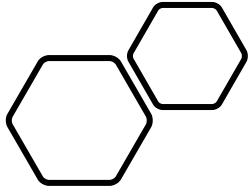
The Long Range Plan 2020/2021

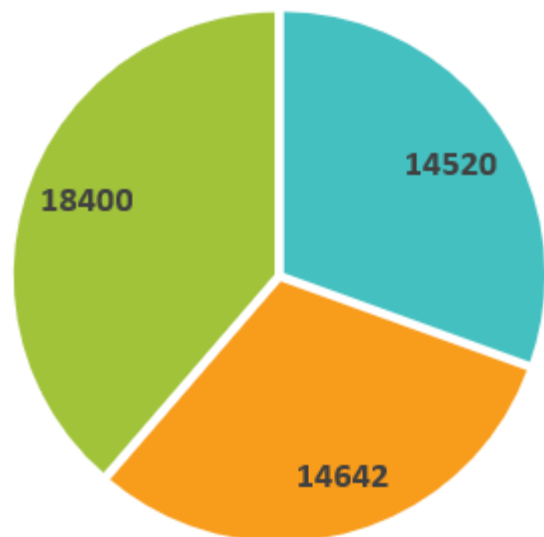

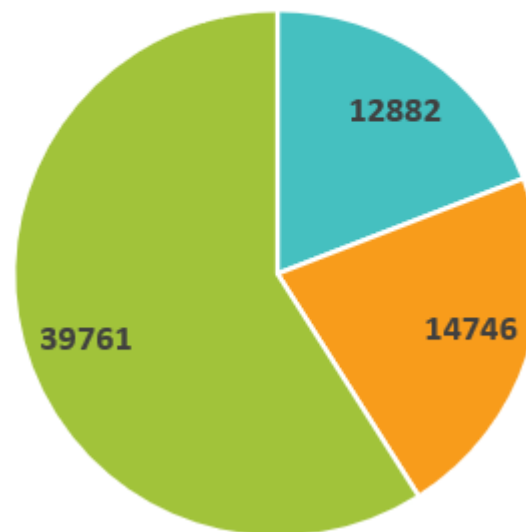
City of Surrey Total 10 Year Housing Projection

(67,389)

