Read Daniel 4:28-37 (suggest dividing up the reading)

- 1) How would you summarize Daniel 4 from what you've read and heard from the sermon?
Hint: Daniel 4 is a chapter devoted not so much to saying pride comes before a fall as saying....
- 2) How do we know that human wisdom, power, and accomplishment can't guarantee the world or outcome you want? (Wisdom v18; Power v30a,31; Accomplishment v30b)
- 3) What feelings did you have when someone "less deserving" was blessed and you were not?
What does a response like that say about how we view God, His grace, and even ourselves in those moments?
- 4) Knowing our sin does not repulse our Savior from us why then is there a need to confess our vulnerability? What does that confession reveal about the state of the confessor's heart?
Why is that important?

Partner

- 1) Remember that your sin is not too dark, your life not too desperate, your loved ones' hearts not too hard for God to soften. Let's pray in light of that of God's grace as seen in Daniel 4.
