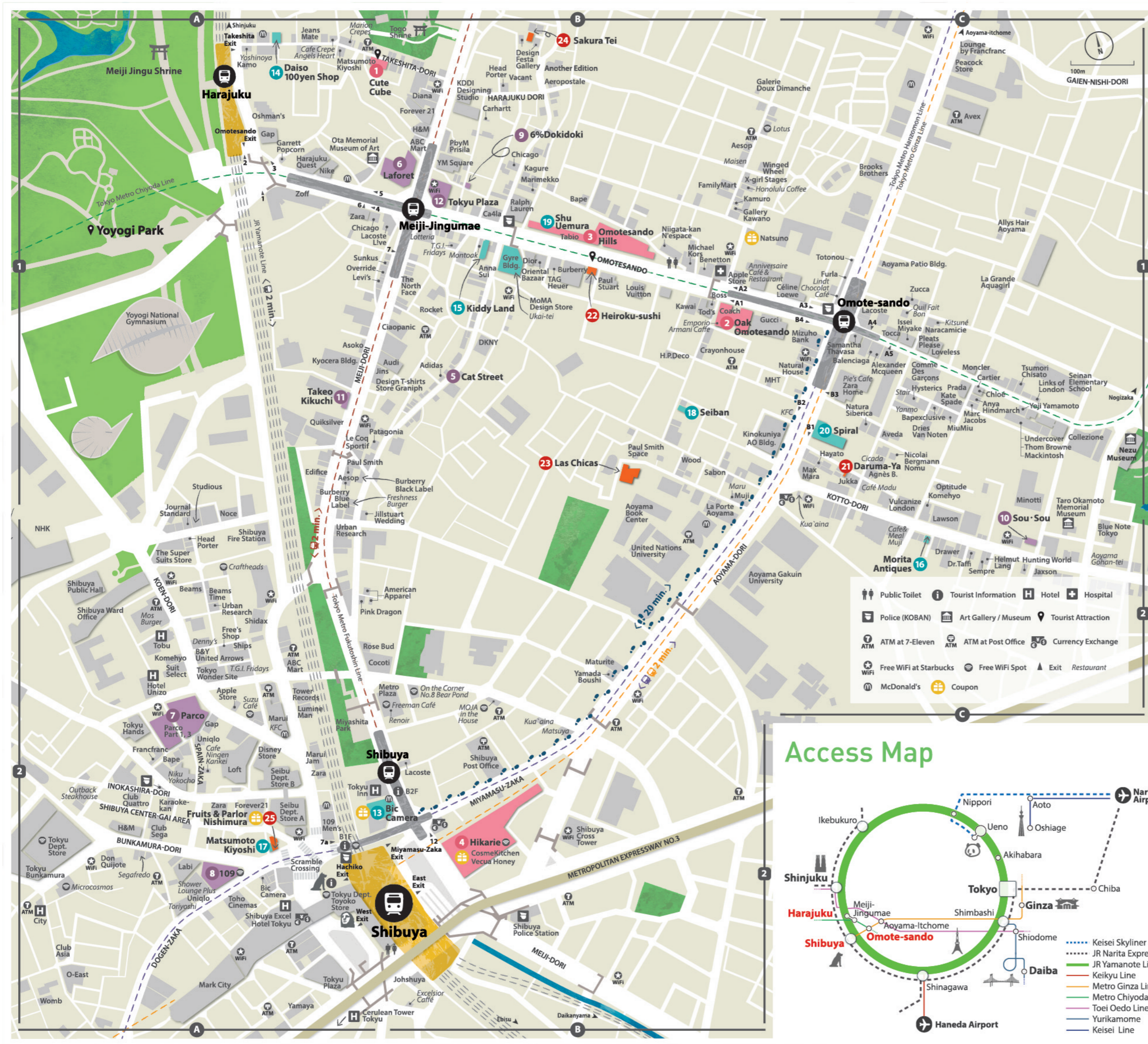


Area Map Shibuya Harajuku Omotesando

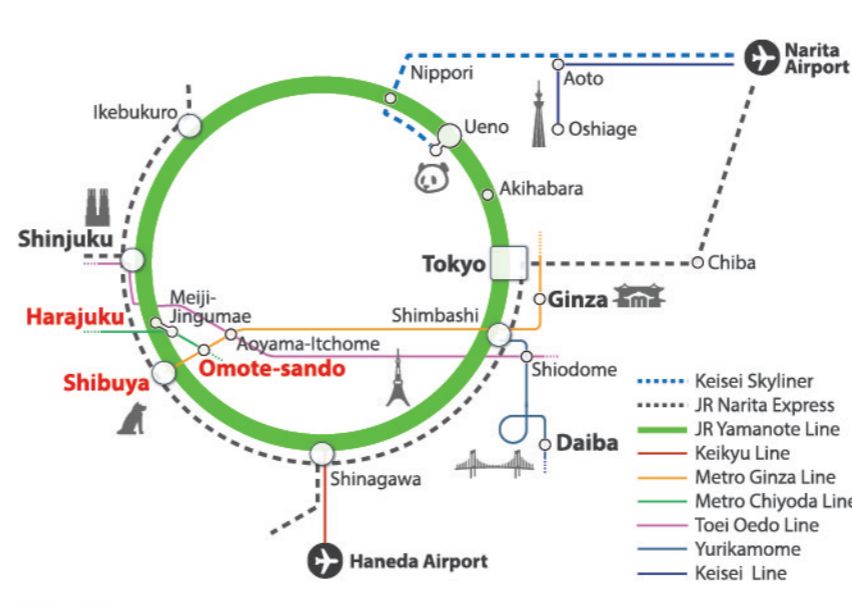

Less than 10,000 yen --- Cosplay (costume play) fashion at Laforet Harajuku and Takeshita-dori/Design products at Omotesando Hills or MOMA Design Store

Over 30,000 yen --- Luxury brand fashion and accessories at shops in Omotesando or select shops
