



CHILD OF GOD CROWN

This week, the kids are learning about the Bible story “Moses and the Burning Bush.” In this story, God gave Moses a very special job! Even though God gave Moses special instructions to follow, Moses still didn’t feel like he was the right person for the job. Through this Bible story, the hope is that the kids will walk away knowing that even when we don’t feel like we’re good enough, we can remember that we are children of God! To help reinforce this teaching objective, the kids will create their own “I am a child of God” crowns so they can remember this Biblical truth.

DIRECTIONS

PREP BEFORE SERVICE

1. Print out printables.
2. Cut out the crown printable.
3. Prepare scissors, stickers, crayons, tape and printables for the leaders.

DURING THE SERVICE

1. Pass out each of the crown halves to the kids.
2. Allow time for the kids to color and decorate their crowns.
3. Help the kids tape the sides of the crown together.
4. Show the kids how to wear their crowns and what it means to be a child of God.
