While this is primarily a stability replace for the earlier release, which was fairly enormous, some enjoyable bits have been put in. One in all the large additions is an official Mod Database, for players to upload and obtain from. The remainder of the update is generally small tweaks and fixes but their support of Linux continues shining. For Linux players, you need to hopefully see improved support for running the sport on Wayland.
