

Four Petal Pedagogy

Education is a systematic process through which a student acquires knowledge, experience, skill and sound attitude. It makes an individual civilized, refined, cultured and educated. For a civilized and socialized society, education is the only means. Its goal is to make an individual perfect. Thus, a student has to learn all these qualities of head, hand and heart through the process of education.

Keeping all these things in the mind, we have developed the Four Petal Learning $^{\text{TM}}$ pedagogy which focuses on four pillars of holistic development i.e academics, humanities, physical education & sports and reasoning ability to achieve our goal of holistic development.



Assessment is the process of documenting, usually in measurable terms, knowledge and skills of a particular area that the child has been exposed to. Over the years, schools have been successful at designing and executing assessment ways to capture the knowledge and skills in different areas of classroom learning. However, at RIS we capture & measure learning which happens out of the classroom in co-scholastic areas in schools. This becomes important in the context of CBSE guidelines on the need to assess children holistically (life skills, arts, physical education & sports etc.) in a CCE compliant way.

When exams have become the focal point of the education system, learning needs to be useful beyond exams, in real life. While solving real problems, we need to apply knowledge from different fields simultaneously. It needs to be applied in complex contexts also. Our curriculum goes a step further and cross-links different topics. It is designed with relevance to the real-life contexts that makes learning lifelong useful.

Academics

RIS believes in the "Student centered Learning Approach" where students are at the centre of the learning process. The teacher's primary role is to coach and facilitate student learning and overall comprehension of

material. Student learning is measured through both formal and informal forms of assessment, including group projects, student portfolios and class participation. Teaching and assessment are connected; student learning is continuously measured during teacher instruction.

Inquiry-based learning is a teaching method that focuses on student investigation and hands-on learning. Here, teacher's primary role is that of a facilitator, providing guidance and support to students through the learning process.

Cooperative Learning refers to a method of teaching and classroom management that emphasizes group work and a strong sense of community. This method focuses on the belief that students learn best while working with and learning from their peers.



At RIS - Mehsana, we are committed to provide best of academic environment to our students. Our classrooms are equipped with interactive boards. We also strive to provide smart class environment to middle and secondary school. We have laboratory for languages, computer and science.

Assessments help teachers and schools determine student's progress. The types of assessments (formative and summative) and the methods (objective and subjective) are used at the primary and secondary levels.

The aim of education is the knowledge; not of the facts, but of values.

Humanities

We refer to the humanities as the study of arts – the visual arts such as architecture, painting and sculpture; music; dance; the theater or drama; and literature. They are the branches of learning concerned with human thoughts, feelings and relations.

The teaching of the humanities is intended to make the students realize that the mere possession of knowledge is useless unless put to useful ends. Moreover, they would become aware that knowledge alone is meaningless unless it is accompanied by values, sentiments, priorities, insights, inter-relationships and other transcendent realities not subject to empirical proofs also form part of the person's education. In the humanities, the students are exposed to these, leading to the development of the whole person, which is the goal of RIS.




Physical Education & Sports


