In order to qualify for this prize, the research does not have to follow any particular topic, in fact, the more diverse the better - as long as it falls in the broad category of the Digital Humanities. In addition, any resulting papers will be published in the Centre's own journal *Studia Digitalia*.

This colloquium is honored to have **Claire Clivaz** from the Swiss Institute of Bioinformatics as a keynote. There will be a direct connection to another event: *Early Digital Computing in Central and Eastern Europe*, a conference that will host professor **Willard McCarty** from King's College London as a keynote, as well as **Mircea Rusu** from the Institute of Atomic Physics in Bucharest.
