We believe that dedicated and relentless hard work will not only increase player fundamentals and athletic ability, but will also help these athletes grow as men and learn the true meaning of leadership. We will take this additional time over the summer months to work to make each player better than they were when they arrived. Team Try Outs: It is highly recommended to all players interested in playing on the Summer team play in our indoor leagues and simply notify one of the many coaches that you're interested. If the number of players interested in joining exceeds the number of roster spots available, a late Spring tryout would occur.
