

# Free Minecraft Hosting: what do you Need to Know?

Minecraft the game that has been around for a long time, has been through numerous revisions. Despite all the changes, Minecraft is still a popular game that we play. If you wish to start an initial Minecraft server in your home computer to play with a couple of your friends, you simply must configure Minecraft in Linux or Putty. If yours is operating on a Windows operating system, you can start an absolutely free Minecraft hosting service by following the instructions given below:

Download the Minecraft software from the official site for the game. It is recommended to save it to a folder that will contain all your Minecraft files in the future. Before proceeding ensure that Java version 6 or greater is installed on your PC. This is essential because all the other versions have issues that may make the installation of downloaded software something next to impossible. Once you've done this, go ahead and start the executable file. This will start the automatic configuration of the Minecraft host server on your computer. You can ignore any error messages that may appear between. After the process is completed, you are required to increase the memory of your Minecraft server. Simply open a notepad and copy the following code.

```
"C:\Program Files\Java\jre6\bin\javaw.exe" -Xmx2048M -Xms2048M -jar  
"Minecraft_Server.exe". This file retrieves the Minecraft server file you use to set up the  
Minecraft server. Once you've done this, you will need to rename it to "run.bat". It must be  
saved in your Minecraft folder. In this way, you increased the memory of your Minecraft  
server from 100MB to 2GB, which is considered to be sufficient to play the game for a long  
time.
```

However, when the game starts increasing in intensity and more of your friends joining the excitement, your computer may be unable to handle the additional pressure it's being forced to manage.
