that occurred in Auburn Manor Apartment Complex involving Metro Enforcement Security Officers.

Sergeant Berke advised that Metro Enforcement Security Officer Aaron Richter and his partner, Joseph Naser were on foot patrol when they encountered Justin Knox, who Richter knew was banned from the Auburn Manor Apartment Complex. Sergeant Berke advised that Justin Knox was able to get back to his vehicle and flee the area before Richter and Naser could take him (Knox) into custody. Sergeant Berke informed us as the Richter and Naser walked west through the parking lot an unknown subject(s) south of their location began shooting a gun in their direction. During this incident, Richter was struck 2 times, once in the leg and once in the arm. Officer's later located 9mm shell casing in the area of where the shooter stood at the time of the shooting.

Prior to going to locate Mclaurin, I conducted a Net- Rms check on Mclaurin name, and learned that she had reported a 9mm Hi-Point Luger handgun stolen sometime between 3/7/2014 and 3/10/2014 (14-026330) from her apartment.

At about 1145 hours, Detective Schroder and I went to [REDACTED] to speak with Diane Mclaurin in reference this incident. After several attempts of knocking on Mclaurin apartment door met with negative results, I decided to call the listed telephone number listed on the theft of handgun report she filed on 3/11/2014. A female who identified herself as Diane Mclaurin answered the phone. I informed Mclaurin that I was at her apartment and needed to speak with her about the shooting incident that occurred outside of her complex. Mclaurin stated that she did not need nor was she going to speak with us about the shooting, because the incident did not involve nor concern

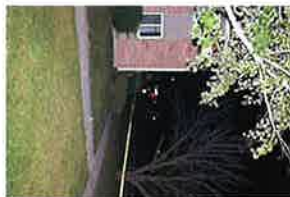

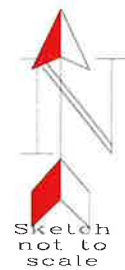
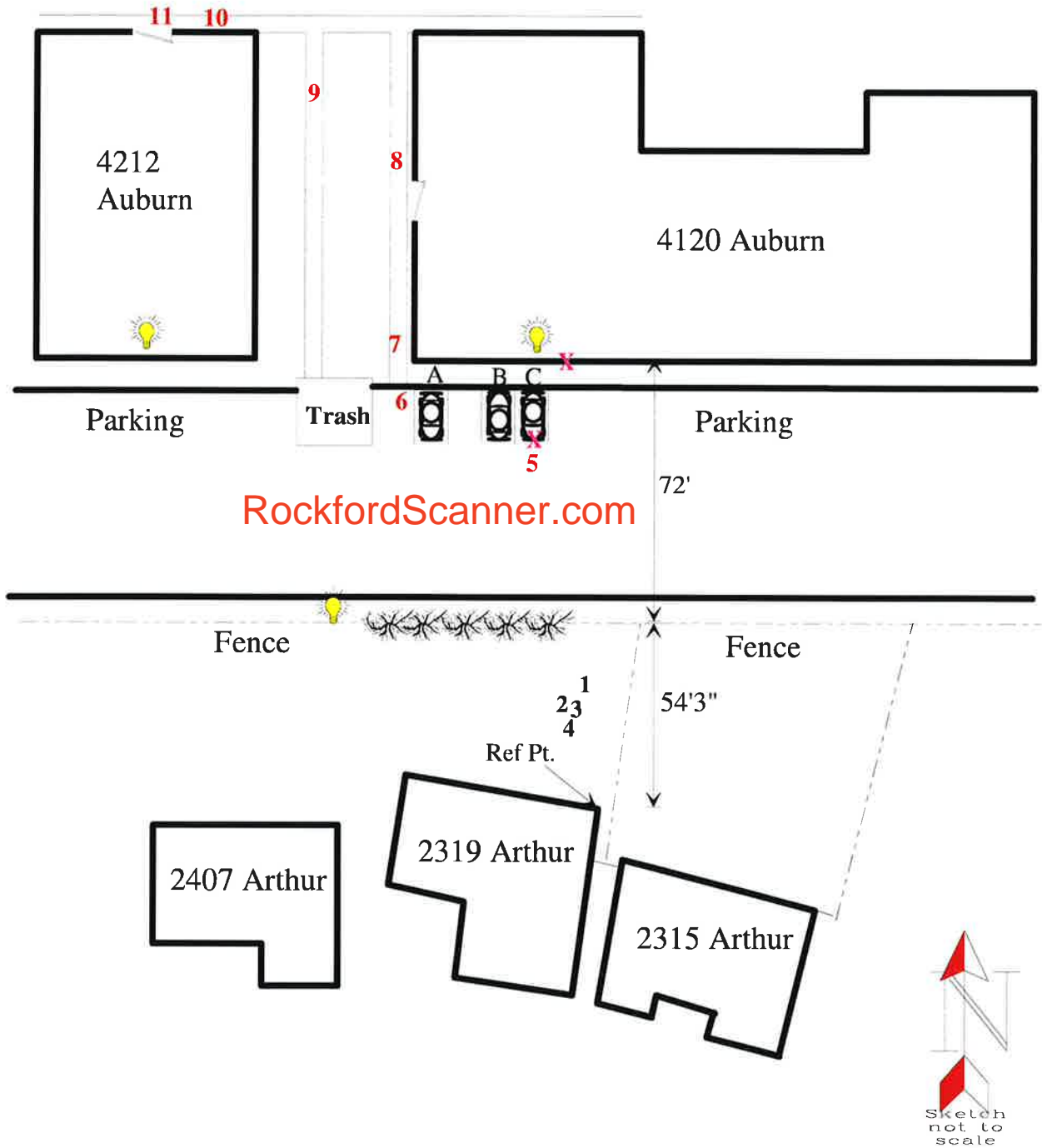

