MATERIALS						
1 Pair of 4mm (UK8 - USA6) PONY Knitting Needles.		3 Buttons for Sweater.				
1 Pair of 3¼mm (UK10 - USA3) PONY Knitting Needles.		4 Buttons for Cardigan. PONY Stitch Holder.				
TENSION						
22 sts and 30 rows to 10cm, (4in) over stocking stitch on 4mm needles or the size required to give correct tension. Check your tension - if less stitches use a thinner needle, if more use a thicker needle.						
IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.

SWEATER

BACK

**With 3¼mm needles cast on 45 [51:55:59] sts.

1st Row. (Right side) K1, * p1, k1, rep from * to end.

2nd Row. P1, * k1, p1, rep from * to end.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows twice more, then the 1st row again.

Inc Row. Rib 1 [4:0:1], inc in next st, (rib 5 [5:5:4], inc in next st) 7 [7:9:11] times, rib 1 [4:0:2]. 53 [59:65:71] sts. Change to 4mm needles. Work in patt as follows:-

1st Row. K3 [6:9:12], Tw2, (k13, Tw2) 3 times,

k3 [6:9:12].

2nd Row. P2 [5:8:11], k1, p2, k1, (p11, k1, p2, k1) 3 times, p2 [5:8:11].

These 2 rows form patt. **

Cont in patt until back measures 23 [25:28:30]cm, (9 [9¾:11:11¾]in), from cast-on edge, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape Shoulders

Cast off 16 [19:21:23] sts, patt until there are 21 [21:23:25] sts on right-hand needle, then cast off rem 16 [19:21:23] sts.

Leave rem sts on a holder.

FRONT

Work as given for Back from ** to **.

Cont in patt until front measures 14 [14:16:18] rows less than back to shoulders, ending with a wrong-side row.

Shape Neck

Next Row. Patt 21 [24:26:28], turn and leave rem sts on a spare needle.

Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at neck edge on next 3 rows, then 1 st at same edge on foll 2 alt rows.

16 [19:21:23] sts.

Work 4 [4:6:8] rows straight. Cast off.

Return to sts on spare needle.

With right side facing, slip first 11 [11:13:15] sts onto a holder, join on yarn and patt to end.

Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at neck edge on next 3 rows, then 1 st at same edge on foll 2 alt rows.

16 [19:21:23] sts.

Work 6 [6:8:10] rows straight.

Cast off.

SLEEVES

(Both alike)

With 3¼mm needles cast on 25 [27:31:33] sts.

Work 7 rows in rib as given for back.

Inc Row. Rib 0 [1:3:1], inc in next st, (rib 2 [3:2:4], inc in next st) 8 [6:8:6] times, rib 0 [1:3:1]. 34 [34:40:40] sts.

Change to 4mm needles. Work in patt as follows:-

1st Row. K16 [16:19:19], Tw2, k16 [16:19:19].

2nd Row. P15 [15:18:18], k1, p2, k1, p15 [15:18:18].

These 2 rows form the patt.

Continuing in patt, inc and work into patt 1 st

each end of 3rd and every foll 10th [6th: 10th:4th] row until there are 38 [42:46:52] sts. Work straight until sleeve measures 11 [13: 14:15]cm (4¼[5¼: 5½:6]in), from cast-on edge, or length required, ending with a wrong-side row. Cast off.

NECKBAND

Join right shoulder seam. With right side facing, using 3¼mm needles pick up and k8 [9:12:12] sts down left side of front neck, k11 [11:13:15] sts from front neck holder, pick up and k10 [11: 14:14] sts up right side of front neck, then k21 [21:23:25] sts from back neck holder. 50 [52:62:66] sts. Work 6 rows in k1, p1 rib. Cast off in rib.

BUTTON BORDER

With right side facing and using 3¼mm needles, pick up and k23 [27: 29:31] sts along edge of left back shoulder from top of neckband to armhole edge. Work 3 rows in rib as given for back. Cast off in rib.

BUTTONHOLE BORDER

With right side facing and using 3¼mm needles, pick up and k23 [27: 29:31] sts along edge of left front shoulder from armhole edge to top. Work 2 rows in rib as given for back.

Buttonhole Row. K1, p1, k1, * yfwd, k2tog, rib 4 [6:6:6], rep from * twice more, rib 2 [0: 2:4]. Rib 2 more rows. Cast off in rib.

