## Server Record - Minecraft Wiki

The multiplayer server checklist in Minecraft: Java Edition.

The featured servers record in Minecraft: Bedrock Version.

Minecraft consists of an in-game server checklist for multiplayer by which users can save the servers they visit.

In Java Version, there is no pre-populated server record instantly available from in-game itself or on the official Minecraft webpage, but the stand-alone Java Version launcher does assist adding servers in the Multiplayer section. It permits players to see if a server is on-line, what number of slots it has, and the way good the player's connection (ping time) to the server is. Hovering over the connection standing icon in Minecraft's server listing tells the player the connection pace to the server.

When first loading up the multiplayer listing, the participant receives a warning concerning on-line play not being rated. If Server Lists needs to not see this again, there's a 'Do not show this display screen once more' checkbox.

In Bedrock Version, the server listing has a section for featured servers that have partnered with Mojang Studios. Within the console versions, these are the one servers accessible, as there isn't a choice to add unofficial servers.

## Finding unofficial servers[]

A number of web sites provide a place for server homeowners to publicly promote their servers, itemizing IP addresses and other information about these servers. There have been two sites of note (each defunct): the official Traditional server list maintained by Mojang Studios and the general public server record at the Minecraft Forums. Since Minecraft Forums has shut down their public server listing as of June 27th 2018 the only various to find Minecraft Servers to play on Java version is thru a public server listing discovered online. There are lots of well-liked server lists that mirror how Minecraft Forums system worked when it was live.

## Organizing servers[]

In Java Edition, the servers appear on the record in a set order, which can be modified. To vary the order the servers appear on the list, the player can hover over the server they like to move and use the arrows to maneuver the server up or down on the listing. Alternatively, the player can hold Shift and use the arrow keys.