I had just recently started with Metro Enforcement and this was my 5th day on the job. gn

gn Officer Richter and I were walking in the back parking lot in the 4100 block of Auburn Street. Officer Richter observed a black Chevy Impala turning into the parking lot and traveling east bound. Officer Richter had known the Impala to belong to a Justin Knox. Officer Richter had known Knox from prior incidents where he was arrested for criminal trespass. The vehicle continued to travel east bound, and Officer Richter observed the license plate on the vehicle and confirmed that it was the vehicle that Knox drives. gn **RockfordScanner.com**

AR My name is Aaron Richter, Ave and I live at _____. I am currently working at Metro Enforcement Security Company, and I have been employed there for over a year now. On 8-9-2014 around 1140 hours I was on foot patrol in the rear parking lot of the Auburn Manor Apartments which is located in the 4000 Block of Auburn Street. I was working along with Joseph Naser who was my partner for that shift. My duties include patrolling the parking lot for suspicious and illegal activity. AR **RockfordScanner.com**

AR Officer Naser and I were walking in the back parking lot and I could hear music coming from a vehicle. I then observed a vehicle approaching the parking lot and I had known this vehicle to belong to a black male I know as Justin Knox. I have Known Knox from prior arrest for criminal trespass to the Auburn Manor Apartment Property. I observed Knox pulling into the parking lot in the same vehicle that he drives all the time which is a black 2000 Chevy Impala. I remember the car because I assisted Spinello Lock Services earlier this year with a vehicle lock out that involved Justin Knox near the intersection of Furman and Sherman. AR

AR Knox proceeded to drive east bound through the parking lot and Officer Naser and I hid behind a garbage dumpster that was located near the apartment building at 4120 Auburn Street. I observe Knox drive to the east end of the parking lot, and then drive back to the west end of the parking lot. I then heard Knox ask another black male if he had seen the "Metros" out. The unknown black male looked directly at Officer Naser and I and stated "I don't know nothing about that and I am not even from around here". The black male continued to walk west bound towards Johnson Ave. I then observed Knox drive his vehicle in reverse and parked next to the very closest parking stall next to the dumpster. AR

AR Knox proceeded to exit his vehicle and Officer Naser and I proceeded to approach Knox from behind the dumpster. Upon approaching Knox to advise him that he was under arrest for trespassing, I advised him to place his hands behind his back. I was standing about 10 to 15 feet away from Knox when I advised him to put his hands behind his back. Knox looked directly at me and stated "fuck that" and he got back into his vehicle and drove west bound out of the parking lot. I then observed Knox stop next to the unknown black male that he asked if he had seen the Metro's, and I heard a short argument and Knox drove off south bound on Johnson Ave. The unknown black male continued to walk in unknown direction. I then heard gun shots and could tell that they were coming from behind us. That's when I noticed that I had been shot in my leg and my arm. I took cover behind a vehicle that was parked in the parking lot beyond the west end of the 4120 building. I took cover behind the passenger door of the vehicle, and Officer Naser went to the back of the vehicle. After the shots stopped I was advised Naser that we had to get to the Office Building. I proceeded to run towards the Apartment building, as I was advising my other units on our radio that shots were fired and I was hit. AR

