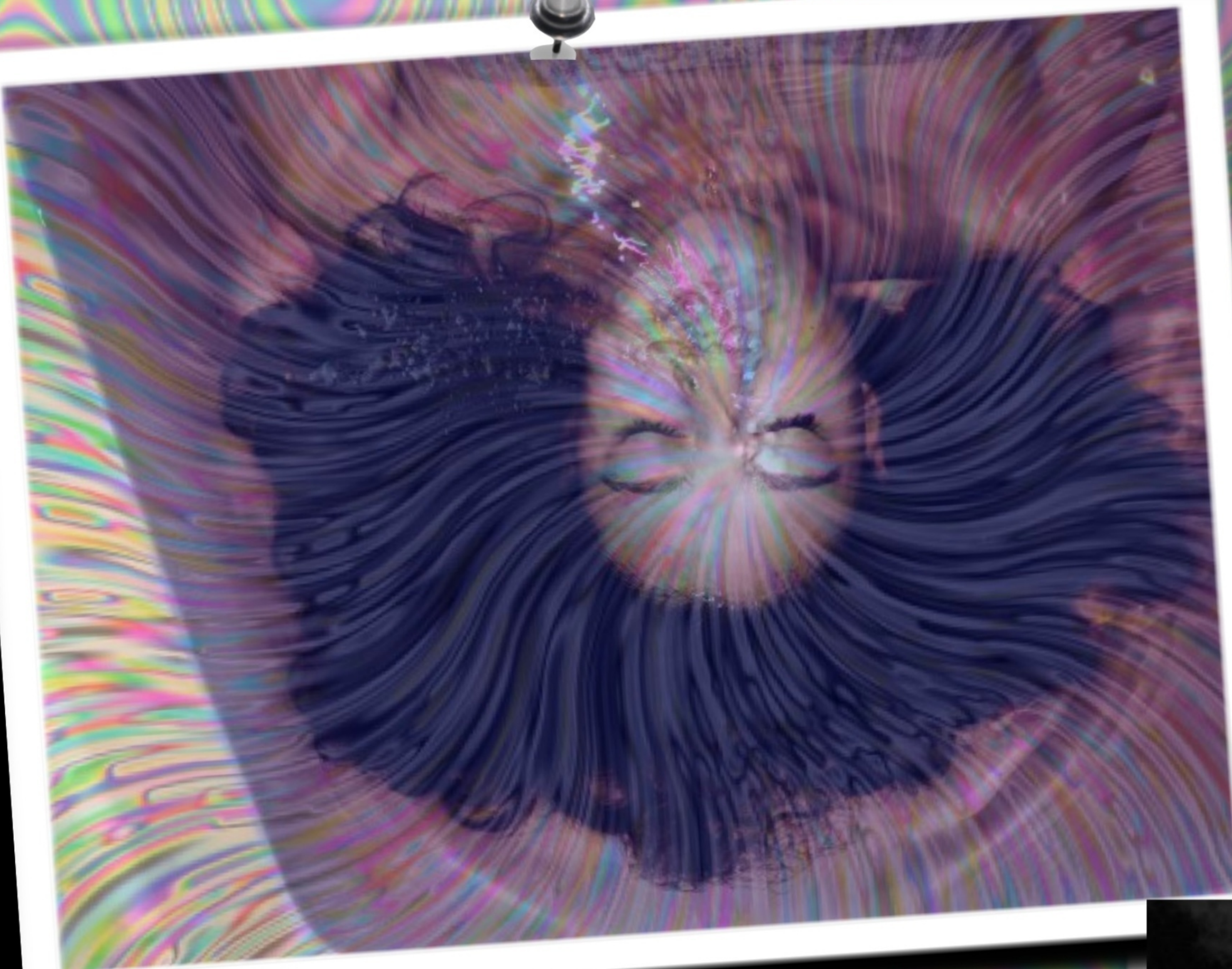
“Paradise of the Universe”

Sovereignty of the Imagination

ON MINIBOOKS AND THE IDEAS THEREIN

I recently assigned a design thinking project to my Digital Publishing class. I asked that they use the space of one 8.5 x 11 inch typing sheet and divide it into 16 parts thus giving 32 pages for the prototype of a mini book that would end up measuring less than 2 x 3 inches in object size.

