

# Jason Momoa To Star In 'Minecraft' Live-Action Movie At Warner Bros

LOS ANGELES (Variety.com) - From the watery kingdom of Atlantis to the dangerous deserts of Arrakis, Jason Momoa may be heading to the video game world of Minecraft for Warner Bros., Variety has confirmed.

The "Aquaman", "Dune" and "Dance" stars are in talks to star in a live-action movie based upon the hugely popular Minecraft videogame. It is the most-sold game ever, with more than 238,000,000 copies sold since its 2011 release.

Jared Hess, known for directing "Napoleon Dynamite," "Nacho Libre" and more, will helm the film. Mary Parent and Roy Lee will produce, and Jill Messick will receive a posthumous credit for working on the film prior to her death in 2018. Jon Berg and Cale Boyter will executive produce. Mojang Studios will produce through Lydia Winters and Vu Bui, the Swedish videogame developer behind Minecraft.

Momoa will next be able to take on "Aquaman and the Lost Kingdom", which is scheduled for March 17, 2023. He is also preparing for "Fast and Furious 10".
