<b>The Equity Project (TEP) Charter School is a public school that is free for all students.</b> TEP has 120 seats for students entering Kindergarten and 120 seats for students entering 5 <sup>th</sup> grade in the fall of 2018. TEP anticipates that more than 120 students will submit applications to attend TEP for each entering grade level. Therefore, TEP will hold a lottery to fill its Kindergarten and 5 <sup>th</sup> grade cohorts.			
Each prospective student will have one ticket entered into the lottery drawing. An individual unaffiliated with TEP will select tickets, one at a time, until all tickets have been drawn. After the lottery is completed, TEP will inform you as to whether your child has been awarded one of the open seats at TEP. If your child is not awarded an open seat through the lottery, your child will be placed on a waiting list for future openings.