Twelve little books have been produced. And their style and character could not be more different. It is incredible to see the mind of youth flush with energy and innovation develop ownership of an idea and then create a design from a very specific and limited framework.

The history of the written language is fairly new being about 10,000 years old with evidence of Sumerians (modern day Iraq) writing on clay tablet surfaces.

All major early civilizations developed their early forms of language/writing and they all created surfaces to place their ideas and records on.

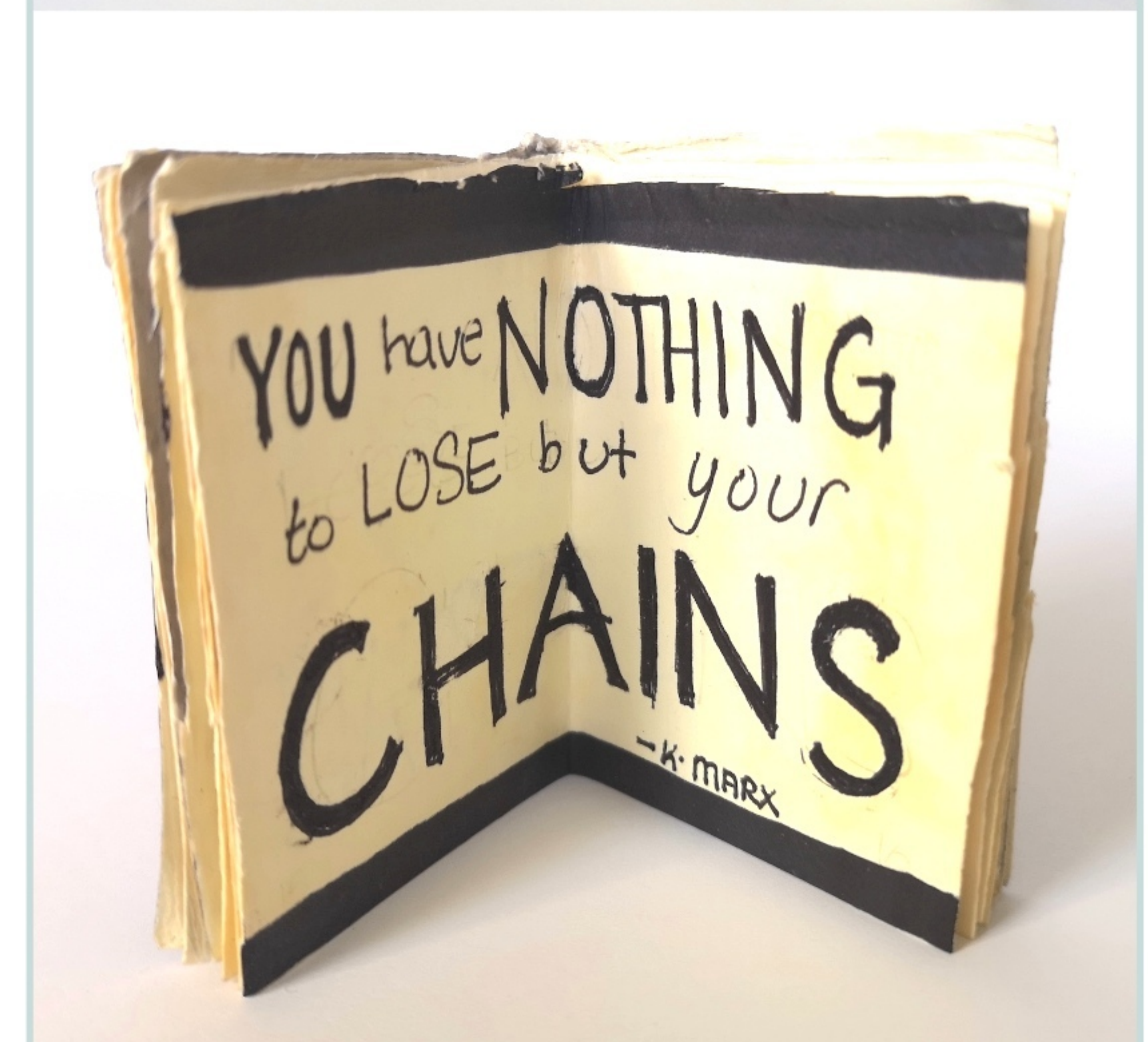
What is publishing? Isn't it the

production of the imagination? Isn't it a sovereign act of creativity in response to human activity?

Really what I want to talk about is how each student was given the same instruction, 1 page, and the result is a wide spectrum of products, an array of ideas that hold up as a unit that I want to call evidence of the sovereignty of the imagination.

