European Atlantic Youth Creative Hubs Project (AYCH)

AYCH aims at providing young people coming from all backgrounds and levels of education the chance to tackle job competency gaps through vocational training and immersion in real life job situations. Participants are invited to think about future needs and innovative solutions from current societal challenges, such as gender inequality, sustainability and resilient communities, with a design thinking methodology. AYCH activities are built around / to engage with the SDG agenda and thought of to work as pull-up platform for creativity and innovation among youth of the Atlantic Arc.

AYCH is co-funded by the ERDF as part of INTERREG Atlantic Area programme.