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AR I was able to make it to the office building at 4212 Auburn Street and I was able to get inside the doorway and then I continued to let other Metro Officers know that I was hit. Within minutes Other Officers from the Metro Enforcement arrived, along with Winnebago County Deputies, and then Rockford Police and Fire arrived. AR

After first being duly sworn on oath I, Detective Bradley J. Shelton do depose and state the following:

That I am a police officer with the City of Rockford Police Department and have been so employed for the twenty-two years. I have been a Detective for the past 7 years and currently assigned to the Rockford Police Gang Crimes Unit. Prior to being a member of the Rockford Police Gang Crimes Unit, I was assigned to the Rockford Police Youth/ Sex Crimes Unit and Rockford Police General Case Division. Prior to that, I was assigned to the M3 Streets Team for one year, and prior to that, the Bicycle Unit for five years, and in patrol for 10 years.

My duties as a member of the Rockford Police Department Gang Crimes Unit include the investigations and enforcement of all gang activity including murder, aggravated battery with firearm investigations, and other weapon offenses.

On March 10th, 2014, at 1527 hours, Officers Stec and Toepfer responded to in reference a domestic battery and spoke with the victim, Brittany P. Person. Person reported she got into an argument with her ex-boyfriend, Justin Knox. Person said she has an old child, named with Justin Knox. Person reported she got into an argument with Justin Knox Sr and he grabbed her hair with both hands and shook her head several times. Person said Justin Knox Sr left when she called the police. Person told Officer Toepfer that Justin Knox Sr often deals heroin and may have a hand gun in his possession. I'm aware of this incident from reading Officer Toepfer's police report, Case 14-026087.1.

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On March 11th, 2014, at 1200 hours, Brittany Person arrived at the front desk of the Public Safety Building in reference to threatening phone calls. Person reported that Justin Knox posted a photo on his Facebook page and tagged Person on 03-11-14, at 1145 hours. This picture was of a bottle of Grey Goose Vodka, black handgun, loaded magazine, and gold front tooth grill. Person reported the teeth belong to Justin Knox and felt this post was a threat on her life. Person feels this threat was from her calling the police on 03-10-14. A copy of this photo was attached to the police report. Person stated that Justin Knox called her three times this same day saying "Why are you trying to put me in jail? I'm going to do what I gotta do to keep me out of jail." Person felt these were additional threats on her life. I know of this report from reading Central Reporting Officer Betsy McIntosh's report, Case 14-026391.1.

On May 19th, 2014, at 1807 hours, Officer Lange and Wadsworth responded to in reference a domestic battery and met with complainants Brittney Person and Renee Hollins. Officer

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Wadsworth spoke with Hollins. Hollins stated she was at Persons residence at when Person's ex-boyfriend, Justin Knox, came over but she got him to leave. Hollins said a while later Justin Knox came back over to see Person. Hollins said they got him to leave again but knew there would be trouble if he returns again. Hollins said there was a male at the residence with her and Person but she declined to provide his name. Hollins said they left to give the male a ride home and returned to Persons residence. Hollins said when she was got there Justin Knox was already there. She said she was by the front gate when Justin Knox jumped the chain link fence around the yard and ran up to her. Hollins said Justin Knox slapped her in the face knocking her to the ground. She said while on the ground, Justin Knox pulled out his black gun and put it in her face. Hollins described the gun as being like the one Officer Wadsworth carries. Hollins said while he had the gun in her face he said, "bitch don't bring no niggas round my son". Hollins told Justin Knox she had nothing to do with it. Hollins slapped the gun out of her face and Justin Knox ran toward the back of the house. She said a short time later she saw Justin Knox leave in a black Chevy Impala. I'm aware of this information from reading Officer Wadsworth original report, Case 14-055097.1.

