 - Application deadline: Application must be received by: Wednesday, March 28, 2018
 - Provide one letter of recommendation
 - Typed essay containing 350-500 words
- Preference will be given to students majoring in music, the fine arts and criminal justice.

Academic Achievement (2.5 GPA or better)	35%	
Contributions to school, church, and/or community	15%	
Essay	35%	
Letters of recommendation	15%