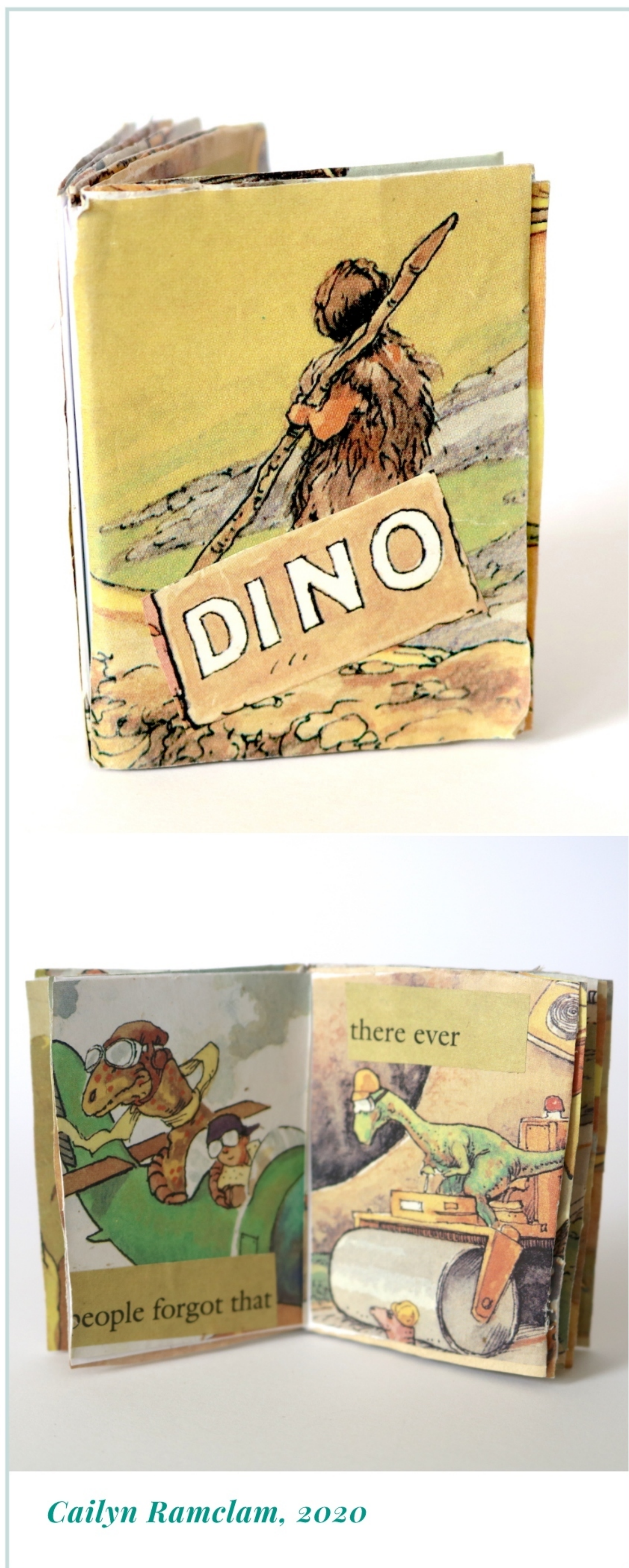