Officer Lange spoke with Brittany Person who said her ex-boyfriend, Justin Knox, arrived in a black Chevy Impala. She said there was a male friend there and she knew there would be problems if Knox saw her male friend so she made up a story to get him away from the residence so she could have Hollins taker her friend home. Person said when Hollins returned Knox ran toward Hollins, jumped the fence, and started to punch Hollins in the face. Person said when she saw this she was inside her residence and locked the doors because she was in fear Knox would batter her. She called 911. Person said Knox came to the rear door and pushed his way into the apartment and punched her around 20 times all over her upper body and face. Person said her brother grabbed ahold of Knox to break them up and Knox fled the residence and left in the black vehicle he arrived in. I know this information from reading Officer Lange's supplement report, Case 14-055097.3.

On July 7th, 2014, Officers responded to _____ on three different times for home invasions. At 0133 hours, Brittany Persons called the police because she woke to her boyfriend, "Michael", being beat up by Justin Knox, who is her child's father. Michael ran out of the bedroom and Justin Knox started punching Person in the arm and head. Person said she left out the residence and Knox followed her. Person reported that Knox owns a black, older, Chevy Impala with temporary license plates but she didn't know the correct plate numbers. At 0352 hours, Person called the police back to say Knox was circling her residence. I'm aware of this incident from reading Officer Harper's original report, Case 14-077353.1.

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On July 7th, 2014, at 0900 hours, Officers Wheeler and Drager responded to _____ for a fight in progress. Officer Drager spoke with Brittany Person who said she was upstairs sleeping when she woke to Justin Knox standing over her bed. She said Knox was standing over her as she lay in bed. She said he grabbed her by the mouth and then held his fist to her face and said, "Don't yell, shut up bitch I'm going to kill you". Person said she complied for a couple minutes but then started to fight back. She said Knox threw her around by her hair and punched her repeatedly in the face, head, and body. Person was able to get away and get outside to yell for her sister, Courtney Person, to call the police. I'm aware of this by reading Officer Drager's report, Case 14-077410.1.

On July 7th, 2014, at 1038 hours, Officer Watson responded to _____ in reference to a domestic dispute. Brittany Person advised Justin Knox had kicked in the rear, north door to her

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residence and this was the third time today. She said Knox came inside so she ran toward the front stairs to get out. She saw Knox exit the back door and go to his car. He threw two bottles and Person told him the police were coming. Knox told her, "bitch, Ill kill you. They won't find me. I'll keep coming back and I won't stop until you die." The neighbor, Starnisha Stoeklin, witnessed Knox get into a black older Chevy Impala, unknown plate, and leave. Courtney Person, Brittany's sister, saw Knox leave in his black older Chevy Impala with temporary registration. I know of this from reading Officer Watson's report, Case 14-077441.1 and from the statement Officer Watson took from Brittany Person.

On July 8th, 2014, Detective Sarantopoulos obtained a warrant for Justin Knox for Home Invasion, Criminal Trespass to Residence, and Domestic Battery. I know this from reading Det. Sarantopoulos's supplement report, Case 14-077353.2.

On July 21st, 2014, at 1350 hours, Officer Kaya, who knows Justin Knox on sight, saw Knox driving a black Chevy Impala, registration at 11th St and 12th Ave. Officer Kaya knew Knox was wanted on an outstanding warrant and had a revoked driver's license. Officer Kaya, who was driving a marked police vehicle attempted to stop Knox by activating the emergency lights but Knox fled at a high rate of speed eastbound on Broadway. I know this information from reviewing Officer Kaya's report, Case 14-083824.1.

On July 27th, 2014, at 1441 hours, Officers Curran and Deutsch were at 2900 W. State St when Officer Deutsch observed Justin Knox and told Officer Curran that Knox was wanted on warrants. Officer Deutsch recognized Knox from prior police contacts. Officer Deutsch pointed at Knox and told Officer Curran to stop him. Officers Curran and Deutsch observed Knox get into a black Chevy Impala, registration , while Officer Curran yelled repeatedly to stop. Knox looked at Officer Curran who was wearing full police uniform and then started backing up the Chevy Impala. Knox drove away at a high rate of speed southbound on Willard. Officer Deutsch was able to obtain the registration and relayed this to dispatch. Officer Curran and Deutsch checked the area but were unable to locate Knox or the vehicle. Officer Deutsch confirmed Knox had a revoked driver's license and two outstanding warrants, Case 14-077353 and 14-055097. I know this to be correct from reading Officer Curran's police report, Case 14-086527.1 and Officer Deutsch's supplement report, Case 14-086527.2.

