MAC BLOOM, Deputy County Attorney, deposes and says that on or about the 5th day of May, 2018, in Missoula County, the Defendant committed the offense of COUNT I: ASSAULT - BODILY INJURY, a Misdemeanor, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-201, punishable by 6 months MCDF and/or \$500 fine.

The facts constituting the offense are:

COUNT I: On or about the 5th day of May, 2018, the above-named Defendant purposely or knowingly caused bodily injury to Aaron Misipeka-Ward when he punched Aaron in the face and knocked out Aaron's two front teeth.

26 MAC BLOOM, Deputy County Attorney, Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath,
27 deposes and says:

28 I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of
Jeremy Stephen Calhoun for allegedly committing the offense of COUNT I: ASSAULT -
BODILY INJURY, a Misdemeanor, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann.
45-5-201.


Based upon the following facts which have been obtained from reports of the law
enforcement officer which, if true, constitute sufficient probable cause to justify the filing of
the charges. The facts from those reports are as follows:

1 On May 5, 2018, at approximately 1:30 a.m., Officer Colyer (MPD) responded to St.
2 Patrick Hospital after learning that a fight resulting in injuries recently broke out in front of
3 Stockman's Bar on West Front Street. At the Hospital, Officer Colyer spoke with Aaron
4 Misipeka-Ward, who was missing his two front teeth. Aaron stated that he and some
5 friends were standing outside of Stockman's Bar when several males began harassing
6 Aaron's roommate. The verbal altercation eventually became physical and several males
7 joined in fighting. Aaron attempted to break up the fight, but when he did, Jeremy Calhoun
8 struck him in the face, knocking out his two front teeth. Two of Aaron's friends confirmed
9 his statement to Officer Colyer. At the Hospital, Aaron learned that his teeth would be lost
10 and that oral surgery would be necessary to install implants.

13 On May 10, 2018, Jeremy provided a statement to Detective Croft. He confirmed
14 that he and his friends were hanging out at Stockman's Bar when an argument broke out
15 between them and several other males. The argument escalated into a physical fight.
16 During the fight, Jeremy admitted to throwing two punches at Aaron. Jeremy stated that
17 only his second punch connected. After Jeremy hit Aaron, Aaron put his hands to his
18 mouth and walked away.

20 Detective Croft obtained surveillance of the incident from a nearby business. He
21 watched the video and observed several males fighting in the street outside of Stockman's
22 Bar. The fight eventually went to the ground. When it did, Jeremy Calhoun became
23 involved and appeared to strike one of the males who was on the ground. Aaron stepped
24 in and grabbed Jeremy around the waist to prevent him from hurting the male. Jeremy
25 then turned toward Aaron and threw two punches at Aaron's face.
