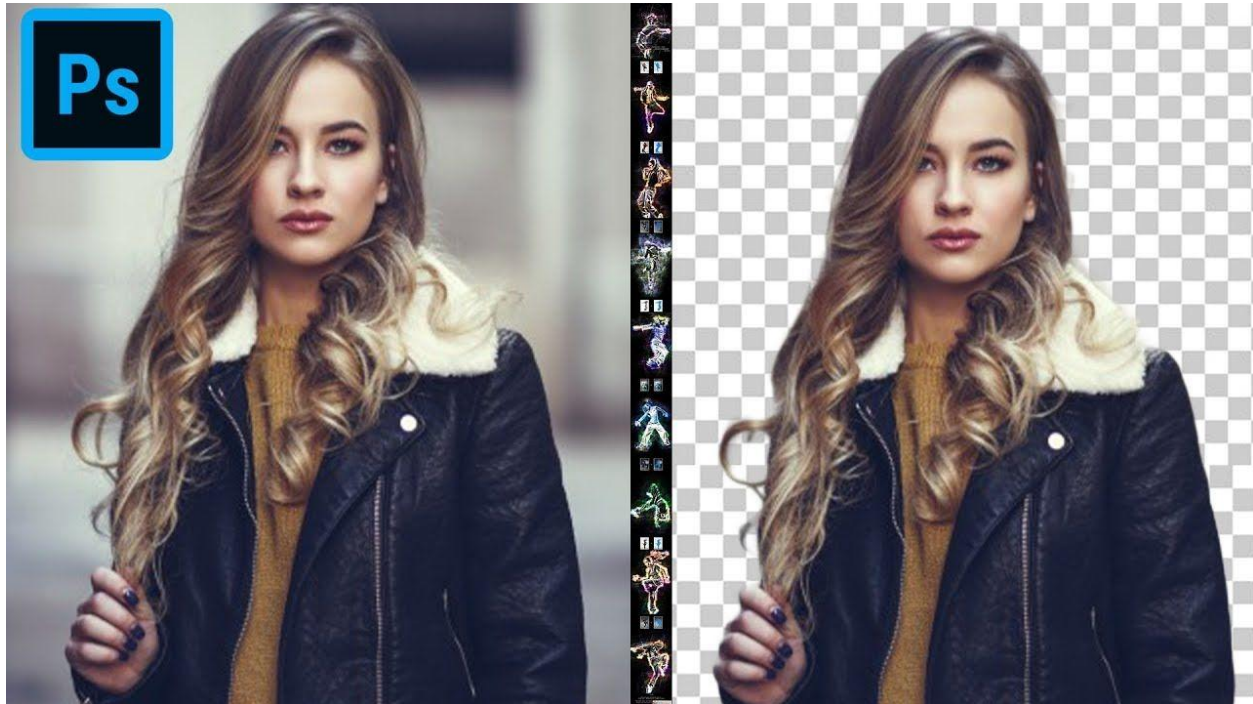


# Learn How to Remove Background from a Photo with These Tips

When you do this, the picture will then be cut down to size and will look a bit like a painting.
