On Monday, July 17th 2017, at approximately 1215 hours, Ocoee Police Department Officer David Ogletree, Officer Jose Massenet and Officer Stevens Bertrand were assigned to Starke Lake conducting marine/safe boating duties.

Officers were out on the water and observed a light green speed boat, now referred to as vessel, in the water, in the weeds on the northeast side of Starke Lake. The vessel was in the tree line with it's bow facing the shoreline. The vessel had a black canvas cover that was on it. The canvas cover was collecting water on it's rear, starboard side. The canvas cover also had a large amount of bird dropping on it. The vessel's certificate of number and decal numbers on the vessel were not visible due to the way it was floating in the water. Officer Bertrand got onto the vessel to see if he could read the vessel's certificate of number and decal. Officer Bertrand was unable to get to the numbers. At that time, an red anchor was in the water tied off to the stern on the vessel. It appeared but was not confirmed that the bow of the vessel was tied off also.

Officers were concerned that the vessel was in violation of City of Ocoee Ordinance, Chapter 48-6. - General operation for Boats and Boating:

D. No person shall operate any watercraft without the State of Florida registration number and decal being affixed prominently on said watercraft.

Or,

Florida State Statute 327.4107 Vessels at risk of becoming derelict on waters of this state.-

- (2) An officer of the commission or of a law enforcement agency specified in s. 327.70 may determine that a vessel is at risk of becoming derelict if any of the following conditions exist:
- (a) The vessel is taking on or has taken on water without an effective means to dewater.

Also, the way the vessel was tied up in the tree line and not affixed to a dock or boathouse like the surrounding vessels, led officers to believe that the vessel could have been illegally dumped and even stolen.

Officers then decided to make contact at some residences across Silver Star Road to inquire if the residents knew about the vessel. Officer Bertrand was taken to shore and went to the address, 618 E. Silver Star Road, using

Officer Ogletree's marked patrol vehicle to make contact with the residents. Officers Ogletree and Massenet were still on the police vessel near the tied down vessel in the weeds/ tree line. Officers Ogletree and Massenet then heard a gunshot.

The scene was secure by arriving patrol officers and no person(s) were struck by the gunfire. Ocoee Police Department Crime Scene Investigator (CSI) Dawn Carlton processed the scene. Lieutenant Scott Nylander arrived on scene and conducted an investigation into the shooting.

Officer Ogletree arrived on scene and briefly spoke to Charlie Brooks. Brooks resides at 618 E. Silver Star Road. Officer Ogletree explained to Brooks why the police were there to begin with. Brooks stated that the vessel in question did in fact belong to him. Brooks was given a business card with the offense number. Animal Control was contacted and responded to the scene. At that time, Animal Control took custody of the deceased dog after gaining permission from Brooks.