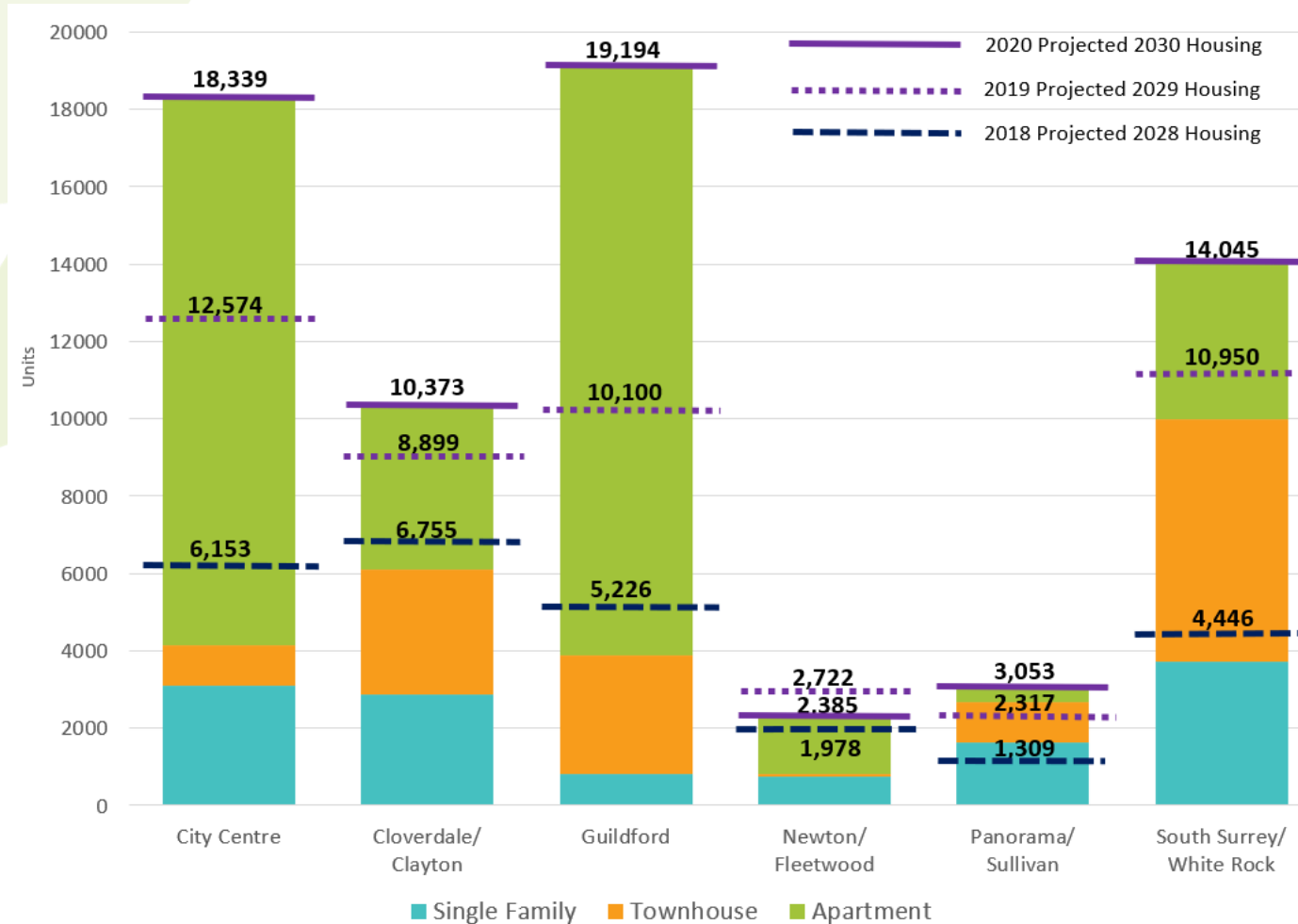

GROWTH: Apartments by 21,361 new units

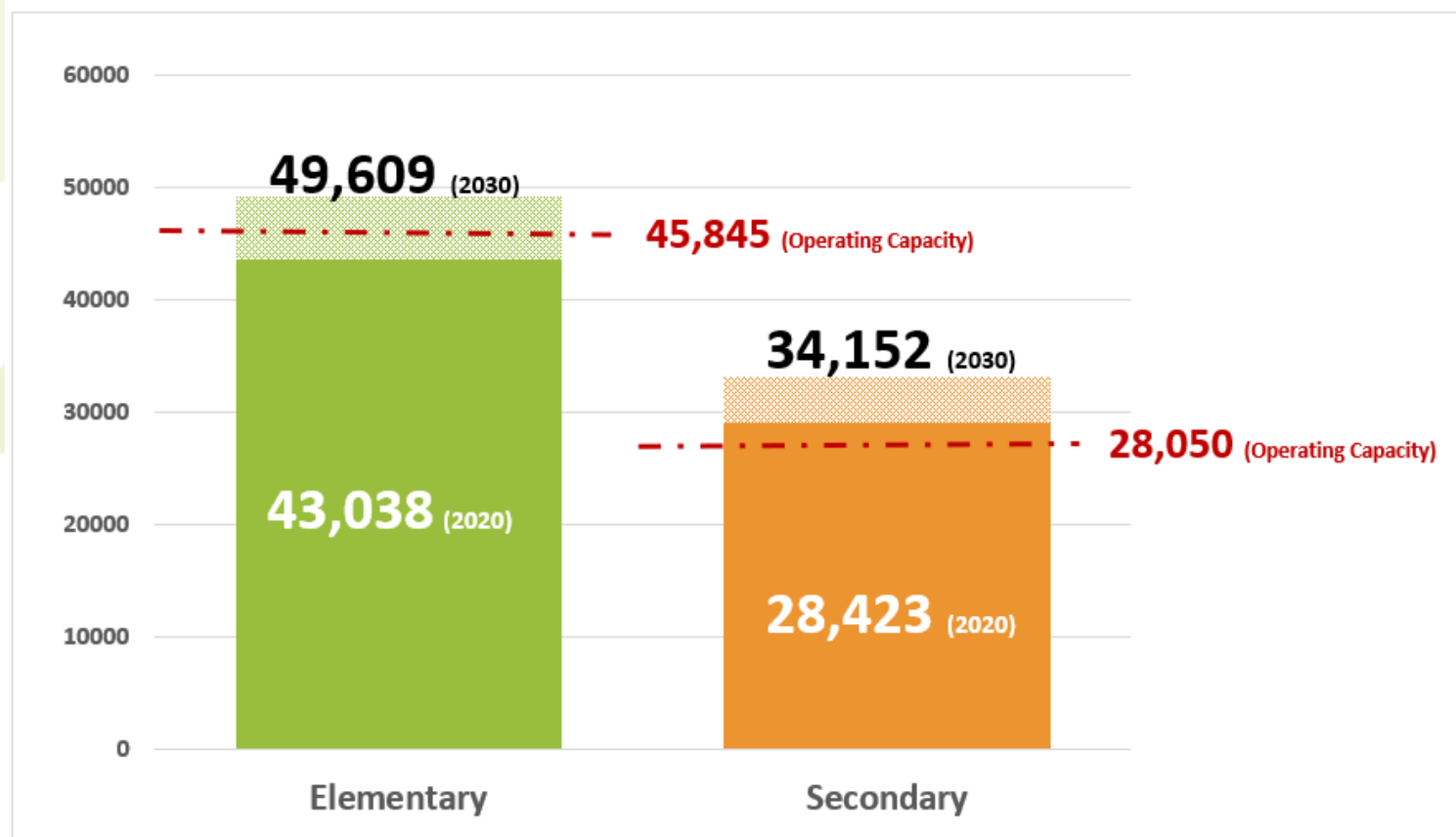
City of Surrey 10 Year Housing NEW Count Projection
