



White Box Live Arts Rental Information Sheet

White Box Live Arts prioritizes activities that support and advance the mission of White Box Live Arts under the direction of San Diego Dance Theater.

Mission: To engineer an accessible environment that curates, produces, and educates artists.

Curates: Facilitating through invitation, grants, and sponsors of live art exhibitions and performances from artists residually, nationally, and internationally.

Produce: Provide a rehearsal and performance space for local and non-local artists, via a variety of rental packages affordable to companies and emerging choreographers.

Educate: Use the space to provide access to interactive workshops, master classes, and seminars for performing artists.

General Information: San Diego Dance Theater's White Box Live Arts at ARTS DISTRICT Liberty Station is the newest installment in the ever evolving NTC Arts & Culture District at the former Naval Training Center in Point Loma. Bright and airy, this space is a transformable and fresh environment for artists to produce their work. White Box Live Arts is well suited for individuals and small to large group rehearsals, as well as for artists seeking an alternative and intimate performance space. It is available for classes, workshops, and performances. There is seating for 128 patrons. Total legal capacity including performers is 175 persons. Hours are 8am- 11pm daily.

Rental Rates and Details: As a renter, you may reserve space up to 1 year in advance by emailing whitebox@sandiegodancetheater.org. White Box Live Arts is available for independent artists, workshops, master classes, weekly repeating classes, and performances. Rentals are fulfilled on a first come, first serve basis according to availability.

Basic rental: \$50/hour

Performance rental: \$110/hour including technician, or \$550/day + technician

Technician: \$35/hour

Dressing room (if available): \$25/hour

In order to reserve event dates, White Box Live Arts requires renters to pay an event deposit of 20% of the estimated rental cost as well as sign a separate event agreement. Liability insurance must also be acquired with San Diego Dance Theater and White Box Live Arts listed as additionally insured.

Renters are responsible for all staffing of their events.

Renters are responsible for their own set up of chairs and other items they use in the space.

Renters are responsible for striking the space back to its original condition at the end of each night.

No props, set pieces, costumes, etc may be left in the space overnight.

Cancellation Policy:

In the event that you need to cancel your rental, we will need advance written notice. Please try to communicate with us as early as possible. Cancelled events will not receive any refund of deposit but can be rescheduled based on White Box availability.