TO MAKE UP

Lapping buttonhole border over button border, catch borders together at armhole edge. Fold sleeves in half lengthways, then placing folds at top of sleeves to shoulder seams, sew in place. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.

CARDIGAN BACK AND SLEEVES

Work as given for back and sleeves of Sweater.

LEFT FRONT

** With 3¼mm needles cast on 21 [23:25:27] sts. Work 7 rows rib as given for back of sweater. **Inc Row.** Rib 1 [1:2:1], inc in next st, (rib 5 [4: 3:3], inc in next st) 3 [4: 5:6] times, rib 1 [1:2:1]. 25 [28:31:34] sts. Change to 4mm needles. **

Work in patt as follows:-
1st row. K3 [6:9:12], Tw2, k13, Tw2, k5.
2nd Row. P4, k1, p2, k1, p11, k1, p2, k1, p2 [5:8:11].

These 2 rows form patt. Cont in patt until work measures 11 [13: 14:15]cm, (4¼ [5¼: 5½:6]in), from cast-on edge, ending with a wrong-side row.

Place a marker at front

edge of last row.

Shape Front Edge

Keeping patt correct, dec 1 st at front edge on next and every foll 3rd row until 16 [19:21:23] sts rem. Work straight until front measures same as back to shoulder, ending with a wrong-side row. Cast off.

RIGHT FRONT

Work as given for Left Front from ** to **. Work in patt as follows:-
1st Row. K5, Tw2, k13, Tw2, k3 [6:9:12].
2nd Row. P2 [5:8:11], k1, p2, k1, p11, k1, p2, k1, p4.
Now complete to match left front reversing all shapings.

FRONT BORDER

Join shoulder seams. With right side facing, using 3¼mm needles, pick up and k34 [37: 40:43] sts up right front to marker and 30 [33: 36:39] sts to shoulder, k21 [21:23:25] sts from back neck holder, then pick up and k30 [33: 36:39] sts down left front to marker and 34 [37: 40:43] sts to lower edge. 149 [161:175:189] sts.
1st Row. K1, * p1, k1, rep from * to end.
2nd Row. K2, * p1, k1, rep from * to last st, k1.
Buttonhole Row 1. Rib 3, cast off next st, (rib 9 [10:11:12] including st left on needle after casting off, cast off next st) 3 times, rib to end.
Buttonhole Row 2. Rib to end casting on 1 st

over those cast off in previous row.
Rib 2 rows. Cast off in rib.

TO MAKE UP

Fold sleeves in half lengthways, then placing folds at top of sleeves to shoulder seams, sew in place. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.

HAT

With 3¼mm needles cast on 82 [92:104:112] sts. Work 6 rows in k1, p1 rib.

Next Row. (Fold line)

Knit to end.

Rib 6 rows increasing 1 st at end of last row on **1st, 3rd and 4th sizes only.**
83 [92:105:113] sts.

Change to 4mm needles. Work in patt as follows:-

1st Row. K4 [1:0:4], (k7, Tw2, k6) 5 [6:7:7] times, k4 [1:0:4].

2nd Row. P4 [1:0:4], (p5, k1, p2, k1, p6) 5 [6:7:7] times, p4 [1:0:4].

These 2 rows form patt. Cont in patt until hat measures 11 [13:14:15]cm, (4¼ [5¼:5½:6] in), from fold line, ending with a wrong-side row and increasing 1 st at end of last row for **2nd size only** and decreasing 1 st at each end of last row for **3rd size only.**
83 [93:103:113] sts.

Shape Crown

1st Row. K1, (k3, sl1, k2tog, pss0, k4) 8 [9:10:11] times, k2. Beg with a purl row work

3 rows in st-st.

5th Row. K1, (k3, sl1, k2tog, pss0, k2) 8 [9:10:11] times, k2.

6th Row. Purl to end.

7th Row. K1, (k3, sl1, k2tog, pss0) 8 [9:10:11] times, k2.

8th Row. Purl to end.

9th Row. K1, (k1, sl1, k2tog, pss0) 8 [9:10:11] times, k2.

19 [21:23:25] sts.

10th Row. P1, (p2tog) 8 [9:10:11] times, p2.

Break off yarn, thread through rem sts and draw up tightly, then fasten off securely.

TO MAKE UP

Join centre back seam. Turn rib to wrong side at fold line and slipstitch into place.