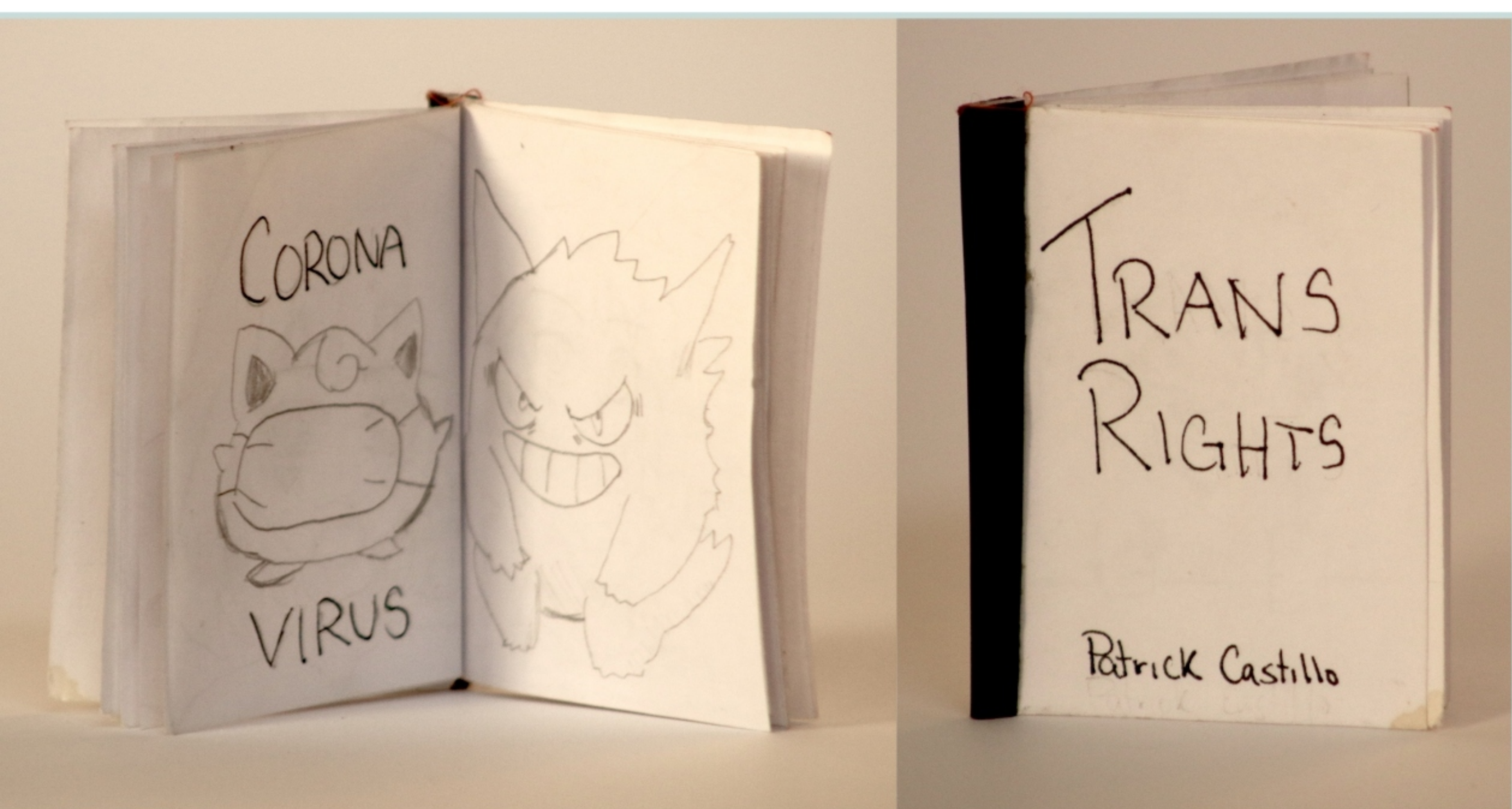
