

Minecraft is Bringing Story Mode To IOS

Minecraft developer Mojang has announced that they will be working with Telltale Games to create a new story mode for the game. Mojang promises it will be a narrative-driven experience about Minecraft, but didn't expand on what exactly that would look like.

The first episode will be released some time in 2015, and will be available on Xbox consoles, PlayStation consoles, PC, Mac, iOS, and Android-based devices. That's right. Whatever system you're using you'll be able to play Minecraft's story mode.

Minecraft: Story Mode will be released episodically. This is similar to Telltale's other games The Wolf Among Us or The Walking Dead. Those games also saw Telltale join forces with an outside developer, Gearbox. If you're worried that the story mode could take away from the gamer's imagined view of what the Minecraft world really is like don't worry. Mojang has put your worries to rest with their announcement. We're not planning on creating an "official" story for Steve, or explaining the world of Minecraft in detail. It's going to be a fun game.
