

Dear beloved sisters and brothers,

We have been blessed, Alhamdulillah, to open the new Mecca Center in the first Friday of 2017. It was like watching a dream unfold into reality. We have already started to see the positive effects our new Masjid is having on our growing congregation and our neighbors. Our community now has big, beautiful prayer spaces to pray in and our children have full classrooms for their schooling and a gym for their activities.

Allah has a purpose and plan for everything. He wants each of us to run our race in line with His plan. In Surat Al-Mutaffifeen Allah said: {and for this let (all) those strive who want to strive} [83:26]. As our community got larger, more space was needed to accommodate the growing numbers. When news had gone out that a new masjid was being built in Willowbrook, people were ecstatic. With no hesitation, the community opened their pocket books to ensure that this project succeeded, all knowing what it would bring.

For years, we eagerly watched as a plot of land slowly, but surely, became what we now know as the Mecca Center. In January of this year, we officially opened the mosque for everyday use; this was what the community needed. As we all know, salat deserves the utmost cleanliness of any building, and salat is best when done with your brothers and sisters. In addition to the five daily prayers, the masjid is also open for Taraweeh and Eid prayers. One of my favorite memories from this summer was seeing the hundreds of people who came during Ramadan and Eid to all gather and worship.

What is great about this masjid is that it is accessible. It's easy to find with an abundance of parking spots and volunteers who devote their time to help the people get in as easily and as safe as possible. What's new about this masjid is that it has a beautiful, open gym. This way, people of all ages are compelled to come to the masjid to play their favorite sports and exercise as they practice their faith. Younger groups can feel free to gather at the masjid for activities or school.

As Americans today, it is essential for the Muslim youth to be surrounded by teachers and instructors who will guide them at a young age towards the right direction: Islam. Furthermore, it's noticeable enough to point out that the young generations of Muslims who come to this new location have taken Sunday school and weekly gatherings much more seriously. With a renovated area, a sense of formality and professionalism quickly emerged in the halls. Students are now compelled to be more mature in this place of worship. As these kids witnessed the mosque being built before their eyes, it gave them a feeling of belonging and a mutual understanding that this masjid would forever change the Chicagoland Islamic society.
