DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For control of White Water Lily and Watershield:

AquaPRO Herbicide may be used via foliar application to control White Water Lily and Watershield in all bodies of fresh and brackish water that may be flowing, nonflowing or transient including lakes, rivers, streams, ponds, estuaries, rice levees, seeps, irrigation and drainage ditches, canals, reservoirs, wastewater treatment facilities, wildlife habitat restoration and management areas and similar sites.

For use rates and application methods, refer to the container label for control of perennial aquatic weeds in NONCROP AREAS. One or multiple applications can be made seasonally but total annual use cannot exceed 8 quarts per acre (8 lb glyphosate acid). For site-specific recommendations, contact a SePRO Aquatic Specialist.

All application directions, restrictions, worker protection standards, and precautions on the EPA registered label must be followed. This recommendation contains new or supplemental instructions for use of the product which may not appear on the package label. Follow instructions carefully. This recommendation and the federal label must be in the possession of the user at the time of the pesticide application.
