



You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals! **TSR Riders Finals** - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

**TSR** In Hand Finals - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Class 3 - KBIS / Equifest Working Hunter Pony Championship. Working Hunter Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders must be the correct age for the animal they ride. If this classification is run as one class, fences must be adjusted for each height section.

#### Classes may be divided as follows:

- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms. Riders not to have attained their **14**<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 133cms but not exceeding 143cms. Riders not to have attained their 17<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 143cms but not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 20<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Open Intermediate Working Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years or over, exceeding 148cms and not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their **25**<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.

Class 4 - NEDZ / Equifest Mountain & Moorland Working Hunter Pony Championship. Mountain and Moorland Working Hunter pony, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dartmoor, Dales, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland or Welsh A, B, C or D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Riders any age. If classes are divided, they must be divided by height and **NOT** by Breed, i.e.

• Not exceeding 122cms.

- Exceeding 122cms but not exceeding 133cms.
- Exceeding 133cms but not ecceeding 143cms.
- Exceeding 143cms.

Class 7 - The Stokes Family / Equifest Open Working Hunter Championships. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms. Riders of stallions to have attained their **14**<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year. Maximum height of fences 1.14m (3'9") at the discretion of the Judges.

Class 8 - BSPA / Equifest Ridden Piebald / Skewbald Championship. Open ridden Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Riders any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championship. Subject to their show rules & conditions.

Classes 9, 11, 34 & 37 - Dollar Bedding/ Equifest Ridden Part Breds Championships. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exhibits in this section must be registered in the Part Bred section of their respective Breed Society. Riders any age Class 8: BSPA / Equifest In-Hand Piebald / Skewbald Championship. Open in Hand Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championships. Subject to their show rules & conditions.

Class 10: Equifest Mountain and Moorland In-Hand. Open to In Hand Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age.

Class 20: Miss Jo Brew/Equifest Open Small Hunter. Open Small Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age.

Class 21: Black Country Saddles/Equifest Ridden Hunters. Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cms. Riders any age.

#### Classes may be divided as follows:

- Lightweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying up to 12.7 stone.
- Middleweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying 12.7 stone but not 14 stone.
- Heavyweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over capable of carrying over 14 stone.

Class 22: HightoppsSTud/Equifest Ridden Hacks. Open Show Hacks, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 160cms. Riders any age.

#### Classes may be divided as follows:

- Small Hacks mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 154cms. Riders any age.
- Large Hacks mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 154cms but not exceeding 160cms. Riders any age.

Class 22: NupaFeed/Equifest Riding Horse. Open Riding Horse, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, any height. Riders any age. Classes may be divided as follows:

- Small Riding Horses mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age.
- Large Riding Horses mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 158cms. Riders any age.

Class23: Nupafeed/Equifest Ridden Cobs. Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. Riders any age.

#### Classes may be divided as follows:

- Open Lightweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms.
- Open Heavyweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms.

Class 26: BSPA/Equifest Ridden Piebald/Skewbald Championship. Open ridden Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Riders any age. The first three places will also qualify for the BSPA Championship. Subject to their show rules & conditions.

Class 35: The Hewitt Family/Equifest Open Ridden Mountain and Moorland. Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age.

The show committee, owner or tenant will not accept responsibility for any accident however caused on the showground.

- 1. The decision of the committee must be considered final in respect of all disputes and may withhold any prizes if there are less than three entries.
- Protests must be accompanied by <u>a deposit of £25.00 (Twenty-five pounds</u>) to be forfeited if the committee consider the protest to be frivolous or otherwise not reasonable. All protest must be made in <u>writing</u> and within <u>one hour</u> of the incident occurring or completion of the class.
- 3. The Judge's decision is final. No person may address the Judge whilst adjudicating unless requested by them.
- 4. Any questions arising about any animal exhibited shall be decided by the Hon. Veterinary Surgeon.
- 5. All cups are kept at the risk of the winner.
- 6. The committee reserve the right to make any alterations they think fit.
- 7. British Safety Standard hard hats must be worn at all times. The committee will make random checks of riders during the day.
- 8. As this is a BRC show no junior under the age of 18 years may wear spurs.
- 9. No competitor shall show a stallion for which they are responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any competition, without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
- 10. The onus is on every rider who suffers a fall, or anybody who suffers a fall or anybody who suffers an injury on the showground to report the fall / injury to the show secretary.
- 11. If a competitor enters two classes which run at the same time in different rings, they must choose between them; classes will not be held up for a competitor.