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On August 2nd, 2014, at 0144 hours, Officers Pofelski and Strawser responded to the alley area just south of 1300 Sherman in an attempt to locate a wanted subject, Justin Knox, who was to be inside a black Chevy product with registration Metro Enforcement Security Officer Aaron Richter called dispatch to say they assisted Spinello's Locksmith in unlocking a vehicle for Justin Knox and thought he was wanted on a warrant. Metro Enforcement Security Officer Richter said the vehicle was a black 2000 Chevy Malibu with registration it was parked in the back alley. Officers Pofelski and Strawser observed a black vehicle driving eastbound in the alley in the middle of the block toward Bluefield with no head lights. They drove behind this vehicle while it continued southbound on Bluefield without headlights. Officers Pofelski and Strawser were able to verify the registration was but were unable to see the driver. Officers Pofelski and Strawser activated their emergency lights in an attempt to stop the vehicle but it fled eastbound on Fairview toward Avon. Officers Pofelski and Strawser deactivated their emergency lights and did not

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pursue. Officer Pofelski reported the vehicle was a black 2000 Chevy Impala, four door, with registration . Officers Pofelski and Strawser confirmed Justin Knox was wanted on two warrants. I know this information from reading Officer Pofelski's police report, Case 14-089115.1.

On August 9th, 2014, at 2340 hours, Officers from the Rockford Police Department responded to 4212 Auburn St reference a Metro Enforcement Security Officer had been shot. Police Officers located Metro Enforcement Security Officer Aaron Richter lying on the ground with blood near his legs from an apparent gunshot wound. The Rockford Fire Department transported Richter to Rockford Memorial Hospital. Officer Harper spoke with Metro Enforcement Security Officer Joseph Naser who said he was working with Richter and at the east end of 4120 Auburn St when Security Officer Richter noticed Justin Knox driving a black Chevy Impala and knew Knox was banned from the property. Knox parked the vehicle at the east end of 4120 Auburn St and got out of the vehicle. Richter and Naser went to approach Knox but he got back into the vehicle and drove away south on N. Johnston Ave. They advised Knox was the only occupant in the vehicle. Security Officer Naser explained the resumed foot patrol and walked toward the west end of the building at 4120 Auburn St. About 1 to 2 minutes after Knox drove away there were 4 or 5 shots being fired from a tree line directly south of where they were standing. Naser said they took cover behind parked vehicles until the shots stopped and Richter said, "I'm hit". Naser escorted Richter to the front of 4212 Auburn St and went inside. Naser described Knox as a black male, years old, medium length gray and black hair with full beard, wearing a white tank top and black shorts. Officer Harper said casings were found in the backyard of 2319 Arthur Ave. Officer Harper checked previous Records Management System(RMS) reports and located a Chevy Impala, registration owned by Nykesha Jones at I know this from reading Officer Harper's original report, Case #14-092566.1.

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Officers Jury and Fitzgerald responded to 4212 Auburn St. Officer Fitzgerald located Security Officer Aaron Richter on the ground screaming that his arm was broken and with blood around his legs. Officer Fitzgerald provided medical assistance until the Rockford Fire Department arrived on scene and transported Richter to the hospital. Officer Fitzgerald went to Rockford Memorial Hospital and spoke with Metro Enforcement Security Officer Richter. Richter explained he and his partner, Joseph Naser, were in the back parking lot of the Auburn Manor apartments near the 4104 building when he saw a subject he recognized on sight and knew to be wanted by the Rockford Police and banned from the property. He advised this was Justin Knox. Richter said he saw Knox exit a black Chevy Impala, plate : that was parked in the parking lot. Richter said they went to approach Knox, but Knox got back into the vehicle and drove westbound through the parking lot and then south on N. Johnston Ave. Richter said he and Naser continued their foot patrol walking westbound through the back parking lot. Richter said about 1-2 minutes after Knox left he heard about 5 to 6 gunshots being fired from a tree line just south of their location. Richter said he fell to the ground and dragged himself behind a nearby vehicle for cover. Richter advised he didn't see who shot him but believed the shooter was Knox because they had just encountered him moments before. Officer Fitzgerald learned from hospital staff that Richter had two gunshot wounds, one to the back of his left bicep which shattered his arm, and one to the outer side of the back of his left knee/thigh area, which appeared to have hit an artery. Officer Fitzgerald was told the wounds were serious but non-life threatening. I know this from reading Officer Fitzgerald's supplement report, Case 14-092566.9.

