A party was held at London's *Cafe Royale* after Bowie's last concert. Many of those famous people who attended the concert arrived at the *Cafe Royale* with other famous people such as Mick and Bianca Jagger, Dana Gillespie, Britt Ekland, Lou Reed, Peter Cook and Dudley Moore. They partied until dawn.



Both Bowie and wife, Angela, have influenced fashion tremendously in the past year. Bowie wore fashions by Freddie Burrett and Angela wore Paris.



In August of 1973, Bowie secluded himself at the *Chateau d'Herouville*, Chopin's former residence, in the south of France. There he recorded *Pinups*, a collection of Bowie's favorite rock tunes from the 1964-67 period in London.

Pinups represents both a tribute and interpretation of the music that was so influential during this period.

Beat Godfather meets Glitter MainMan

In November of 1973, *Rolling Stone Magazine* arranged a joint interview with Bowie and "Beat Godfather", William Burroughs. The two got along so well that Bowie suggested that they could team up and become "The Rodgers and Hammerstein of the Seventies".

In the interview (*Rolling Stone*, February 28, 1974) Bowie gave a detailed description of his *Ziggy Stardust* conception.
