About foodKIND

foodKIND is a humanitarian organization with a mission to provide food and compassion to refugees in crisis. Our work focuses on the most vulnerable groups of refugees and aims to provide support where there is a significant absence of consistent and sufficient food supply and where basic needs are not being met. Job Description