Officers Jury and Fitzgerald checked various databases(RMS, LEADS, Accurint, etc) in order to obtain further information on the suspect, suspect vehicle, vehicle's registered owner, and the

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suspects possible location. They found possible phone numbers and address for Nykesha Jones being . They were unable to reach Jones by phone contact. I know this from reading Officer Fitzgerald's supplement report, Case #14-092566.8.

On August 10th, 2014, at 0028 hours, Officers Spriggs and Scharlau learned from Sergeant Torrance that the registered owner of the Chevy Impala, Nykesha Jones, was staying at . Officers Spriggs and Scharlau went to check this residence. Officers Spriggs and Scharlau drove to the alley behind this residence and observed two black male subjects standing in the parking lot and one of larger build matched the description of the suspect, Justin Knox, but was wearing a white tank top and light colored basketball shorts. Officer Scharlau shined his flashlight at the subjects and the larger of the two began to walk toward the residence. This same subject then looked at Officers Spriggs and Scharlau and then ran east toward the north side of the building. Officers Spriggs and Scharlau lost sight of him and were unable to locate him and were unable to reach Nykesha Jones at her residence. I know this from reading Officer Scharlau's supplement report, Case 14-092566.7 and the Call for Service, Case #14-092580, which shows information entered by dispatch.

Officers Jury and Fitzgerald were assisting Officer Spriggs and Scharlau in looking for the black male who fled on foot and were driving south at 1300 12th St. They located the black Chevy Impala, plate , parked on the street facing northbound, unoccupied, directly across from

Officers Jury and Fitzgerald sat from a distance away to observe this vehicle to see if anyone would return but after about an hour a track from Belvidere K-9 was attempted with negative results. Sergeant Torrance advised Officers Jury and Fitzgerald to impound the Chevy Impala and at 0146 hours Haas Towing was called by dispatch. Officer Fitzgerald found the Chevy Impala to be locked and could see a black t-shirt and what appeared to be a handgun manual inside the car. Haas Towing arrived and towed the Chevy Impala to the 2nd St garage and Officers Jury and Fitzgerald followed him. The Chevy Impala was secured in the Rockford Police Department 2nd St garage. Officer Fitzgerald noted this vehicle has been involved in numerous fleeing incidents, Rockford Police Cases, #14-083824, 14-086527, and 14-089115. I know of this information from reading Officer Fitzgerald's supplement report, Case 14-092566.8.

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On August 10th, 2014, around 0430 hours, Officer A. DeBoer went to Rockford Memorial Hospital and collected a spent bullet that was removed from Metro Enforcement Security Officer Richter during surgery. I know this from reading Officer A. DeBoer's report, Case #14-092566.6.

On August 11th, 2014, at 1210 hours, Detective Gulley and Detective Sarantopolous showed a photo line-up of Justin Knox to Metro Enforcement Security Officer Aaron Richter. He was unable to make an identification from the photo line-up shown to him. Richter then pulled out his phone and showed Detectives J. Gulley and Sarantopoulos a photo of Knox he had saved on his phone from a previous contact and said, "that's him".

On August 11th, 2014, at 1500 hours, Nykesha Jones, the registered owner of the black, 2000 Chevy Impala, four door, plate ; arrived to speak with Det. J. Gulley and I. Jones explained she purchased this car for Justin Knox, who she has been dating, and he is the only person who drives it. Jones said Knox stays with her at her apartment at . Jones explained that on 08-09-14 the police showed up at her residence while Knox was there and they didn't open the

