


HardieBacker[®] 6MM & POLYPIPE OVERLAY™



- 1. Score-and-snap boards to required sizes and make necessary cutouts.
- 2. <u>Tiled Areas Only</u> Mix and apply a single part flexible adhesive in accordance with the adhesive manufacturer's instructions and spread evenly with a 6mm notched trowel.
- 3. Stagger all **Hardie**Backer[®] Cement Backerboard joints in a broken bond or brick pattern. Do not align with subfloor joints. Never allow all four corners of boards to meet at one point.
- 4. Leave a 3mm gap between floor and wall edges, vanities, baths etc. and fill with a good quality bathroom sealant.

- 5. Fix with 15mm galvanized brads (such as Paslode brand) or **Hardie**Backer screws.
- 6. Keep fixings between 15mm from board edges and 50mm from the board corners.
- 7. Insert fixings every 200mm and between pipe runs to hold the sheet flat against underlying pipe support board. <u>Ensure to avoid underlying</u> pipes.
- 8. <u>Tiled Areas Only</u> Embed a 50mm alkaline resistant Fibatape across the HardieBacker joints and feather tile adhesive across the tape to leave a 150mm wide adhesive joint.

**Suitable for Tile, Engineered Wood and Carpet, other floor finishes may require leveling.