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door. She said he told her not to answer the door and she didn't because she is afraid of him. We asked Jones if she has a FOID or owns firearms. Jones told us she has a FOID and purchased a firearm and ammunition about two weeks ago at Bullet Stop Gun Shop for home protection but couldn't remember what caliber the gun was. I asked Jones if she knew where her gun was and she told us she last saw it about a week ago inside her bedroom closet. She agreed to take Det. J. Gulley and Det. Posley to her residence to determine if it was missing. Jones also agreed to a Consent to Search of her 2000 Chevy Impala, plate VIN: 2G1WF55KOY9265527 and signed a consent to search form. 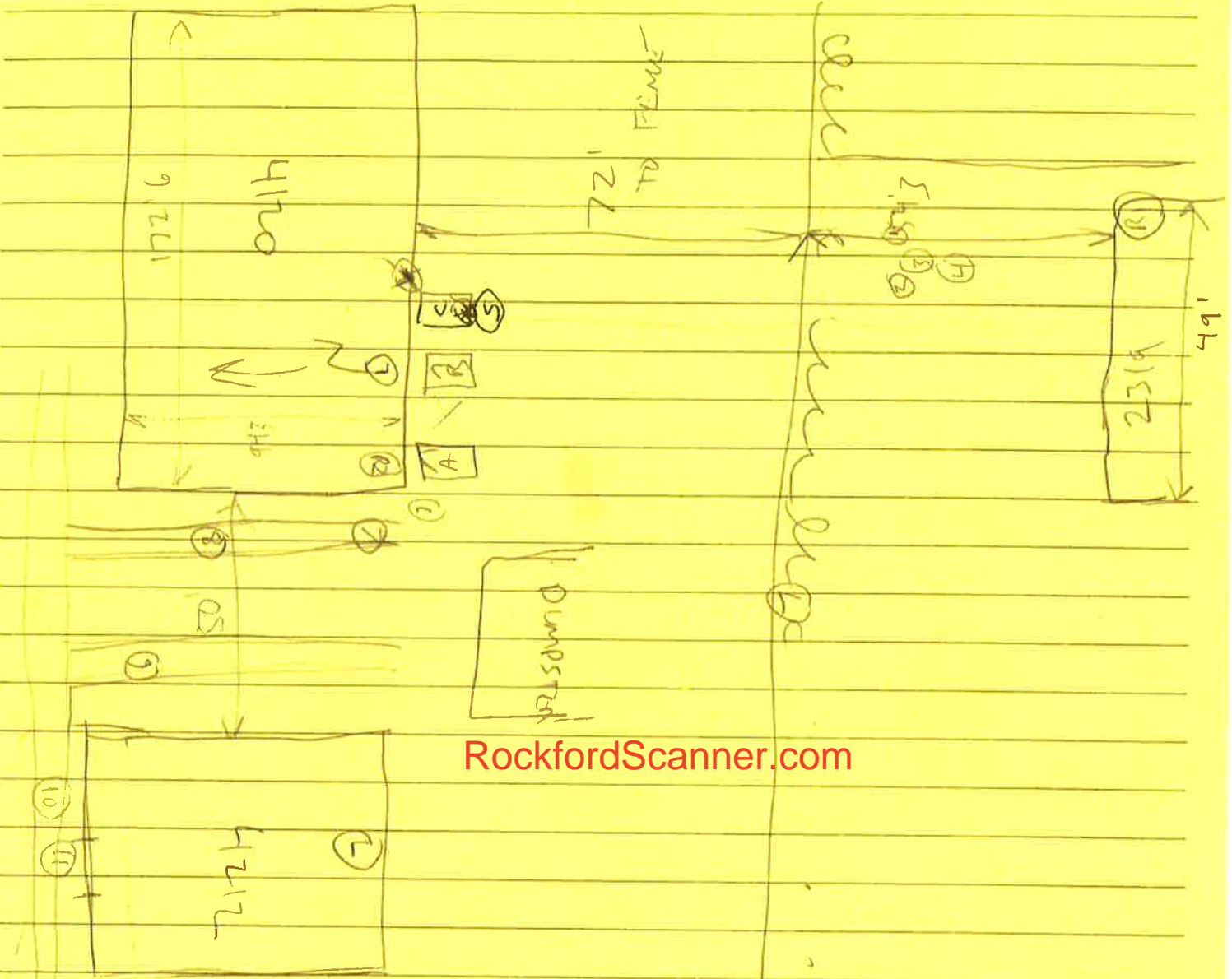
